Non-Regular Classes (Involving Single Dog Entries)

Veteran 7-10 Yrs - A class for dogs and a class for bitches at least Seven (7) years of age and under Ten (10) years.

Veteran 10 Yrs & Over - A class for dogs and a class for bitches Ten (10) years and older.

Entries in the Veteran Classes may be spayed or neutered. The winners of these classes are eligible to compete in Best of Breed provided they are undefeated in any other class.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Select Dog and Select Bitch, where applicable, will be chosen immediately following Best of Breed competition. This will be followed by Awards of Merit (up to 15% - National Specialty Only), NOHS Best of Breed, Best Puppy in the Regular Puppy Classes, Best of Opposite Sex to Best Puppy From The Regular Puppy Classes, Best in the Bred-By Exhibitor Classes.

BEST PUPPY IN THE REGULAR PUPPY CLASSES: The First Place Winners from the individual Regular Puppy Classes (6-9 mos. And 9-12 mos.) will compete for the award of Best Puppy in the Regular Classes. Best Puppy & Best of Opposite Sex to Best Puppy From The Regular Puppy Classes competition will follow Best of Breed judging.

BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR IN THE BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CLASSES: The First Place Winners from the individual Bred-By-Exhibitor Classes will compete for the award of Best Bred-By-Exhibitor. Best Bred-By-Exhibitor competition will follow Best of Breed judging.

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries (Stud Dog & Brood Bitch) is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dogs may be neutered and Brood Bitches may be spayed.

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular Classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merit of the Get.

While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the AKC Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard of the breed.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Dog and Produce for Get.

SWEEPSTAKES - WEDNESDAY

Requirements and Classification

Sweepstakes is open to all Bichons Frises 6 months and under 18 months of age, as of November 17, 2021. Dogs & bitches who have major points or are Champions of Record are eligible for competition. Any individual who derives an income from showing dogs in any country will be allowed to show only those dogs registered in his/her name. Any individual exhibiting a dog that the individual does not own or co-own must be a member of the same household as either an owner or co-owner of the dog being shown. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes MUST ALSO be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class."

Classifications

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

Puppy, 6 Mos & Under 8 Mos • Puppy, 8 Mos & Under 10 Mos • Puppy, 10 Mos & Under 12 Mos Junior, 12 Mos & Under 14 Mos • Junior, 14 Mos & Under 16 Mos • Junior, 16 Mos & Under 18 Mos
Best Puppy in Sweepstakes: The winners of the six Puppy classes will compete for Best Puppy in Sweepstakes & Best of Opposite Sex to Best Puppy in Sweepstakes.

Best Junior in Sweepstakes: The winners of the six Junior classes will compete for Best Junior in Sweepstakes & Best of Opposite Sex to Best Junior in Sweepstakes.

The winner of Best Puppy in Sweepstakes and the Best Junior in Sweepstakes will compete for the Grand Sweepstakes winner.

Division of Entry Money as Prizes

The club will retain 35% of the entry fees for expenses. The remainder will be divided as follows: Grand Sweepstakes Winner - 10% of Sweepstakes Entries

The remaining 55% of entry fees will be divided as follows:

1st - 40% • 2nd - 30% • 3rd - 20% • 4th - 10%

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES - BOTH DAYS

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Professional handlers,* household members and current assistants to professional handlers** may not exhibit. Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS. (05/20)*

AWARDS OF MERIT (National Specialty Only)

The judge may award an Award of Merit to up to 15% of all specials entered. Winners Dog & Winners Bitch will also be considered for this award. A Rosette of Hunter Green & Burgundy with the words "Award of Merit" inscribed on the Rosette offered by the Bichon Frise Club of America, Inc. will be awarded. All Regular Classes & Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries will receive Rosette Ribbons in all placements. Duplicate ribbons for major awards may be purchased by co-owners of the dog. Ribbons must be ordered with the Show Chairman the day of the show and paid for at the show. Cost depends on the ribbon ordered.

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The American Kennel Club will collect: a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee where applicable for the first entry of a dog, plus a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 is required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 is required for each additional entry of the same dog.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Clubs is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. FAX NUMBER: 360-755-2248. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). - Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify BaRay Events at 360-755-7086 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- PUBLICATION RIGHTS – By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.

"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."

ATTENTION OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1. The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf>.

NOTE

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATPC 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination. Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used.
