From Makaha, Waianae: Take Farrington Hwy. toward Honolulu. The destination is on the right.

COVID-19: Exhibitors, judges, volunteers and spectators will be required to comply with all Facility, Local, and State mandates in place at the time of the event.

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

NOTE: TRANSFER OF ENTRIES AND REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS FOR PUBLISHED JUDGE CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 16. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent prior to the start of the class at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Grooming tables under the judging tents will only be allowed just prior to ring time. The grounds are to be cleared of all exhibitors and dogs 1 hour after Best in Show judging on Saturday. On Sunday, the grounds are to be cleared of all exhibitors, dogs and setups 1 hour after Best in Show judging.

NO RESERVED EXHIBITOR TENTING

There will be no reserved tenting space except as assigned by the Event Committee for show personnel and vendors.

Absolutely no vehicles will be allowed on the field at any time except:

- 3. Truck with tents/tables/chairs
- 4. Vendors to load and unload (30 minute limit)

Due to the limited Grounds space, Large Commercial tenting cannot be accommodated.

TRASH NOTICE

Before leaving the show grounds each day, grooming and setup areas must be cleared of hair and trash. Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own trash bags and removing their trash.

MEDICAL STANDBY

FOOD CONCESSION

The Board is pleased to announce that there will be a FOOD CONCESSION TRUCK for the convenience of exhibitors on the show grounds both days. Bring your own shade, but make sure it is staked down. It may get very breezy and unsecured canopies can easily be twisted or blown away. No food of any kind should be left at your setup overnight. Mongoose and loose dogs are known to prowl the area.

SHOW SAFETY: RESPONSIBILITY OF EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors are charged with absolute responsibility for the control of their dogs throughout the period the dogs are on the show grounds, including rings, grooming areas and common areas. No delegation of such duty of control given to another shall relieve the Exhibitor of the ultimate responsibility to control his or her dog's behavior. As used herein, "control" shall require of an Exhibitor the taking of such affirmative action and effort as may be necessary to preclude the dog from demonstrating against or evidencing aggressive behavior toward or attacking or biting or threatening to attack or bite, any other Exhibitor, dog, member of the public or Show Official. Exhibitors are particularly cautioned to appreciate that patrons of dog shows, particularly children, whether in the company of an adult or otherwise, are frequently unaware that an innocent touching may erroneously be perceived by the dog as a threat leading to defensive conduct and a loss of control by the Exhibitor. The effort required of an Exhibitor to retain control shall therefore include the need for the giving of preventive warning to all who may approach the dog in a manner that is likely to incite unwanted behavior. The giving of such warning, however, shall not be deemed to release or relieve the Exhibitor from all further duty to keep his or her dog under control at all times.

In furtherance of the foregoing and without limitation upon the ultimate responsibility of the Exhibitor for control, dogs shall be kept on leash or crated throughout the Shows. Exhibitors shall promptly and affirmatively respond to all instructions or orders regarding show safety directed or called to the attention of the Exhibitor by a Show Official. No debate or argument with such Show Official shall be permitted. Though it is the intent of these rules to avoid any untoward incident from occurring, the inadequacy of any rule or regulation to accomplish such purpose shall not serve to release or relieve the Exhibitor from the responsibility of control over his or her dog. Exhibitors are charged with full awareness and knowledge of the behavior of their respective dogs and are expected to respond accordingly.
