EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE - RINGS LOCATION

- **The facilities for our shows at the Fairgrounds are excellent, and to ensure that we will have the use of this beautiful site in the future, please follow these rules:**
- DAY PARKING on the grounds is limited and available on a first-come, first served-basis at \$5.00 per day. Obtain a day permit at the front gate. No overnight parking will be allowed in this lot. Free parking will be available in the parking lots outside the fenced grounds, with Non-Exhibitors walk-in fee of \$1.00 per person (kids under 12 free).
- ALL PARKING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK. THE CLUB ASSUMES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR THEFT AND/OR DAMAGE TO ANY VEHICLE OF ITS CARGO.
- EACH OVERNIGHT PARKING SPACE ACCOMMODATES TRUCK AND TRAILER OR MOTOR HOME WITH PULL VEHICLE. ALL OTHER VEHICLES MUST BE REMOVED BY 10:30PM NIGHTLY OR WILL BE CHARGED THE OVERNIGHT FEE FOR PARKING.
- OVERNIGHT PARKING SPACES with electricity are available at \$50.00 for show weekend. Parking spaces will be assigned and those wishing to park together must send in reservations together.
- DAY TENT GROOMING with no electricity \$30.00. Generator will be allowed in limited spaces.

PUPPY GROUP – 1 breed

BRED BY EXHIBITOR GROUP – 3 breeds

VETERAN GROUP – 2 breeds

REGULAR HOUND GROUP - 13 breeds

USE OF RAMPS – ALL BREEDS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: Grand Basset Griffon Vendeen.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Whippets.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Basset Hounds, Cirneco dell'Etnas.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (01/2021)

BEST VETERAN COMPETITION – Best Veteran will be awarded from the First Place winners in the Veterans Classes immediately following each breed. If the Best of Breed is awarded to a dog/bitch coming from the Veterans Class, the Best Veteran win is automatic. Best Veteran In Show will be judged following the Hound Group. First through Fourth Place will be awarded. Judge for Best Veteran in Breed will be as published for the regular classes.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR COMPETITION – Best Bred by Exhibitor will be awarded from the First Place winners in the Regular Bred by Exhibitor Classes immediately following each breed. If the Best of Breed is awarded to a dog/bitch coming from the Bred by Exhibitor Class, the Best Bred by Exhibitor win is automatic. Best Bred by Exhibitor In Show will be judged following the Hound Group. First through Fourth Place will be awarded. Judge for Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed will be as published for the regular classes.

BEST PUPPY COMPETITION – Best Puppy will be awarded from the First Place winners in the Regular Puppy Classes (6-9 mos. & 9-12 mos. ONLY) immediately following each breed. If the Best of Breed is awarded to a dog/bitch coming from one of the Puppy Classes for that breed, the Best Puppy win is automatic. Best Puppy In Show will be judged following the Hound Group. First through Fourth Place will be awarded. Judge for Best Puppy in Breed will be as published for the regular classes.

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

EXHIBITORS NOTE: BECAUSE OF TRAVEL TO THE SHOW SITE, TRANSFER OF ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON TUESDAY, JULY 20. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent prior to the start of the class at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent prior to the judging of the class at the show.
