Select Dog and Select Bitch, where applicable, will be chosen immediately following Best of Breed competition. This will be followed by Best Owner-Handled.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR COMPETITION - THURSDAY ONLY

Best Bred-by-Exhibitor in Breed, Groups and Show

BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CRITERIA

1. Every dog entered in the event may compete for the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Competition, if shown by a breeder-owner of record.
2. **To be eligible for BOB BBE, one must check the appropriate box on the entry form indicating their participation.** All dogs entered in the BBE class are automatically eligible for the Bred-By-Exhibitor competition. All eligible entries will be indicated by a hash tag (#) in the catalog.
3. All dogs in competition for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor, except International entries, must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club.
4. Dogs in competition for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor must be handled throughout the entire breed competition by a breeder/owner of record.
5. No handler change will be permitted for the purpose of becoming eligible for the Best Bred-by-Exhibitor competition.
6. Dogs competing in the Best Bred-by-Exhibitor Groups and Best Bred-by-Exhibitor in Show must be handled by a breeder/owner of record.

Best in Show Bred by Exhibitor will be judged following Best in Show judging. Judges for the Bred by Exhibitor Groups and Best Bred by Exhibitor in Show will be announced at the show.

A class for dogs and a class for bitches seven (7) years of age and older. Entrants may be spayed or neutered. **Winners are NOT eligible for Best of Breed competition by virtue of having won this class.** See additional information below.

The Veteran class will be judged immediately after judging of Best of Breed/Best or Variety for each breed. Each Veteran group will be judged by the Regular Group judge in the same ring immediately after Regular Group judging is completed. **Your dog may be altered in this competition. The same handler must exhibit the dog through all levels of the Veteran Competition (i.e., Veteran Class, the Veteran Group and the Best in Show Veteran) on Friday.** Best in Show Veteran will be judged following Best in Show judging. Judges for the Veterans Groups and Best Veteran in Show will be announced at the show.

AKC SANCTIONED 4-6 MONTHS PUPPY THURSDAY, FRIDAY, SATURDAY (1ST SHOW)

ENTRIES WILL CLOSE WEDNESDAY NOON, MAY 13, 2026, AT SUPERINTENDENT OFFICE.

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

USE OF RAMPS - ALL BREEDS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged **on the ground or on a ramp** through all levels of competition: Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, American Water Spaniels, Boykin Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Grand Basset Griffon Vendeen, Norwegian Elkhounds, Whippets, German Pinschers, Portuguese Water Dogs, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Australian Cattle Dogs, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, and Basset Fauve de Bretagne, Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on a **ramp or table** through all levels of competition: Mudi, Puli.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on the **ground, ramp, or table** through all levels of competition: Miniature Bull Terriers.

The following breeds **must be judged on a ramp** through all levels of conformation competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirneco dell'Etnas, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden and Spanish Water Dogs.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (01/2026)

(Ring Rentals)

To be held in the Obedience and Rally ring

Wednesday, May 27th - during Crate Set-Up 4:00-6:00 PM & Thursday, May 28th - 30 minutes after end of Obedience and Rally Trials to 6:00PM.

\$5.00 for seven minutes of individual ring time.

The club will provide a timer. Exhibitors must set up jumps and provide their own "judge" if desired. Sign-up sheets for C matches will be available at noon the day of the match at the steward table in the Obedience and Rally building on a first come-first served basis. You can sign up immediately prior to the matches if time is available. CLUB MEMBERS RUN FIRST. You may not use consecutive time slots. Ending times are non-negotiable. Fee accepted immediately prior to ring set up. Your time begins when your team walks into the ring after set-up. You may use your time to do run-throughs, exercises or parts of exercises, play, train, or stays. Any regular or non-regular classes can be run-through. Verbal praise, corrections and gentle guiding are allowed (harsh corrections are not allowed). Food, toys & training aids are allowed, but you must pick up any food dropped on the mats. JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.






DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE FOR - RV AND TENT CAMPING

THE ONLY ACCESS TO RV PARKING IS THRU THE GATE CLOSEST TO BROOKS ST. ON SOUTH AVE. WEST. IT WILL BE MARKED BY SIGNS ON THE SIDEWALK.

