Select Dog and/or Select Bitch, where applicable, will be chosen immediately following Best of Breed. To be followed by: Awards of Merit

NON REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular classes involving multiple entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes will be for stud dogs/brood bitches and two of their get/produce. Stud dogs/brood bitches must be entered in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch class and must be shown in the ring with their get/produce. The owner of the stud dog/brood bitch does not need to be the owner of the get/produce. The award is based upon the merits of the get/produce. The stud dog/brood bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. Get/produce must be entered in a Regular class and wear armbands. Stud Dog/Brood Bitch shall be considered one entry and requires only one entry fee. Stud Dog Class: For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show.

Brood Bitch Class: For bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show.

Stud Dog/Brood Bitch may be spayed or neutered.

4-6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for (Golden Retriever) dogs/bitches that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Entry and eligibility requirements include: AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin. All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. 
