### **PEE WEE SPECIAL ATTRACTION! SUNDAY ONLY - JUDGE: RHONDA SILVEIRA**

For children 5-9 years old. Fancy Rosettes and loads of surprises in a pretty bag for each child entered! A responsible adult must accompany each child into the ring. Held during the Lunch Break in an outside ring Sunday at Noon or after regular judging when that ring breaks for lunch. Exact ring to be assigned day of the show. Please plan to observe and support the kids! Cake and punch will be served to all after the special attraction! Sign up on Sunday from 8:00-11:00AM. at the Announcer's Stand. Each child will be required to fill out an entry form and a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. **Entry limit - 12 children.**

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship Class. The Pee Wee Class is geared toward children 5-9 years. Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent, guardian, or responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult. A dog must be at least four (4) months old to enter the Pee Wee class. Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. All dogs entered must have the proper leash and collar. A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside the ring. All AKC fully recognized and miscellaneous Class Breeds are allowed to enter, including dogs with a PAL listing. All FSS Breeds not in the Miscellaneous Class and All - American dogs are allowed to enter. In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian.

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Select Dog and Select Bitch, where applicable, will be chosen following Best of Breed competition. This will be followed by Best Owner-Handled.

## AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

*The purpose of the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner-Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.*

- Dog must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS prior to the closing of entries. There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.
- Exhibitors must declare their dog AKC National Owner-Handled Series eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show. Dogs declared eligible will be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the judge's book, steward's book, and the show catalog.
- \*Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit.
- The Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.

*\*Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household. Household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

### USE OF RAMPS – ALL BREEDS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged **on the ground or on a ramp** through all levels of competition: Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, American Water Spaniels, Boykin Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Grand Basset Griffon Vendéen, Whippets, German Pinschers, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Australian Cattle Dogs, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs, and Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on **a ramp or table** through all levels of competition: Mudi, Puli.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on the **ground, ramp, or table** through all levels of competition: Miniature Bull Terriers.

The following breeds **must be judged on a ramp** through all levels of conformation competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirneco dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows and Keeshonden.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (04/2024)

**Section 1- Classifications** – The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

**Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility** – Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/ weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

Everyone using the parking areas will be expected to leave the parking areas clean.

Absolutely no unauthorized plugging in to unassigned electrical outlets.  
Doing so, may result in disciplinary action.

**GENERATORS:** Generators must be turned off between 10:00PM and 6:00AM.

Persons with a medical reason to run a generator during these hours must note this when making the reservation. There are a limited number of 30 AMP hookups for RVs available at \$50 each for the weekend.

There will be an extra charge for this service.

**THERE WILL BE ABSOLUTELY NO DUMPING OF GRAY WATER  
OR SEWAGE ON THE GROUND.**

There will be a \$250.00 fine/clean-up charge and vehicle will be impounded until fine/fees are paid in full. (Owner is responsible for any additional towing and impound fees.)

Limited handicapped day parking will be available. Anyone requesting handicapped day parking must have a valid Handicapped Parking Permit or plate. **HANDICAPPED DAY PARKING DOES NOT MEAN "NEAR THE RINGS."** It only means a readily accessible surface and space.

RV spots are limited. Once spots are filled, parking will be in overflow.

## **DIRECTIONS TO SOZO SPORTS COMPLEX: 2200 S. 36TH AVE, YAKIMA, WA**

**FROM THE NORTH (ELLENSBURG):** From I-82 take exit 31A/31B to highway US 12. Drive west to 40th ave exit (about 2 miles). Once on 40th Ave, drive about 3.2 miles south to W Washington Ave. Turn right onto W Washington Ave. The road will start to curve south. You will see a sign on both your right and left indicating you are on the route to the Sozo Sports complex. At .3 miles after entering W. Washington Ave, turn left onto Spring Creek Road. Stay on this road and it will bend south after about ¼ of a mile. The entrance to Sozo will be on your right.

**FROM THE SOUTH (RICHLAND OR GOLDENDALE):** Take exit 34 off Interstate 82. At the end of the ramp, turn left onto Nob Hill Blvd. Drive west about 4.25 miles to 40th avenue. Turn south onto 40th ave. Drive about ¾ of a mile to W. Washington Avenue. Turn right onto W. Washington Ave. After entering W. Washington Ave, the road will start to bend to the left (south). After driving about .3 miles, turn left onto Spring Creek Road. Follow the sign pointing to Sozo Sports Complex. Stay on this road and it will bend south after about ¼ of a mile. The entrance to Sozo will be on your right.

## **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION - SATURDAY & SUNDAY ONLY**

**NOVICE CLASS:** This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

**NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:** **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

*After the judge has awarded Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.*

**NOTICE:** Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

**NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S):** There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.