1. **RESERVE ST:** Exit 101, Drive south to Hwy 93/Brooks Ave. Turn Left at light. Continue east. Cross Russell Ave at light and veer to right on South Ave W. (Fairgrounds located on right) **Entrance through fence line will be approximately 150 feet on right, marked by signs.**

ADDITIONAL RV PARKING INFORMATION

HELP PREVENT DIGGING & URINATION IN GRASS!!

GROUND COVER UNDER ALL DOG PENS IS REQUIRED

The Missoula County Fairgrounds Policy requires a **moisture proof barrier** be placed between your dog pens and the grass underneath. Carelessness by previous dog exhibitors resulted in large areas of **dead grass** and **holes** on Carnival Field prior to the following annual county fair. Failure to do so may result in a grass repair bill to you from the Missoula Co. Fairgrounds office. Please contact the FVKC Grounds/Show Chair if you need assistance to comply. Thank you.

VEHICLE AND GENERATOR EXHAUST VENTING

It is mandatory that exhibitors will utilize exhaust piping (i.e. Gen-Turi) to direct exhaust from vehicle-mounted and stand-alone generators for the health and safety of dogs and people. Please keep your vehicle's engine running to a strict minimum for the same reasons. Free Standing Generators must have a sheet of plywood underneath prevent damaging grass or exhibitor risks being billed by Missoula County Fairground for damage.

NO GRILLS OR FIRE PITS UNLESS ELEVATED ABOVE GROUND

Must be elevated a minimum of 1-1/2 feet. Heat shield or other barrier is recommended.

PLEASE CAREFULLY REVIEW THE FOLLOWING SHOW SITE RULES AND POLICIES

- All vehicles must have a working fire extinguisher. Do not park in designated Fire Lanes.
- If you utilize a free-standing portable generator, a protective barrier (plywood) must be placed between the generator and the grass to prevent any heat from damaging the grass. A fine from the Western Montana Fairground if you damage the grass. Contact Grounds Chair for help.
- Generators must be shut down between 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM, unless specified by the FVKC Show Committee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for daily clean-up of their parking space. Trash bags are to be deposited in the nearest dumpster. When departing, please leave a clean area.
If using your vehicle levelers of any type ON THE GRASS, then a solid leveling pad will be utilized under each leveler.
- All vehicles must vacate the grounds on Sunday by 5PM. Longer stays can be arranged with the FVKC Information Desk/RV Parking Chair.
- Tuesday & Sunday Overnight stay's: NO ELECTRICAL ACCESS
- All use of fairgrounds RV area requires Missoula Fairgrounds Release & Waiver of Liability.
- Self-contained RVs only: Do not discharge gray water or sanitary waste on the show grounds. Violators will be asked to vacate the show grounds immediately.
- No piggyback electrical hook-ups. Violators will be asked to leave the show grounds.
- No dogs allowed overnight in the grooming areas/buildings. Grooming buildings will close at 10:00 PM and reopen at 6:00 AM.
- NO BATHING OF DOGS IN RESTROOMS. A wash rack with tubs is in the vicinity of the conformation rings.
- All parking is a privilege extended by the Five Valley Kennel Club Inc. and the Missoula County Fairgrounds. We reserve the right to withdraw this privilege from any person who uses abusive language, argues with the parking personnel, or attempts to circumvent or break the rules, policies, and regulations. All parking is at your own risk. The FVKC and Missoula County Fairgrounds assume no responsibility or liability for damages to or loss to any vehicle or its contents.
- The Parking Committee will assign spaces in the order they were received, but reserves the right to park vehicles by size and need as to benefit the operation of the show and inflict the minimum amount of damage to the grounds.
- Handicap Parking will be as close as possible to events. A copy of the handicap parking permit must be included with the reservation, and the necessary permit or state license plate displayed as required at the show. There are limited handicap spots so reserve early. They will be assigned on a First come First Serve Basis.

AKC® Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List. The

American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event: An AKC Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions.)

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES - Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE - The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
