GENERAL INFORMATION - ALL EVENTS

ROUTES TO THE SHOW

From the North: Take I-95 S. towards Richmond, VA. Use the left 2 lanes to take exit 84A to merge onto I-295 S. toward Rocky Mt. NC/Richmond International Airport. Continue 14.8 miles. Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 28A to merge onto I-64 E toward Norfolk/Virginia Beach. Continue 63.8 miles. Near Newport News, keep left to stay on I-64 E. for 6.6 miles. Continue through Hampton Roads Bridge Tunnel following signs for I-64 E. Continue 14.6 miles. Take exit 286B to merge onto Indian River Rd. Continue on Indian River Rd. for 0.4 miles. Founders Inn and Spa is on the right.

From the South: Take I-95 N. from the North Carolina State Line. Travel about 12 miles to exit 11A to merge onto US-58 E toward Norfolk. Continue 68.4 miles. Use the right 2 lanes to take the US-13 N ramp to I-264 E/ I-64/Portsmouth/ Norfolk/VA Beach. Go 1 mile and merge onto I-664 S. Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 15B for I-64 toward Chesapeake/VA Beach. Continue on I-64 W for 12.9 miles. Take exit 286B for Indian River Rd. E. Go about 0.3 miles. Founders Inn and Spa is on the right.

From the West: Take I-64 E. from the West Virginia State Line. Travel about 65 miles. Use the left 2 lanes to merge onto I-64 E/I-81 N via the ramp to Staunton/Winchester. Take exit 221 for I-64 E toward Richmond. Continue onto I-64 E for 89.7 miles. Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 177 for I-295 toward Airport/Washington/Norfolk (this takes you around Richmond). Continue on I-295 for 23 miles and then take exit 28A to merge onto I-64 E toward Norfolk/VA Beach. Continue 63.8 miles. Near Newport News, keep left to stay on I-64 E. for 6.6 miles. CRATING- Day crating will not be available until after 5:00 PM on Sunday, May 17th, 2026. The crating area **MUST** be completely vacated within 1 hour of the final Specialty Show awards on Saturday. All crates must have an ID with a cell phone number clearly marked. Owners/ handlers will be responsible for their dogs and will be asked to relocate them if they cause a nuisance by barking or disturbing other exhibitors. Be advised that there will be NO Event Center security in the crating area. This is a non-tethering show and no electronic bark devices are allowed to be used on the show grounds.

DOG ACCESS & EXERCISE AREA: This is a "self-cleaning" show. Owners/ handlers are responsible and **MUST** clean up after their dogs. No exceptions. The Show Committee will police the grounds and any exhibitor who is not cleaning up after their dogs will be fined \$100.00 for the first offense. Additional offenses will be dealt with by an Event Committee Hearing. There are ample areas to exercise dogs at the hotel. Please follow all signs of where you are allowed to exercise your dogs. No dogs are allowed in any carpeted areas. Please be respectful at your hotel/ motel and pick up after your dogs at those locations as well.

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed or Variety competition:

Dogs that are Champions of Record, or Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the day of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records.

Best of Breed • Best of Winners • Best of Opposite Sex

Select Dog • Select Bitch • Best Owner-Handled • Awards of Merit

Followed by competition for Best from the Regular Puppy Classes (*Regional Specialty & MDGSPC*), Best from the Veteran Classes Best Veteran Dog & Best Veteran Bitch (*Regional Specialty only*), (*See Special Recognition, page 9.*)

Field Trial Class - Open to all German Shorthaired Pointers that have placed at an AKC Licensed or Member Field Trial or have received a Judges Award of Merit.

HUNTING DOG CLASS HUNTING BITCH CLASS

Hunting Dog Class - Open to German Shorthaired Pointers who have achieved the AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter or Master Hunter Titles. (*Title from Hunting Test*)

DUAL CHAMPION DOGS DUAL CHAMPION BITCHES

Dual Titled Class (National Only) - Dual Champion class is Open to German Shorthaired Pointers who have achieved an AKC breed championship as well as an AKC field trial championship.

The winners of the Veteran, Field Trial, Hunting and Dual Champion Classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed, provided that they are undefeated in any Regular Class at this show.

NOTE: Spayed/Neutered dogs and bitches are allowed in veteran classes at independent specialties. Full registration required. Age determined as of the first day of conformation judging.

At the National, Regional & Mason Dixon GSPC - Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided the criteria set forth in Chapter 16, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows are met.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING MULTIPLE ENTRIES (NATIONAL ONLY)

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class

STUD DOG & BROOD BITCH CLASS – Each entry is allowed two get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. The get **MUST** be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

SPECIAL RECOGNITION

AWARD OF MERIT: At the conclusion of Best of Breed, after picking Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch, the judge, at his discretion, may choose up to 10% of the dogs in competition for Best of Breed for an Award of Merit. Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch, and Best of Winners are not eligible to receive an Award of Merit because it is assumed the judge finds them worthy of merit by the virtue of their win.

BEST PUPPY: (Regional & Mason-Dixon Only) After Best of Breed, Selects, and Awards of Merit are chosen, the winner of the Puppy Dog (6 mos. & under 9 mos.), Puppy Dog (9 mos. & under 12 mos.), Bred By Exhibitor Puppy Dog, Puppy Bitch (6 mos. & under 9 mos.), Puppy Bitch (9 mos. & under 12 mos.), and Bred By Exhibitor Puppy Bitch compete for Best Puppy. If Best of Winners is from a puppy class, that entry is automatically Best Puppy.

2026 BEST OF BREED BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR COMPETITION - National Only

The GSPCA will offer this special competition. To qualify Exhibitors must declare their dog meets the requirement of the Bred By Exhibitor class (Chapter 3, Section 8 of Rules Applying to Dog Shows). Dogs must be breeder owner handled. Eligible dogs will be identified by an indicator in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition by an eligible breeder owner.

Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries. Exhibition-only entrants will participate in the same BPUP classes as regular entries. Judges will evaluate exhibition-only entrants in the same manner as regular entrants but will not consider them for awards. All Exhibition BPUP entries will receive an armband/catalog number starting with a capital "E"
- To be competitive, dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

A DNA Profile Number is required for a Futurity entry at this Show.

The GSPCA National Show Futurity will be held each year in conjunction with the GSPCA National Specialty Show. **ELIGIBILITY:** Puppies whelped between October 1, 2024 and September 30, 2025 will be eligible for the 2026 Futurity. All breeders and co-breeders of litters nominated for the Show Futurity must be members of the GSPCA at the time of nomination. (Pending does not constitute membership). All owners and co-owners of individual dogs or bitches that compete in the Show Futurity must be members of the GSPCA BEFORE FEB 28. Second Forfeits will NOT be accepted without a current GSPCA membership number. If the ownership changes prior to the Futurity, the dog will remain eligible provided all new owners/co-owners are members apply for membership to the GSPCA. The Futurity Chairman must be notified within 10 days of any changes of ownership.

NOMINATION: Bitches must be nominated within 56 days (8 weeks) of whelping, and a fee of \$25.00 must accompany the nomination. Any nominations postmarked or finalized online later than 56 days from whelping will be considered late. Litters may be nominated after the 56th day but not later than 112 days (16 weeks), with an additional \$50.00 penalty payment (\$75.00 total). Litters may be nominated after 112 days (16 weeks), with an additional \$200.00 penalty payment (\$225.00 total). No nomination will be accepted if postmarked or finalized online later than 143 days (20 weeks) after whelping.

SENIOR CLASS: For dogs whelped on or after October 1 through January 31. Dogs and bitches will be judged separately.

INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For dogs whelped on or after February 1 through May 31. Dogs and bitches will be judged separately.

