Select Dog and Select Bitch, where applicable, will be chosen immediately following Best of Breed competition. This will be followed by NOHS Best of Breed.

BEST IN PUPPY CLASSES: the first place winner of each of the four puppy classes will compete for Best Puppy.

BEST IN BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES: the first place winner of each of the Bred by Exhibitor classes will compete for Best Bred by Exhibitor.

### Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

NOTE: As the judges' decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Class is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed, Get must be entered individually in one of the Regular Classes, or Best of Breed Competition.

Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog, except substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "Produce" for "get".
