TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES AND REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS FOR PUBLISHED JUDGE CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 17. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SHOW SECRETARY ON SITE.

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

OBEDIENCE OR RALLY: A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class; or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible provided the club offers transfers. Transfers from an "A" to "B" class at the same level are allowed provided the host club allows transfers. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Superintendent or Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Clubs may choose to accept transfers prior to the day of the trial and this should be clearly stated in the premium list. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

REFER TO PREMIUM FOR COMPLETE LIST OF RULES & REGULATIONS

- The Event Center will be available to Conformation/Obedience/Rally exhibitors on Thursday, January 18 from 4:00PM - 6:00PM.
- There are NO night time security personnel on site. NO DOGS will be allowed to remain in the building overnight.
- All exhibitors MUST abide by the 15 minute unloading/loading parking time limit designated around the Event Center. All vehicles must leave their headlights on while unloading. NO VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED NEXT TO BUILDING OR IN ANY ROADWAY. VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.
- **OVERNIGHT RV PARKING** - Refer to information in the Premium - RV Parking Reservation section. RV parking in the upper lot of the Event Center will be available starting 9:00AM on Thursday, January 18. All RV and Day parking vehicles must vacate the RV Parking area by 6:00 pm on Sunday, January 22, 2024. Lower RV lot is available Thursday, January 18, 2024. Handicapped parking is available in areas marked.
- **ACCESS** - A Security Guard will be present at the gate to allow access to the facility from 7:00AM to 8:00PM. From 8 pm to midnight gates are closed, but access to and from the facility is still possible. The exit gate automatically opens to allow guests to leave. A Security Guard will be at the gate each hour, on the hour, during this time to allow overnight guests back onto the premises. Between the hours of midnight and 7 am, the gates are closed.
