Road). Exit East 1/8 mile. Fairgrounds are on the North side  
of the road. Enter Bob Fish Drive.

FROM EAST & WEST - Take Hwy. 60 to Hwy. 45. Go North on 45  
for 2 miles. Exit PV (Pleasant Valley Road). Go East 1/8 mile  
to Bob Fish Drive. Follow signs for Parking or Unloading.

PUBLISHED JUDGE CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE  
OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON MONDAY, JUNE 22. AFTER THIS TIME,  
YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.**

**CONFORMATION:** Dogs may be transferred from one of the  
regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition,  
provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at  
least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular  
conformation judging at the show.

**JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP:** Junior Handlers who win a third  
Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a  
Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win  
towards moving to Open, after closing of entries for a show  
are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the  
Open Class by notifying the Superintendent prior to the start  
of the class at the show. Correction may be made from one  
age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open  
or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior  
miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer  
must be made to the Superintendent prior to the judging of  
the class at the show.

**- NOTE -**

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s.95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination.

Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used.
