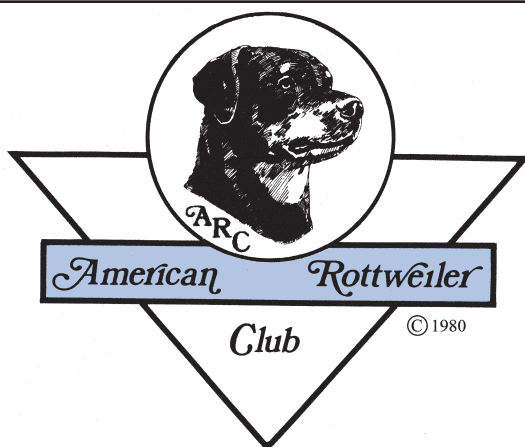

#### ROUTES TO THE SHOW

Both Northbound & Southbound on I-5, Take Chehalis Exit #79, Chambers Way, Turn East off the exit onto Chamber Way.

• Go to the second stop light and turn left onto National Avenue, which is a one-way street going north. National Avenue turns into Kresky Avenue.

• For the North Parking Lot, continue north on Kresky Avenue and turn left on Fair Street, then left on Gold Street. The North Parking Lot will be on the right side. Overnight Parking will enter through the North Gate, no Day Parking will be allowed in the North End gate. Day Parking will enter through a gate at the SOUTH end. You will be directed to unload or day parking. No dog show Parking will be allowed in the marked off Gun Show parking lot.

## ATTENTION ALL ATTENDEES

There is **NO SMOKING** on the **SOUTHWEST WASHINGTON FAIRGROUNDS**

Per Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 70.160.030 Smoking is prohibited in Public Places. "Smoke" or "smoking" means carrying or smoking of any kind of lighted pipe, cigar, cigarette, or any lighted or electronic smoking equipment. Under RCW 69.50.445 it is unlawful to open a package containing marijuana, useable marijuana, marijuana-infused products, or marijuana concentrates, or consume marijuana, useable marijuana, marijuana-infused products, or marijuana concentrates, in view of the general public or in a public place.

## TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

**NOTE: BECAUSE OF TRAVEL TIME TO THE SHOW SITE, TRANSFER OF ENTRIES AND REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS FOR PUBLISHED JUDGE CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON TUESDAY, SEPT. 14. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.**

**CONFORMATION:** Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

**JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP:** Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent prior to the start of the class at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent prior to the judging of the class at the show.

## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS & VENDORS

- The Show Site will be available to exhibitors and vendors on Thursday, at 3:00PM.
- Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday.
- NO ROLLER BLADES, SKATEBOARDS, OR BICYCLES ON FAIRGROUNDS.
- NO PARKING AGAINST ANY BUILDING ON FAIRGROUNDS.
- **No vendor or exhibitor vehicles may be driven on the Show limits during Show hours.**
- Exhibitors and vendors must vacate Fairgrounds by 7:00PM on Sunday.
- Smoking (lighted pipe, cigar, cigarette, or any other lighted or electronic smoking equipment,) or use of marijuana, or marijuana-infused products on the Southwest Washington Fairgrounds public places are **UNLAWFUL and STRICTLY PROHIBITED** per RCW 70.160.030 and RCW 69.50.445.