JUNIOR CLASS: For dogs whelped on or after June 1 through September 30. Dogs and bitches will be judged separately.

PAYMENT OF FORFEITS: Three forfeits must be paid as follows: First Forfeit of \$20.00 must be postmarked or finalized online by December 31; Second Forfeit of \$20.00 must be postmarked or finalized online by February 28 (29); Third Forfeit of \$20.00 (to count as entry fee) must be received at the Superintendent's office by the closing date of the National Specialty Show entries.

Any forfeits, with the exception of the third forfeit, will be accepted if postmarked or finalized online up to 21 days late and accompanied by a penalty payment of an additional \$20.00 per pup. **Late forfeits postmarked or finalized online after the 21st day, or forfeits without proper payments, will be returned and/or deemed ineligible.** All forfeits will become the property of the GSPCA Futurity and are non-refundable. All payments must be U.S. Funds.

U.S. Funds drawn on Foreign Banks must include an additional **\$5.00 processing fee per check** (per check mailed). **FORMS:** An email acknowledgement with your **Futurity Litter Number** will be sent to the breeder upon nomination of the litter. After the Futurity Litter Number has been received by the Breeder, First Forfeits can be made. First & Second Forfeit Forms are downloadable on the GSPCA website in the Store or payments can be made online. Please refer to the timelines above to be sure you have submitted your forfeits in a timely manner either by mail or online. First Forfeits are paid just as a quantity of pups multiplied by the fee. Second Forfeits require a card for EACH pup moving forward in the Futurity. Forfeit cards must be completed in full. Entries are compared to the Second Forfeit Card, be sure all information is correct. Any deviations can result in pups being deemed ineligible. Indicate "Futurity" and age division under Additional Class.

DIVISION OF PRIZE MONIES

Actual Futurity expenses will be deducted from Futurity money. The balance remaining will be divided as follows:

1 - The Best of Futurity and Best of Opposite Sex would continue to receive 12.5% of the funds which will be further divided 60% to the owner and 40% to the breeder.

2 - The winner of each class will receive up to \$300.00 or the total of the funds available for that class, if the funds are less than \$300.00.

3 - If the funds available for each class are more than \$600.00, the winner will receive at least \$300.00 or those funds available according to the following allocation:

FIRST PLACE.....	50%	SECOND PLACE.....	25%
THIRD PLACE.....	15%	FOURTH PLACE.....	10%

4 - If the funds available for each class allow for the winner to receive \$300.00, but are less than \$600.00, the allocation of the funds for placements second through fourth would be as follows:

SECOND PLACE IN EACH CLASS.....	50%
THIRD PLACE IN EACH CLASS.....	32%
FOURTH PLACE IN EACH CLASS.....	18%

5 - All funds for each class will be further divided 60% to the owner and 40% to the breeder.

Pee Wee Class Entry Form - No Entry Fee

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5–9 years of age. Children younger than five cannot participate in the Pee Wee Class Special Attraction. The safety of the children is a primary concern.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

At an All-Breed Event the judge must be an AKC approved All Breed Junior Showmanship Judge. A Group Club or Specialty Club may have a Limited Status Junior Showmanship Judge that meets the criteria.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- It is up to the host club to decide if a dog must be registered to participate.
- How entries will be accepted is up to the host club. In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Please contact Event Operations at eventplans@akc.org to request the current version of the Pee Wee Release of Liability.
- The entry fee, if any, shall be specified.
- Clubs may specify a limit on the number of children allowed to enter the class.
- Clubs must submit a summary report to AKC including number of entries and feedback to the Sport Services Department.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

Although the word "judge" will be used, this is designed to be a learning and mentoring experience—no Junior will be "judged" but rather will be mentored with the age-appropriate amount of information to help prepare them for what they will be expected to know about AKC regular Junior Showmanship once they reach 9 years of age.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List. The

American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event: An AKC Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions.)

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
