Points Available for Reserve

The Harrier Club of American will award at its **National Specialty** a three-point major to Reserve Winners Dog if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

Awards of Merit

At a National Specialty often times the number of quality dogs in competition far exceeds the number of top awards available. The judge must choose only one Best of Breed and one Best of Opposite Sex and one Select Dog and Bitch. The awarding of an Award of Merit acknowledges that this animal was under consideration for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex or Select Dog/Bitch. The judge is indicating recognition of an exceptional animal who could, on another day, merit a top award. At the discretion of the judge, an Award of Merit may be given to up to 10% of the number of Specials entered at the time of closing; the number entered will disregard all absentees and transfers from the classes. All those entered for Best of Breed competition, plus Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, 1st place Veteran Dog and 1st place Veteran Bitch (each age division) shall be eligible to receive an Award of Merit, except for the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed winners. Receiving an Award of Merit is, indeed, a significant honor.

NOTE: Spayed/Neutered dogs and bitches are allowed in veteran classes at independent specialties. Full registration required. Age determined as of the first day of conformation judging. *Winners, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible for Best of Breed competition.*

HUNTING DOG/BITCH CLASS

Hunting dog and hunting bitch classes are for those Harriers who have earned a hunting certificate from the Harrier Club of America. *Winners, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible for Best of Breed competition.*

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Selects, if applicable, will be chosen following Best of Breed.

BEST FROM THE REGULAR PUPPY CLASSES: Best Puppy From The Regular Puppy Classes First place winners in Puppy Classes, 6 mos. and under 9 mos. and 9 mos. and under 12 mos., both sexes will compete together and will be judged after Best of Breed.

BEST FROM THE BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES: After Best of Breed, Selects and Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of Bred By Exhibitor Dog and Bred By Exhibitor Bitch compete for Best Bred by Exhibitor. If Best of Winners is from the Bred by Exhibitor class, that entry is automatically Best Bred by Exhibitor.

BEST VETERAN: First place winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes will compete for Best Veteran Dog and Best Veteran Bitch after Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES)

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class: Each entry is allowed two get unless otherwise specified. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excused under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

Brace Class: Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

Team Class: Four Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. All dogs competing in the team class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Team Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Team is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Team Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Team must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Team Class."

SWEEPSTAKES

The Sweepstakes is open to all Harriers who, on the day of the Show, will be 6 months and under 18 months of age. Entries must be made at the same time, on the same entry form as for the Regular Class at this show. All entries **MUST ALSO** be entered in a Regular Class. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and age division under Additional Class.

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATIONS

Class winners (above) will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Veteran Sweepstakes will be open to all Harriers who are 7 years old and over the day of the Show. Entries must be made at the same time on the same entry form as for the Regular Classes at this Show. All entries **ARE NOT** required to enter a Regular Class at the Show. Neutered or Spayed Veterans may enter Veteran Sweepstakes. Indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" and age division under Additional Class.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATION

- Veteran Dogs (7 years & under 10 years) Veteran Bitches (7 years & under 10 years)
- Veteran Dogs (10 years & under 12 years) Veteran Bitches (10 years & under 12 years)
- Veteran Dogs (12 years and older) Veteran Bitches (12 years and older)

Class winners (above) will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes.

The remaining entry fees will be divided among the First Place winners of the Four Veteran Sweepstakes Classes in ratio to the class entries.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

ADDITIONAL SHOW RULES

1. The show-giving clubs require that all dogs be on leash at all times while on the show premises, except when in an exercise pen, in crates or in Obedience or Rally ring.
2. GROOMING: Private exercise pens, crates & tables will not be allowed WITHIN 10 FEET OF ANY RING OR WITHIN 10 FEET OF ANY FOOD CONCESSION.
3. CHAIRS, TENTS & CANOPIES: Chairs will not be provided by the Clubs for exhibitors or other spectators. Tents or canopies may be set up on the show site in areas 10 FEET OR MORE FROM RINGS.
4. WATER on grounds for filling large tanks or containers. Drinking fountains ARE available on the grounds.
5. OVERNIGHT PARKING: See pages 16 & 17 of this premium list for Parking reservations & special notes.
6. DAY & OVERNIGHT PARKING: Parking will be allowed only in authorized parking zones. Any unauthorized vehicles will be asked to move immediately. Refusal will constitute loss of exhibition privileges & towing at owner's expense.
7. All vehicles will be parked as designated by parking locations.
8. No alcohol allowed on park recreation premises.
9. No Vehicles on the show grounds during show days.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians’ recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.

“Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm’s way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm’s way is considered mistreatment.”

ATTENTION OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1.
