



The New Highway 26 Bypass is open around Jefferson.
FROM (IOWA & SOUTHWEST WISCONSIN): US 12 East/US 18 East to US 18 East. Turn Left on US 18 East. US 18 East to N Jackson Ave. Turn Left on N Jackson Ave.
FROM SOUTH (INTERSTATE I-90/I-39): Hwy 26 North to new Hwy 26 Bypass. Take Exit Hwy 18 (Cambridge/Jefferson Exit). Turn Right on Hwy 18. Turn Left on N Jackson Ave.
FROM WEST/EAST (INTERSTATE I-94): I-94 West to Exit 267 (Hwy 26/Johnson Creek/Watertown Exit) Turn Left on Hwy 26 South to new Hwy 26 Bypass. Take Exit Business Hwy 26. Turn Left on Business Hwy 26. Take Right on W Puerner Street.
