IMPORTANT HOTEL INFORMATION

- All dogs **MUST** be crated when left unattended in the Hotel guest rooms. ***Leaving loose and unattended dogs in hotels rooms shall be reported to the Show Chairman who shall determine the need for disciplinary action which may include a fine and/or an Event Committee hearing.***
- Plastic is required under all crates. Exhibitors are responsible for **BRINGING THEIR OWN PLASTIC!**
- There is a limit of 4 dogs per room at any given time.
- All exhibitors & guests are expected to maintain clean conditions & use good housekeeping habits in all areas. This includes the show site, guest rooms & hotel grounds. In addition, all exhibitors & guests are expected to abide by all posted restrictions & regulations. Those who do not comply are subject to possible expulsion from the show site and/or hotel premises, as well as subject to a show hearing in accordance with AKC Rules & Regulations Applying to Dog Shows in Dealing with Misconduct.
- Hotel guest rooms will be cleaned daily - **NO EXCEPTIONS**. The Hotel staff will do a walk-through of each room at check-in & check-out.
- Dogs may **NOT** be bathed or groomed in the guest rooms.
- Housekeeping must have access to rooms daily and will report anyone who is not in compliance. All grooming must be done in the grooming areas, there will be an outside dog bathing area.
- Dogs are not allowed in the front lobby, hallway past the dining room, courtyard areas, pool areas, or in the landscaping near the building.
- Exercise areas will be clearly marked.
- There will be Grooming Area Available at the Show.

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

NOTE: TRANSFER OF ENTRIES AND REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS FOR PUBLISHED JUDGE CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON FRIDAY, MAY 6. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE EVENT SECRETARY ON SITE.

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent prior to the start of the class at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent prior to the judging of the class at the show.

OBEDIENCE OR RALLY: A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class; or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible provided the club offers transfers. Transfers from an "A" to "B" class at the same level are allowed provided the host club allows transfers. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Superintendent or Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Clubs may choose to accept transfers prior to the day of the trial and this should be clearly stated in the premium list. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit.

Pee Wee Class Entry Form - No Entry Fee

- For kids from 5- 9 years of age (with a parent or guardian).
- Dog must be at least six (6) months of age to enter.
- All dogs must have proper leash and collar.

The Special Attraction to follow regular class judging when ring becomes available. An announcement will be made regarding the start time. Entries are in person up to the start of Pee Wee Class judging on Friday, May 13, 2022. There is NO entry fee. There is no limit on number of teams. All participants will receive a ribbon and prize.

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship Class for children who are at least age 5 and under age 9 years on the date of the show. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child. Each child is accompanied into the ring by a responsible adult who stays with the child at all times; only one Pee Wee Handler and one adult will be in the ring at any one time. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside the ring as well as ensure control inside the ring. A primary goal is safety and a positive experience for the children, so at the judge's discretion, the adult may be required to attach a second leash to the dog in the ring. The dog handled by the Pee Wee Handler must be at least six (6) months of age, must be an AKC registered **German Shorthaired Pointer** (including dogs with a PAL/ILP listing). Bitches in season are not allowed to participate (eligible dogs may be substituted). Dogs must have a proper leash and collar. A show lead and collar will be available at ring side if needed. An AKC licensed Junior Showmanship judge will be officiating at this event. Before a Pee Wee participant will be allowed to enter the ring, his or her parent or legal guardian must sign a Release of Liability Form. One will be provided at the show.

You do not need a Junior Showmanship number to participate.
