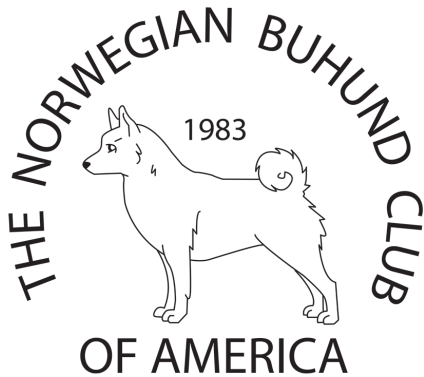

**ROUTES TO THE SHOW**

**FROM INTERSTATE 15 North** - Take exit 280 (Central Ave West) off ramp. Travel east to 6th St SW. Turn left at light, heading north approx. 1/2 mile. Turn right at Dog Show Entrance into EXPO PARK west gate.

**FROM INTERSTATE 15 South** - Take exit 280 (Central Ave West) off ramp. Travel east to 6th St SW. Turn left at light, heading north approx. 1/2 mile. Turn right at Dog Show Entrance into EXPO PARK west gate.

**FROM HIGHWAY 89 SOUTH** - Follow 10th Avenue S approx. 6 1/2 miles. Turn right on 6th St SW. Turn right at Dog Show Entrance into EXPO PARK west gate.

**FROM HIGHWAY 89 NORTH** - Turn right at Smelter Ave NE. Follow it around to the 6th traffic light (approx. 1 mile). Turn right on NW By Pass. Go to next traffic light (1/2 mile) & turn left onto 6th St NW. Go approx. .2 mile & turn left at Dog Show Entrance into EXPO PARK west gate.

**USE OF RAMPS – NORWEGIAN BUHUNDS**

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, Norwegian Buhunds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition.

This extends to all competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (01/2021)

**TRANSFER OF ENTRIES**

*NOTE: TRANSFER OF ENTRIES AND REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS FOR PUBLISHED JUDGE CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON XXXXX, XXXXX 00. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.*

**CONFORMATION:** Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

**JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP:** Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent prior to the start of the class at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent prior to the judging of the class at the show.

The clubs reserve the right to withdraw this privilege from any persons who feel they cannot abide by the rules & regulations or who resort to abusive language. All parking is at your own risk. - ◆ Parking in assigned spaces only. For safety reasons, no setups or extra vehicles may be in the alleyways between rows. No extra vehicles in reserved parking spaces.
- ◆ As per our agreement with the fairgrounds, there will be a charge for all overnight/reserved parking. No overnight parking will be allowed in the fairground park or picnic areas. No setups in or around the picnic shelters.
- ◆ In consideration of other exhibitors, there will be no use of generators between 10:00PM & 6:30AM.
- ◆ Day parking is free.
- ◆ Grooming space is limited.
- ◆ NOTE: There will be no exercise pens or grooming setups in the show building. Crating will be allowed near the ring as space permits during judging of your breed, but must be removed after judging is completed.

## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors after 2:00PM, Friday. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Tuesday. Building will be closed at 12:00AM and will open at 6:00AM. All gates except West gate are locked by 11:00PM.

**NO CRATES should be left ringside after showing.**

Limited Indoor Grooming. (No X-pens in grooming building). Grooming building will be closed at night. Electric City Kennel Club accepts no responsibility for lost or stolen items.

Grooming building will be closed at midnight. No security in building at night.

Please reserve your space if you want to assure a grooming spot. Space is limited.

No dogs are to be left overnight in building.

Shower and bathrooms open until midnight. There will be no security in the building at night.
