ROUTES TO THE SHOW

Do not use Lake Holm Road. It has load restrictions and tight turns that make it impossible for an RV.

From I-5 or Highway 167: Take Highway 18 heading EAST. From Highway 18 (either direction), take the Auburn Black Diamond exit. At the stop sign, turn Right onto Auburn Black Diamond Road. Continue on Auburn Black Diamond Road for 7.6 miles until you get to intersection of 218th Avenue SE. Turn Right and cross SE Green Valley Road. Run Wild Dog Sports & Training Center will be on your left.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE Effective immediately, AKC's new Unattended Dogs in Vehicles Policy prohibits leaving dogs unattended in vehicles that are fully enclosed or do not have adequate ventilation and airflow. Simply having fans, air conditioning, temperature monitors, remote alerts, or other electronic devices does not, by themselves, make a vehicle safe for an unattended dog. Owners and handlers are responsible for ensuring dogs are kept in conditions that protect them from heat-related illness, distress, injury, or death. TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

NOTE: TRANSFER OF ENTRIES AND REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS FOR PUBLISHED JUDGE CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON MONDAY, JULY 27, 2026. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent prior to the start of the class at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent prior to the judging of the class at the show.

PARKING INFORMATION

Parking for this weekend is a privilege extended by WWH and Run Wild Dog Sports & Training Center. (RWDS). WWH and RWDS reserve the right to withdraw this privilege from any person who abuses it. OBEY ALL PARKING SIGNS. All parking staff are volunteer YOUTH and their advisors from SOTA BOTS. Thank you for treating them with courtesy. Abusive language and actions towards the parking attendants **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. NO EXCUSES, NO SECOND CHANCES.** This is a benchable offense and may result in dismissal from the show with no refund.

1. Parking is at your own risk. Neither WWH, RWDS, the Specialty Clubs nor the Superintendent assumes any responsibility or liability for damage or loss to any vehicle, its contents or dogs.
2. All parking is to be on the show grounds.
3. Gates will open at 7:00AM and close at 11:00PM Friday thru Sunday.
4. Unloading in designated areas only. Observe all time limits.
5. Handicap parking: both day and overnight spaces will be available on a limited basis. Overnight RV reservations must be accompanied by a copy of disabled parking permit.
6. A Signed Agreement and payment of fees are required for any overnight parking INCLUDING VEHICLES PARKED OVERNIGHT IN DAY SPACES. Payment is due at time of reservation.

DAY PARKING: \$5.00 per day.

HANDICAP PARKING: Enter in Parking field off of 212th Way SE

LOAD/UNLOAD: Enter Parking field for rings 3, 4 & 5 or Main Gate for rings 1 & 2.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS NOTE: Fees must be paid in US dollars or check drawn on a US bank account. You may NOT mark "pay in US funds" as our bank will NOT process these checks. Contact parking chair with any questions.

Generators: A Genturi exhaust system must be used for all on board generators in use and the exhaust directed above the RV. All stand alone generators must be on a fire prevention mat and the exhaust directed away from neighbors.

Electricity: Run Wild has limited electricity supplying all the electrical hook up RV spaces. No AC or large draw appliances are allowed to be run off the Run Wild power grid so the circuits won't be tripped.
