ROUTES TO THE SHOW

From I-5: Take Exit #127 (Puyallup/Mt Rainier) and turn onto Highway 512 going east; take the WA-161 exit towards South Hill/Eatonville; turn right onto WA-161 (104th St E); WA-161 (104th St E) becomes WA-161 (S Meridian); head south for about 8 miles; take first right after 213th St Ct E. Look for the Little Wheels sign.

NEW EXHIBITOR BRIEFING

Superintendent will have New Exhibitor Handbooks available, and are there to answer any of your questions on the days of the shows.

SHOW INFORMATION

- Gates will open at 6:00AM
- Each exhibitor will receive an acknowledgment of entry.
- All dogs shall be kept on leash except when in the obedience or rally rings.
- There shall be no drilling nor intensive corrective training of dogs on the grounds or premises.
- Designated exercise areas will be clearly marked.
- No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these shows.

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

NOTE: TRANSFER OF ENTRIES AND REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS FOR PUBLISHED JUDGE CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON MONDAY, JULY 14. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

FREELANCE PHOTOGRAPHERS - WHICH INCLUDE THOSE THAT DERIVE INCOME/VALUE FROM THEIR WORK AND/OR HAVE A CLIENT BASE - MUST HAVE PRIOR PERMISSION FROM THE SHOW CHAIRMAN AND PAY A FEE TO PHOTOGRAPH AT THESE SHOWS. RATE IS \$150 FOR ONE DAY, OR \$250 FOR TWO DAYS. FOR FURTHER INFORMATION, EMAIL THE SHOW CHAIRMAN (hilite1@earthlink.net). Non-professional (no detachable lens) cameras are allowed. No video cameras, selfie sticks, gimbals or tripods. Unauthorized or prohibited photography of any event may result in film or videotape being confiscated by show representatives and the photographer asked to leave show grounds. In all cases, the resale of photography or video is strictly prohibited unless taken by an authorized show vendor or show photographer.
