The American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event: An AKC

Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions.)

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned
 entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of
 Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events
 assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the
 owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee
 to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required
 to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same

The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. Select Dog and Select Bitch, Awards of Merit, Best Bred by Exhibitor and Best Veteran will be chosen immediately following Best of Breed competition (See Special recognition below).

SPECIAL RECOGNITION

AWARDS OF MERIT: After awarding Best of Breed, Best of Winners, and Best Opposite Sex, the judge may award up to a maximum of three (3) Awards of Merit to exhibitors in the breed ring that are, in the judge's opinion, outstanding specimens. The total number of Awards of Merit the judge is allowed to award is determined by the total number of dogs and bitches competing in the Best of Breed Competition as follows: 1-10 Entries (1); 11-15 Entries (2); 15 or more Entries (3). Best of Breed, Best of Winners, and Best Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch are not eligible.

BEST BRED-BY EXHIBITOR & BEST VETERAN: Eligibility for Best Bred-by Exhibitor and Best Veteran competitions is predicated upon entry into the following class(es) and all divisions of:

- Best Bred-By Exhibitor the Bred-by-Exhibitor classes including coat types or age divisions (as applicable)
- Best Veteran any non-regular Veteran Class

For Best Bred-By Exhibitor, the eligibility criteria involving the individual handling the dog applies only to the original class entered and all competition specific to the special attraction (i.e. Best BBE of Breed). There are no restrictions as to who may handle the dog in any subsequent classes it may become eligible.

NOTE: Best Veteran or Best Bred By Exhibitor competition will be forgone if the Best of Breed is one of the above
