DIRECTIONS TO THE HOST HOTEL

FROM BILLINGS/ BILLINGS LOGAN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT: Take I-90 West towards Bozeman. In 11 miles take exit 434 for US-212/US-310 toward Laurel/Red Lodge. Turn left onto US-212 W/US-310 E. In 44 miles, at the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit onto US-212 W/Broadway Ave N. Continue 6.4 miles and the destination is on your left.

FROM BOZEMAN: Take I-90 East towards Billings. In 98 miles take exit 408 for State Rte 78 toward Columbus. Turn right onto MT-78 S/State Rte 78 S. Turn right onto Old U.S. 10/E Pike Ave. Turn left after NAPA Auto Parts - H & L Auto Supply Inc (on the right). Turn left onto Joliet Rd. In 8.8 miles continue onto State Hwy 421. In 9.3 miles turn right onto US-212 W. In 24.7 miles, at the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit onto US-212 W/Broadway Ave N. Continue 6.4 miles and the destination is on your left.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE
