TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

NOTE: TRANSFER OF ENTRIES AND REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS FOR PUBLISHED JUDGE CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON WEDNESDAY, MAY 25. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent prior to the start of the class at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent prior to the judging of the class at the show.

OBEDIENCE OR RALLY: A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class; or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible provided the club offers transfers. Transfers from an "A" to "B" class at the same level are allowed provided the host club allows transfers. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Superintendent or Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Clubs may choose to accept transfers prior to the day of the trial and this should be clearly stated in the premium list. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit.

Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment and subject to disciplinary hearing.

GENERAL INFORMATION

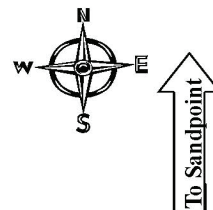
- All parking is a privilege extended by the show-giving club & the Kootenai County Fairgrounds. They reserve the right to withdraw this privilege from any person who uses abusive language, argues with parking personnel or attempts to circumvent the rules & regulations. All parking is at your own risk. Violators will be towed at owner's expense. The show-giving club & the Fairgrounds assume no responsibility or liability for damages or loss to any vehicle or its cargo.
- Dogs are NOT ALLOWED in any landscaped area at the Fairgrounds. Failure to observe the rules may result in an Event Hearing.
- Everyone using this facility is expected to keep & leave the area clean. Everyone must police their area prior to leaving & pick up all trash, this includes dog hair & cigarette butts.
- Limited handicap parking (with a valid permit) is available for both the general & reserved parking areas. These spaces will have easy access but may be some distance from the show rings. Please send a copy of your handicap permit with your parking reservation.
- In case of emergency, a member of the Show Committee will be available at all times.
- ALL OVERNIGHT PARKING UNITS MUST BE SELF-CONTAINED. No dumping of gray water or sewage. All units must have own fire extinguisher on board.
- NO PARKING IN FIRELANES OR ANY AREA NOT DESIGNATED FOR RESERVED OR DAY PARKING. Violators will be towed at owner's expense.
- IF IT IS NECESSARY TO RESCUE AN UNATTENDED DOG FROM A PARKED CAR OR CRATE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS, THE CLUB & THE FAIRGROUNDS WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE OR LIABLE FOR ANY DAMAGE TO THE VEHICLE INVOLVED.
- All vehicles must vacate the premises no later than two hours following Best in Show on Tuesday. Anyone wishing to stay Tuesday night, should contact the Fairgrounds.
- All parking fees must be paid in US funds.
- Once vehicles have been unloaded/loaded, they must be moved to the day parking area. Your cooperation is appreciated.

DAY PARKING

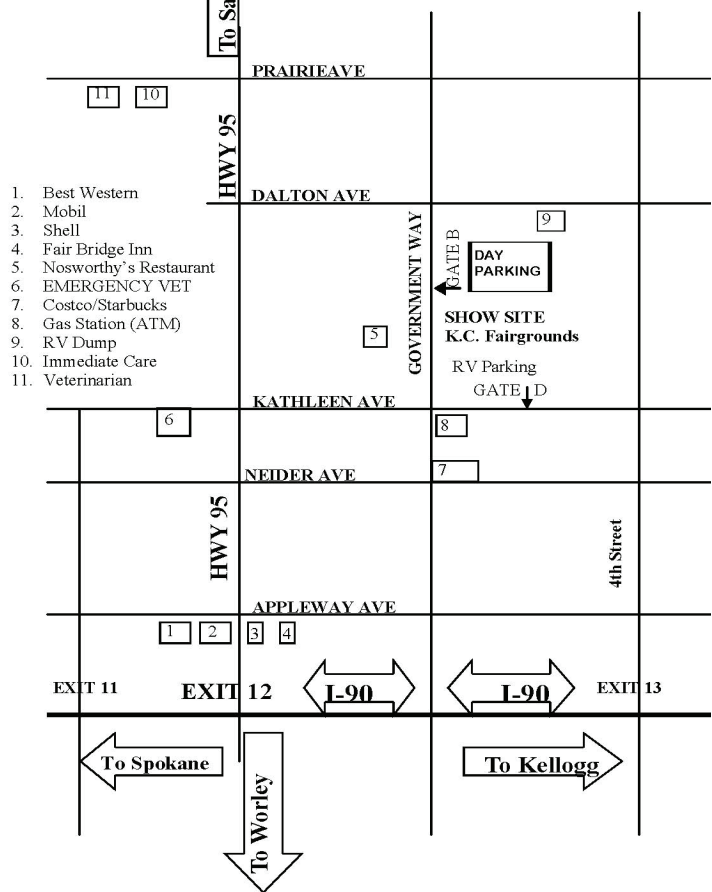
- Available in EAST Lot. ENTER FROM GATE C ONLY (C gate off Kathleen Ave).
- NO OVERNIGHT PARKING IN THE GENERAL DAY PARKING AREA.** Gates will be locked TWO hours after Best in Show.
- Cars left in fire lanes will be towed.**

