## **HOTEL AND ACCOMMODATIONS:**

**The host hotel is the Olympia Inn at Capitol Lake (Formerly Hotel RL Olympia),  
2300 Evergreen Park Dr. SW, Olympia, WA 98502.**

A grab and go breakfast will be available Monday September 20th-Saturday September 25th at a rate of \$5 per person plus tax and gratuity. A hot breakfast buffet is available daily at a reduced rate of \$10 per person plus tax and gratuity.

Please Note: If guests cancel their entire reservation less than 30 days prior to arrival there will be a charge of 1 night room and tax. An early departure fee will be added to the guest's folio should they check out prior to their scheduled departure. Be sure to verify your check out date at check in to avoid this fee.

### **Hotel Policies**

We have established these rules for the safety of everyone and the preservation of the hotel. When rules are followed, the hotel atmosphere is greatly enhanced by the presence of your dogs and we sincerely look forward to hosting your shows and events. These policies and fees are subject to change without notice.

- Dogs must be crated in guestrooms at all times when owners are not in the room. NO EXCEPTIONS! Plastic is required under all crates in the rooms. Hotel will supply plastic. If any dog is found out of their cage, there will be a \$50.00 per day charge assessed to the guestroom. This is for the safety of the hotel personnel, the hotel property and the dogs. Each guest is responsible for any damages.
- There will be a \$75.00 non-refundable fee required for each guestroom. Each room will be inspected upon checkout and, if extra cleaning is needed or damage has been done to the guestroom each individual will be charged according to the damage. 2 board members and 2 hotel associates to verify the damage to the guestrooms will view each room.
- Dogs must be leashed, crated, or penned at all times outside your room, except when showing in an obedience or agility ring. Dogs are not permitted to be bathed or groomed in the guestrooms at any time.
- A maximum of four (4) dogs per room.
- Dogs must be cleaned up after. Please contact the hotel's front desk if you need to clean up inside the hotel or your room. Clean up supplies will be furnished to you. You will be responsible for any additional cleaning charges, if applicable.
- No dogs are permitted in the restrooms, restaurant, or pool areas. Observe and obey signs – some areas of the hotel grounds are off-limits to dogs. Please respect posted signs and staff directions regarding designated areas.
- Maid service is required each day.
- Owners must pick up outdoor exercise areas after use by their dogs. Scoopers or (preferably) plastic baggies need to be deposited in designated trash cans only. The hotel will provide a maximum of 3 large lined trash containers. Additional trash containers will be at the clubs expense. Each garbage can will be emptied 4 times a day by Red Lion Hotel Staff.
- NO dog "marking" permitted. Please be constantly aware of the natural territorial instincts and do not permit your dog to 'mark' (urinate on) walls, furniture, decor, or other inappropriate indoor objects or furnishings. If you do have an accident, please ask the front desk for assistance.

## **RV RESERVATIONS:**

A limited number of RV Parking spots are available on the hotel grounds. RV spots with electricity and water available are \$50.00 per day. **NOTE: TRANSFER OF ENTRIES AND REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS FOR PUBLISHED JUDGE CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 20. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.**

**CONFORMATION:** Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

**OBEDIENCE OR RALLY:** A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class; or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible provided the club offers transfers. Transfers from an "A" to "B" class at the same level are allowed provided the host club allows transfers. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Superintendent or Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Clubs may choose to accept transfers prior to the day of the trial and this should be clearly stated in the premium list. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit.

# AKC Code of Sportsmanship

## PREFACE:

*The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.*

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
