TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

NOTE: TRANSFER OF ENTRIES AND REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS FOR PUBLISHED JUDGE CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON MONDAY, DECEMBER 30. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent prior to the start of the class at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent prior to the judging of the class at the show.



Unloading Instructions

Please note that we have different unloading zones at the Tinley Park Convention Center, depending on which grooming area you are going to be in.

RESERVED GROOMING SECTIONS 1 (ROWS A-R) AND OVERFLOW RESERVED GROOMING IN THE SAMUEL TINLEY ROOM:

Unloading for these areas will be on the North Dock. When you arrive at the convention center, follow signage for unloading with **BLACK ARROWS**. Note: As you enter the Convention Center on Harlem Ave., Turn left at the light at 183rd St. Go through one more stop light (Convention Center Dr) and take the next right. Proceed Straight to the North Dock.

RESERVED GROOMING SECTION 2 (ROWS S-U) and OPEN GROOMING:

Unloading for the smaller reserved grooming section, reserved grooming OF 1-10 and **ALL** open grooming will be at the South Dock. This includes rows S-U (this includes the reserved area for Bernese Mountain Dogs). When you arrive at the Tinley Park Convention Center, follow signage with **RED ARROWS**. Note that you will have to circle around behind the Even Hotel to the back of the Convention Center in order to reach the South Dock

CAT EXHIBITORS:

Follow the **BLUE ARROWS** on the map. All cat unloading should happen through the North Entrance.

NOTE: There is NO dog unloading through the North or West Entrances. The North Entrance is used for Ca Exhibitors ONLY.

Important Reminders

No equipment on wheels (dollies, crates, etc.) will be allowed through the South Entrance on the front side of the building. You MUST unload via either the North or South loading docks. This is the policy of the convention center and there will be no exceptions. Dogs may be WALKED through the front South Entrance doors.

Bathing tubs will be located on the North Dock in a heated area. These tubs will be first come, first served, when available. Please keep the bathing area clean.

The building will be open and available to exhibitors at 3:00PM on Thursday, January 1. The building will close at 10:00PM Thursday-Saturday and reopen at 6:00AM.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors after 3:00PM on Thursday, January 1, 2026. Building will close at 10:00PM Thursday through Saturday & buildings reopen at 6:00AM Friday through Sunday.

No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these shows.

Dogs found to be in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment.

COOK COUNTY FIRE REGULATIONS PROHIBIT THE USE OF AND/OR ENTRY OF RED GASOLINE CANS OR YELLOW DIESEL FUEL CANS INSIDE ANY PUBLIC BUILDINGS, ANY SUCH CAN WILL BE CONFISCATED BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE OWNER WILL BE ESCORTED OFF THE SHOW SITE. (Water MUST be in Approved Water Container).

- A Night Watchman will be on duty Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights; However dogs are left at owners risk.
- Only Intoxicating Beverages purchased from the Convention Center are permitted.
- SMOKING IS PROHIBITED IN ALL BUILDINGS.
- All Crates must be stacked and there is no room for any unentered dogs.
- Exhibitors/Handlers MUST have plastic sheeting under AND around exercise pens. Plastic sheeting will not be provided. Any pens without sheeting will be taken down.
- No sawdust in any indoor Ex-Pen. All Private Ex-Pens will be indoors in a designated area. All grooming is in a carpeted room. NO Ex-Pens allowed in the Grooming Area.
- ALL EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CLEAN UP OF THEIR OWN DOGS IN THE RING, BUILDING AND OUTSIDE ON THE PROPERTY.
- When unloading or loading, exhibitors, dogs and equipment must enter only from 1 of the 2 loading dock areas. DO NOT drive up the ramps or unload/load from the turn around areas outside the front of the Convention Center.
- · DAY PARKING IS FREE.
- Medical Professional, if available, will be on the grounds.
- SHOW SITE & RESTROOMS ARE HANDICAPPED ACCESSIBLE.
- PLEASE TURN OFF CELL PHONES AND/OR PAGERS BEFORE ENTERING RINGS.
- NO SOFT SIDED CRATES WITHIN 10' OF ANY RING, AISLES MUST BE KEPT CLEAR OF OBSTACLES. ALL GROOMING TABLES AND CRATES MUST BE IN MARKED GROOMING AREAS ONLY.
- EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE for all property damage caused by them at hotels or Show Grounds and will be charged accordingly.
- DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A SHORT LEASH. NO FLEXI-LEADS!
