The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The American Kennel Club will collect: a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee where applicable for the first entry of a dog, plus a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 is required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 is required for each additional entry of the same dog.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. Baray Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. FAX NUMBER: 360-755-2248. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). - Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify Baray Events at 360-755-7086 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 11, Section 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.

STRIPPED DOWN COMPETITION

Stripped Down Competition shall be offered for any AKC Champion of Record (Conformation) of any age or Variety. Length of hair is required to be trimmed to a maximum of 1.5 inches long on any portion of the body, with exception of the ears where no length restriction apply. Entrants are to be judged on conformation. All varieties of dogs (males) will be judged first as one class, then all varieties of bitches will be judged as the second class. The winners of these two respective classes will compete for Best in Stripped Down Competition. Judging will begin following competition of the Puppy Sweepstakes and prior to the Regular Classes. Entrants in this special competition will not be required to compete for Best of Variety. If further completion is desired (i.e. Best of Variety, Best Stud Dog or Best Brood Bitch) an "Additional Entry of Same Dog" fee shall be required.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Professional handlers,* household members and current assistants to professional handlers** may not exhibit. Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

• No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

**A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

FIELD TRIAL DOG/BITCH CLASS: Classes for Dogs/Bitches that have earned Working Dog (WD) or Working Dog Excellent (WDX) Titles from the American Spaniel Club, or that have earned Junior Hunter (JH), Senior Hunter (SH), or Master Hunter (MH) Titles from the AKC. *Entrants must be intact. Winners of the Veteran & Field Trial classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible for Best of Breed.*

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries) - Each Variety

For complete description of each class, refer to AKC Rules & Regulations

NOTE: *As the judge's decisions in the Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries) are based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, not one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.*

STUD DOG/ BROOD BITCH CLASS: For Stud Dogs/Brood Bitches and two of their Get/Produce. The Stud Dog/Brood Bitch must be shown in the ring with the Get/Produce. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get/Produce.

BRACE CLASS: A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace must have at least one common owner

Stud Dog, Brood Bitch & Brace Classes are to be followed by Best Stud Dog, Best Brood Bitch and Best Brace Class competition after Best of Breed has been judged.

PARADE OF TITLE HOLDERS: For dogs that are American Champions, Field Trial Champions, AKC Obedience Title Holders and dogs that have earned a Working Dog Title from the AKC. Parade MUST be indicted on the entry form. All entrants receive a rosette with the dog's name imprinted.

SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes is open to all Cocker Spaniels that are six months of age 6 months & under 13 months of age on the day of the show. Dogs shown in sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to regular classes. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class".

DIVISION OF SWEEPSTAKES ENTRY MONEY

25% of entry fee will be retained by club for expenses. The remaining will be known as the Sweepstakes Fund and will be divided as Follows (rounded to the nearest dollar amount): 10% To Best of Breed in Sweepstakes, 5% to Best Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes. The remaining 85% of Sweepstakes Fund to be divided between Best Dog and Best Bitch in each age class in each variety, based on proportion of that particular class entry to the total entry.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: Junior-9 years old & under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old & under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old & under 18 years old on the day of the show

NOTE - SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

PEE WEE SPECIAL ATTRACTION

Entries will be taken the morning of the event only – No entry fee

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5-9 years of age. Safety is a primary concern.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- The dogs must be Cocker Spaniels.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead & collar.
- Judging will be held during a break.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- There is no fee, but each parent/guardian must sign a waiver.
- Waivers/entry blanks will be available at the club table.

Because safety of both the dogs and Juniors is a primary concern an additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.