RESERVED RV PARKING

- Those with reserved parking for Overnight RV & Premium Parking lot will enter thru Gate D, off of Kathleen Ave.
- All vehicles must park as directed by the parking attendants.
- All generators MUST be shut off & dogs kept quiet from 10:30PM - until 6:00AM. Violations may result in an Event Hearing.
- Please note that due to changes of landscaping and building additions by the fairgrounds parking assignments may not be the same as previous years.

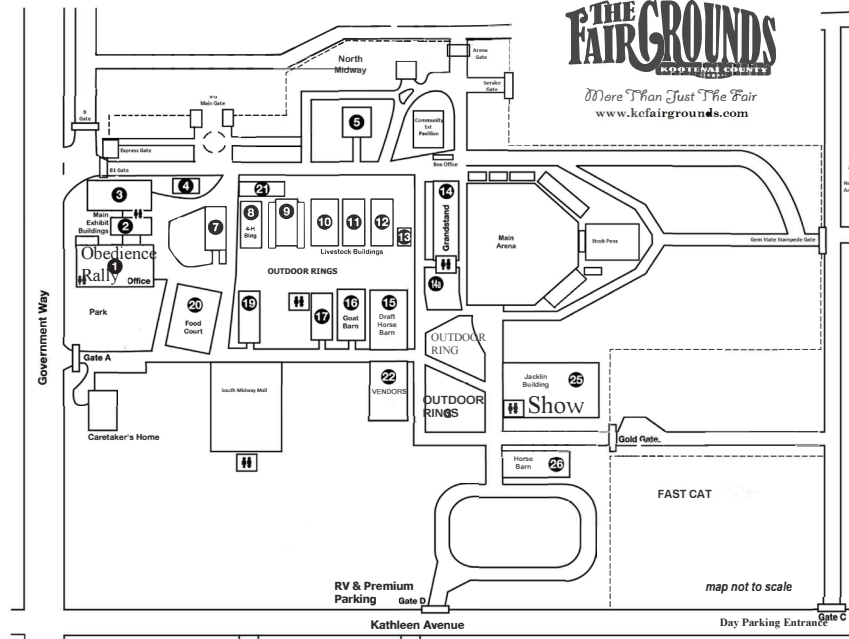

GROOMING

No exercise pens in the grooming area.

There will be NO GROOMING ALLOWED in the Jacklin Building. This will be strictly enforced.

The Show Committee reserves the right to assign all the reserved grooming spaces. No dogs will be left overnight in reserved or in free grooming areas.

All grooming setup will start on Sunday at 3:00PM. Spaces must be accepted as assigned. All grooming spaces must be cleaned and vacated by 1 hour after Best in Show Tuesday.

CDADF will not be held responsible for personal belongings left unattended.

EXHIBITORS - PLEASE NOTE

No grooming, no blowers, no fans in the show building.

- Grooming only in the designated grooming areas, RV section or parking lot. No grooming in grassy areas.
- Overnight parking only in the Paid RV section.
- RV spaces without advance reservations \$60 per night, electric if available.
- All equipment must be removed every night in the Day Parking Lot per Expo regulations.
- RV RESERVATIONS & PAYMENT MAY BE COMPLETED ONLINE AT: www.cdadogfanciers.org Contact CDA Dog Fanciers at cdadogshow@gmail.com if you have questions regarding RV Parking. Day Parking will be through Gate C on Kathleen Ave. The fee is \$5 per day, exact change preferred.
- Grooming set ups found in non-designated areas will be removed to be in compliance with Expo Center rules.
- Show Site is Handicapped Accessible.
- Indoor restrooms and showers are available.
- First Responder will be onsite.
- IT IS STRICTLY UNDERSTOOD THAT ALL CHILDREN ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THEIR PARENTS AND WILL BE SUPERVISED AND UNDER THEIR CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.
- Please turn off cell phones and/or pagers before entering rings.
- NO CRATES ALLOWED IN THE AISLES.
- No seating will be provided.
- KNOW YOUR ARMBAND NUMBER(S) PRIOR TO COMING RINGSIDE.
- No permanent crating anywhere in the Conformation building. Crates are allowed ringside during breed judging.
- Crates **MUST** be removed immediately after judging. The show committee reserves the right to remove any crate from the building. Obedience and Rally are only allowed in building while competing.
- Due to the constantly changing requirements we will post the most updated information related to rules in the Judging Program and the club website www.cdadogfanciers.org

Dogs may not be left in the building.

