IMPORTANT EXHIBITOR INFORMATION
ADDITIONAL RULES INCLUDED IN PREMIUM LIST - READ IT. There is no acceptable excuse for breaking or being unfamiliar with the rules.

GROUND'S RULES

EXHIBITORS & HANDLERS will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and setup areas.

AN EXERCISE AREA will be provided. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to take care of their dogs and to clean any area soiled by their dogs.

GENERAL GROOMING set-up will be open starting at 12:00PM on Thursday, May 28, 2026. Grooming may be opened earlier once the show setup is completed. There will be NO GROOMING set-up allowed before the show set-up is completed.

ALL GENERATORS will only be allowed only at fence line setups or behind the fence in your setup. Electricity & shelters are not available at this show site so you will need to make your own arrangements for the use of a generator & easy-up shelter. Due to SAFETY, there will be NO extension cords for generators run past those setups along the fence line.

NO DOGS ALLOWED in children's playgrounds on CBA location. This risks the clubs ability to continue holding their shows on this site and the Event Committee will hold hearing(s) if anyone has not complied that is entered. Signs will be posted for everyone's attention for all dogs entered for the AHGC. The welfare of an Exhibitor's children and dog(s) is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children and dog(s) OR THEY WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOW PREMISES. (This includes disturbances as well).

SMOKING WILL BE OUTSIDE THE FENCED AREA.

NO OPEN FLAMES OR FIRES allowed in set-ups or on the field.

NO PARKING at back door entry to CBA building.

IF IT IS NECESSARY TO RESCUE A DOG from a parked car on the show grounds, the Club will not be responsible or liable for any damages to the car involved.

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

NOTE: TRANSFER OF ENTRIES AND REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS FOR PUBLISHED JUDGE CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON MONDAY, MAY 25, 2026. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent prior to the start of the class at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent prior to the judging of the class at the show.

OBEDIENCE OR RALLY: A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class; or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible provided the club offers transfers. Transfers from an "A" to "B" class at the same level are allowed provided the host club allows transfers. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Superintendent or Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Clubs may choose to accept transfers prior to the day of the trial and this should be clearly stated in the premium list. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit. For Bitches in Season, refer to General Rules in Premium List.
