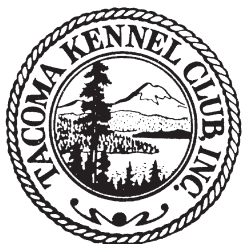

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

NOTE: TRANSFER OF ENTRIES AND REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS FOR PUBLISHED JUDGE CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON MONDAY, JULY 13, 2026. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent prior to the start of the class at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent prior to the judging of the class at the show.

OBEDIENCE OR RALLY: A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class; or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible provided the club offers transfers. Transfers from an "A" to "B" class at the same level are allowed provided the host club allows transfers. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Superintendent or Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Clubs may choose to accept transfers prior to the day of the trial and this should be clearly stated in the premium list. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit. For Bitches in Season, refer to General Rules in Premium List.

PEE WEE CLASS SPECIAL ATTRACTION

SATURDAY & SUNDAY – DURING LUNCH BREAK NO ENTRY FEE – ENTRY LIMIT: 15

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5-9 years of age. Safety is a primary concern.

Stephanie Kaul is the Saturday Pee-Wee judge.

Bryan Martin is the Sunday Pee-Wee judge.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

REGISTRATION WILL BE TAKEN AT THE CLUB TABLE DAY OF SHOW, STARTING AT 9:00AM. EACH ENTRANT WILL BE REQUIRED TO FILL OUT AN ENTRY FORM. IN ADDITION TO AN ENTRY, A RELEASE MUST BE SIGNED BY THE CHILD'S PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN. JUDGING WILL BE HELD DURING THE LUNCH BREAK. NO ENTRY FEE. ALL PEE-WEE PARTICIPANTS WILL RECEIVE A RAINBOW ROSETTE.

Pee Wee Entries are open to All Breeds, including Miscellaneous and FSS Breeds, and All-American Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program.

• Pierce County Parks are smoke-free properties. There is no smoking permitted in any indoor or outdoor spaces within the park. This includes vaping. "Smoke" or "smoking" means the carrying, holding or smoking of any kind of lighted pipe, cigar, cigarette, or any other object that is used for smoking. PCC 14.08.100

SHOW INFORMATION

- Gates will open at 7:00AM
- Each exhibitor will receive an acknowledgment of entry.
- All dogs shall be kept on leash except when in the obedience or rally rings, or being judged at dock diving, NASDA, Barn Hunt, or Fetch.
- There shall be no drilling nor intensive corrective training of dogs on the grounds or premises.
- Designated exercise areas will be clearly marked.
- No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these shows.

GROOMING INFORMATION - RESERVATIONS ARE CLOSED

RESERVED GROOMING

- Spaces are 10' x 10'
- Exercise pens are allowed
- You must provide your own shade/shelter
- Fee is \$50.00 per space for four days if paid prior to the deadline. After the deadline, the fee will be \$70.00 IN CASH paid at the show
- No electricity available, bring a generator. All generators must be placed on a plywood/fire proof surface larger than the generator. Anyone found tripping a circuit breaker will be charged \$50.00 and be subject to disciplinary action.

A bench show hearing may be called if a space is not left clean, free of dog hair and debris.

DAY-OF-SHOW GROOMING (NO FEE)

LOCATED BEHIND RESERVED GROOMING

- First-come, first-served each day
- The number of spaces is limited.
- Spaces are free/no cost
- No saving of spaces
- No exercise pens allowed
- No access to electricity/power unless you bring a generator. Generators must be placed on plywood/fire proof surface larger than the generator.
- Equipment must be removed at the end of each day; if not, equipment will be confiscated
- You must provide your own shade/shelter

A bench show hearing may be called if a space is not left clean, free of dog hair and debris.

STALL GROOMING

- Stalls are approximately 5' x 9'; located in north side of Goat and Small Equine Barns. Stalls must be accessed from outside of barn.
- Limited to 17 stalls per barn. The stalls are matted.
- Power is not available-bring a generator, All generators must be placed on a plywood/fire proof surface larger than the generator. Anyone tripping a circuit breaker will be charged \$50.00 and subject to disciplinary action.
- ***A bench show hearing may be called if a space is not left clean, free of dog hair and debris.***
- Fee is \$25.00 per stall for four days if paid prior to the deadline. After the deadline the fee will be \$45.00 IN CASH paid at the show.

