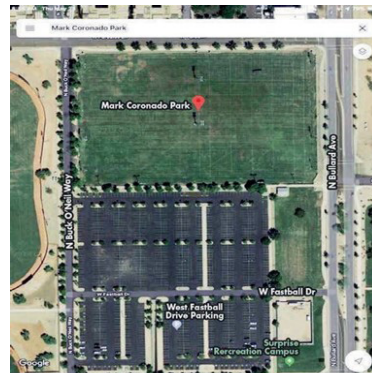

USE OF RAMPS

Chinese Shar-Pei **must be judged on a ramp** through all levels of conformation competition: The full policy and list of Table and Ramp eligible/required breeds is available on the AKC website at: https://images.akc.org/pdf/judges/table_breeds.pdf

Ramps can be used to judge any breed in an emergency situation where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list; an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (06/2025)
