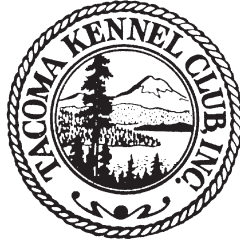

## **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - ALL EVENTS**



**The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.**

The American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event: An AKC Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions.)

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES - Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE - The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- PUBLICATION RIGHTS - By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

- No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these shows.

## **GROOMING INFORMATION**

---

Grooming is available for 4 days, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday with no reduction in fees for fewer days. No grooming at ringside - touch-ups only.

**Reservations must be submitted on this form and postmarked or emailed no later than July 1, 2026.**

Spaces will be assigned in the order they are received. Requests to groom together must be sent in the same envelope. NSF checks will be charged a fee of \$25. No refunds after the deadline.

### **RESERVED GROOMING**

- Spaces are 10' x 10'
- Exercise pens are allowed
- You must provide your own shade/shelter
- Fee is \$50.00 per space for four days if paid prior to the deadline. After the deadline, the fee will be \$70.00 IN CASH paid at the show
- No electricity available, bring a generator. All generators must be placed on a plywood/fire proof surface larger than the generator. Anyone found tripping a circuit breaker will be charged \$50.00 and be subject to disciplinary action.
  - **A bench show hearing may be called if a space is not left clean, free of dog hair and debris.**

### **DAY-OF-SHOW GROOMING (NO FEE) LOCATED BEHIND RESERVED GROOMING**

- First-come, first-served each day
- The number of spaces is limited.
- Spaces are free/no cost
- No saving of spaces
- No exercise pens allowed
- No access to electricity/power unless you bring a generator. Generators must be placed on plywood/fire proof surface larger than the generator.

## **RV PARKING INFORMATION**

### **Reservations for Overnight Parking Parking Reservations Close Wednesday, July 5, 2026**

1. Spaces are reserved and assigned on a first paid basis. Reservations close July 5, 2026. No refunds after July 5, 2026.
2. Spaces are approximately 20' x 40' (width x length). If a larger space is needed, an additional space must be reserved and paid for. Parking for RV and one tow vehicle is allowed at each space. Additional vehicles, and oversized tow vehicles, must be parked elsewhere on the show grounds and will be charged an additional \$10 per day.
3. Handicap RV parking must be reserved in advance. There are a limited number of spaces available to holders of a current state-issued handicap parking permit. A copy of this permit must be included with your parking request. Please mail your request early - space is limited. When these spaces are filled, the remaining requests will be assigned to regular spaces in the order they are received.
4. Requests to park together must be submitted in the same envelope.
5. Parking lot will open at 1:00PM on Thursday. Gates will open Friday, Saturday, and Sunday at 7:00AM and close Thursday through Saturday at 10:00PM. On Sunday, gates will close one hour after Best in Show.
6. To access RV Parking, you MUST use the NORTH gate. The North gate is the ONLY gate that will be open to vehicles. DO NOT BLOCK traffic on Meridian. RVs that cannot turn into the park due to traffic at the North gate will need to lay over elsewhere until traffic has cleared at the North gate.
7. Parking personnel will gladly assist you in locating your space and answering any questions you may have. They will NOT reassign spaces. Parking is a privilege extended by the Tacoma Kennel Club, Inc. and the Club reserves the right to withdraw this privilege from any person who feels he/she cannot abide by the rules and instructions of our Parking Crew, or who resorts to abusive language and/or other tactics. There will be no refund of fees. Failure to abide by Parking Personnel instructions may also result in an Event Committee hearing according to AKC Rules & Regulations.
8. Persons arriving without an RV reservation will be charged \$75 cash per night, for a 20' x 40' space, subject to availability.
9. Power for RVs: **No power available**. Exhibitors must use onboard or portable generators for air conditioners and blowers/dryers. All exhaust must be directed away from other campsites, preferably up. Generators must be placed on plywood, or another fire-proof surface, which is larger than the generator.
10. No dumping of grey water or sewage. Violators will be fined \$500.
11. All camping areas must be cleaned before departure. Failure to leave your camping spot clean may result in denial of the privilege at future shows.
12. FIRE LANES, DESIGNATED PARKING ZONES, NO PARKING ZONES & LOADING ZONES WILL BE STRICTLY MAINTAINED. Violators will be towed without notice at their expense.

### **SATURDAY & SUNDAY – DURING LUNCH BREAK NO ENTRY FEE – ENTRY LIMIT: 15**

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class.

The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5-9 years of age. Safety is a primary concern.

*Stephanie Kaul is the Saturday Pee-Wee judge.*

*Bryan Martin is the Sunday Pee-Wee judge.*

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

REGISTRATION WILL BE TAKEN AT THE CLUB TABLE DAY OF SHOW, STARTING AT 9:00AM. EACH ENTRANT WILL BE REQUIRED TO FILL OUT AN ENTRY FORM. IN ADDITION TO AN ENTRY, A RELEASE MUST BE SIGNED BY THE CHILD'S PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN. JUDGING WILL BE HELD DURING THE LUNCH BREAK. NO ENTRY FEE. **4-6 BEGINNER PUPPY**

**ENTRIES CLOSE 12:00PM PDT, WEDNESDAY, JULY 1, 2026**

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

**Entry and Eligibility**

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries. Exhibition-only entrants will participate in the same BPUP classes as regular entries. Judges will evaluate exhibition-only entrants in the same manner as regular entrants but will not consider them for awards. All Exhibition BPUP entries will receive an armband/catalog number starting with a capital "E."
- To be competitive, dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

## ***JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION***

---

**NOVICE CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

**MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

**NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:** **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

**NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S):** There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

**AWARDS OF MERIT (AOM):** At the conclusion of the Best of Breed judging, the specialty judge may, at his or her discretion, recall into the ring up to a maximum of 10% of the combined entries for Best of Breed, Winner's Dog, Winner's Bitch, and the non-regular classes involving single-dog entries to receive an AOM. All dogs from the classes mentioned above are eligible except Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch, and Best of Winners because it is assumed the judge finds them worthy of merit by the virtue of their win.