The order of the day will be determined in the judging program.

No dogs in buildings overnight.

You will need to remove your personal chairs following breed judging.

Please be mindful, if you are done showing and the building is looking crowded, take a break leave the building and visit the Vendor area and come back if you want to observe.

IF A SHOW OFFICIAL ASKS YOU TO LEAVE A BUILDING PLEASE DO SO WITHOUT ARGUMENT.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- BUILDINGS will be open at 7:00AM and will close each day after Best in Show or completion of specialty/special events, unless otherwise noted in the judging program.
- THROUGHOUT THE BUILDINGS: All chairs, crates, and accessories must be placed within designated areas and must not block aisles, door exits, or fire extinguishers. Dogs must be on leash at all times.
- No flexi-leads on show grounds.
- Vehicles left in fire lanes will be towed.
- NO UNENTERED DOGS ALLOWED IN CONFORMATION & OBEDIENCE OR RALLY AREAS.
- EXHIBIT HALLS: No grooming. Your crates may be placed in designated areas during the judging of your breed, but must be removed upon completion of your breed judging.
- DOG WASHING: There will be dog washing facilities available at these events.
- Any equipment left at ringside will be collected by CDADF and may be returned at owners expense. All items not claimed may become property of CDADF. • No Paid Reserved or Free Grooming spaces.
- Please be prepared for seasonal or warm weather.
- Obedience & Rally Building: Due to limited space there will be NO SETUPS.
- Loading and unloading areas are extremely limited. Exhibitors are to keep parking blinkers on and are limited to 15 minutes.

USE OF RAMPS - ALL BREEDS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, American Water Spaniels, Boykin Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Grand Basset Griffon Vendeen, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs, and Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Whippets, Miniature Bull Terriers.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp, or on a table: Mudi.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirneco dell'Etna, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows and Keeshonden.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (01/2022)



SUGGESTED BEST PRACTICES FOR THE WELL-BEING OF DOG SPORT PARTICIPANTS

The AKC supports each club's informed decision to reschedule, postpone or cancel their respective events, as well as supporting clubs ready to hold events in locations that are open and permit gatherings. As events resume across the country, people need to feel safe while enjoying their dog activities. The AKC urges clubs to take appropriate precautions for the benefit of their participants. Events need to be held in a manner that emphasizes the safety of participants and event officials over efficiency.

The following is a list of suggested best practices that may be helpful when planning or attending an event. Event locations, facilities and dates will differ. With a situation that is continually evolving, it is up to the clubs to determine the guidelines that best fit their event. In order to inform participants, specific guidelines established by the club/cluster should be published in the premium, show catalog, club website and posted on signage/flyers at their event.

GENERAL PRACTICES

- Clubs, officials and participants are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is held.
- Practice social distancing consistent with guidelines in effect at the time of the event. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
- Wash hands as frequently as possible. Have disinfecting spray at bathroom facilities for people to spray door handles (or anything else they touch).
- Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact.
- Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
- Avoid common use pens/pencils - bring your own.
- Meals - Participants should consider bringing their own lunch/drinks.
- Vendors should follow retail guidelines for the area.
- Parking - Park with sufficient distance between vehicles if possible. Please bring exact change \$5.00
- Indoor show sites should work with facilities to have as many entrance/exits points open as possible. Hand sanitizer should be available at every entrance to the site and at multiple locations within the site.
- Parking/unloading staff should wear face coverings and sanitize their hands following the assistance of each individual.
- Prepare to be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, bring a generator for electricity, bring personal use face coverings
- Know the armband numbers for your entries before going to the ring. Bring rubber bands or arm- band clips to secure armband.
- Do not congregate at the ring or ring gate.
- While showing your dog, maintain social distances with other exhibitors.
- All classes should be called in catalog order to provide order and efficiency.
- Judges are to have the exhibitor display the oral exam and may personally examine the mouth ONLY if absolutely necessary. By the nature of the procedure, judges must conduct thumb exams.
- Judges should sanitize hands after examining each entry. Re-examining of dogs should be minimized
- Judges are encouraged to personally pull ribbons for placements. Coupled with frequent hand sanitizing, this will help mitigate contact exposure.
- Participants are expected to follow state, local government, facility and event guidelines. Clubs should be prepared to enforce the guidelines that apply to their event. The conformation field reps will assist as always in an advisory capacity.