GENERAL RULES

- No dogs may be left overnight at any grooming setup.
- Grooming and crating area aisles must remain open at all times; if equipment exceeds the boundary of the grooming spot it will be moved.
- Exercise pens are allowed only in the reserved grooming areas,
- Generators are only allowed in grooming areas. All generators must be placed on a plywood/fire proof surface larger than the generator.
- NO GENERATORS ALLOWED ON THE FRONT LAWN.
- Bathing stations are available with 2 hoses.

GROOMING SET UP/TAKE DOWN

- NO ACCESS FOR SET UP PRIOR TO THURSDAY, AT 2 PM
- Thursday set up runs from 2 PM to 7 PM
- Access to the grooming areas on Friday thru Sunday is from 7AM to 7PM
- Grooming set ups must be removed no later than 7 PM on Sunday.
- A bench show hearing may be called if a space is not left clean, free of dog hair, and clear of debris.
- Reservation forms postmarked/emailed after the deadline will be charged an additional \$20. Refer to the Premium List for Grooming Reservation Form.
- No refunds after the deadline.

RV PARKING INFORMATION

1. Spaces are reserved and assigned on a first paid basis. Reservations close July 5, 2026. No refunds after July 5, 2026.
2. Spaces are approximately 20' x 40' (width x length). If a larger space is needed, an additional space must be reserved and paid for. Parking for RV and one tow vehicle is allowed at each space. Additional vehicles, and oversized tow vehicles, must be parked elsewhere on the show grounds and will be charged an additional \$10 per day.
3. Handicap RV parking must be reserved in advance. There are a limited number of spaces available to holders of a current state-issued handicap parking permit. A copy of this permit must be included with your parking request. Please mail your request early - space is limited. When these spaces are filled, the remaining requests will be assigned to regular spaces in the order they are received.
4. Requests to park together must be submitted in the same envelope.
5. Parking lot will open at 1:00PM on Thursday. Gates will open Friday, Saturday, and Sunday at 7:00AM and close Thursday through Saturday at 10:00PM. On Sunday, gates will close one hour after Best in Show.
6. To access RV Parking, you MUST use the NORTH gate. The North gate is the ONLY gate that will be open to vehicles. DO NOT BLOCK traffic on Meridian. RVs that cannot turn into the park due to traffic at the North gate will need to lay over elsewhere until traffic has cleared at the North gate.
7. Parking personnel will gladly assist you in locating your space and answering any questions you may have. They will NOT reassign spaces. Parking is a privilege extended by the Tacoma Kennel Club, Inc. and the Club reserves the right to withdraw this privilege from any person who feels he/she cannot abide by the rules and instructions of our Parking Crew, or who resorts to abusive language and/or other tactics. There will be no refund of fees. Failure to abide by Parking Personnel instructions may also result in an Event Committee hearing according to AKC Rules & Regulations.
8. Persons arriving without an RV reservation will be charged \$75 cash per night, for a 20' x 40' space, subject to availability.
9. Power for RVs: **No power available**. Exhibitors must use onboard or portable generators for air conditioners and blowers/dryers. All exhaust must be directed away from other campsites, preferably up. Generators must be placed on plywood, or another fire-proof surface, which is larger than the generator.
10. No dumping of grey water or sewage. Violators will be fined \$500.
11. All camping areas must be cleaned before departure. Failure to leave your camping spot clean may result in denial of the privilege at future shows.
12. FIRE LANES, DESIGNATED PARKING ZONES, NO PARKING ZONES & LOADING ZONES WILL BE STRICTLY MAINTAINED. Violators will be towed without notice at their expense.

DAY PARKING INFORMATION

Parking is a privilege extended by Tacoma KC.
