EXHIBITORS - PLEASE NOTE

- No ringside seating for spectators.
- Masks are required for everyone while in the buildings and in the outdoor rings during judging.
- Please maintain six (6) foot social distancing.
- Please use hand sanitizer frequently.
- Adhere to AKC Covid 19 Best Practice Guidelines for Conformation, Obedience and Rally.
- Crates only allowed in the buildings while the breed is in the ring and must be removed immediately after the breed is judged.
- No grooming tables in the Building.
- Adhere to and respect any State and Local Active Mandates.
- No grooming, no blowers, no fans in the buildings.
- Grooming only in the outside reserved grooming spots (pre-paid), the RV parking, and the parking lot. No grooming in the grassy areas.
- Overnight parking only in the Paid RV section.
- RV spaces without advance reservations will be charged \$50 additional/night - no electricity.
- All equipment must be removed every night from the buildings and the parking lots.
- No saving of spaces with cones or anything else.
- Reserved grooming with electricity is outdoors under the Charolais Barn and in the stalls of the Stable. Free Grooming Space is in the Heritage Park Equine Center. All equipment in the free grooming area MUST be removed every evening.
- IT IS STRICTLY UNDERSTOOD THAT CHILDREN ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THEIR PARENTS AND WILL BE SUPERVISED AND UNDER THEIR CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.
- PLEASE KNOW YOUR ARMBAND NUMBER(S) PRIOR TO COMING RINGSIDE.
- Due to constantly changing requirements we will post the most updated information related to rules in the Judging Program.

We ask that you cooperate with us on the amount of time you spend in the buildings. In order to limit building occupancy, we ask the exhibitors to come into the buildings no sooner than fifteen (15) minutes before showing and ask that you leave if you are not needed for further competition. Dogs may not be left in the buildings overnight. Chairs will not be provided. You may bring your own, but please be aware of the social distancing. Please be mindful, if you are done showing and the building is looking crowded, take a break, leave the building and visit the Vendor area and come back if you want to observe.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- BUILDINGS will be open at 7:00AM and will close each day after Best in Show, unless otherwise noted in the judging program.
- THROUGHOUT THE BUILDINGS: All chairs, crates, and accessories must be placed within the designated areas and must not block aisles, door exits or fire extinguishers. All equipment must be removed immediately after judging of your breed.
- DOGS must be on a leash at all times. No flexi-leads on show grounds.
- NO UNENTERED DOGS ALLOWED IN CONFORMATION, OBEDIENCE, & RALLY AREAS.
- EXHIBIT HALLS: No grooming. Your crates may be placed in designated areas during judging of your breed, but must be removed upon completion of your breed judging.
- DOG WASHING: There will be two tubs outside to wash dogs.
- Please be prepared for inclement or cold weather.
- OBEDIENCE AND RALLY BUILDING: There will be NO EARLY SETUPS. Crates must be removed at the end of class competition.

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS ON THE SHOW GROUNDS & AT YOUR MOTEL SITE. We want to retain these facilities for future events. Remember, all complaints regarding conduct prejudicial to the sport will be dealt with in accordance with AKC Rules by the Show Committee.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

PEE WEE CLASS SPECIAL ATTRACTION – SATURDAY ONLY

This Special Attraction will be held at lunch time when a ring becomes available. An announcement will be made.

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5-9 years of age. Safety is a primary concern.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

Entries are taken in person on Saturday morning at the Show Site (Club Table) 9:00AM to 11:00AM.

Entry fee: \$5.00 per dog. There is no limit on the number of teams, but they must be registered Saturday morning to participate.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- All AKC fully recognized and Miscellaneous Class breeds are allowed to enter, including dogs with a PAL listing.
- FSS breeds not in the Miscellaneous Class and All-American dogs are allowed to enter.
- In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Please contact Event Operations at eventplans@akc.org to request the current version of the Pee Wee Release of Liability. Releases will also be available at the event

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS – A reminder from the Show Committee to all Breeders/Exhibitors wanting to compete in the Pee Wee Class this weekend: Please keep your dogs that are entered in the Pee Wee Class away from the show ring until your class is called.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The purpose of the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner-Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.

- Dog must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS prior to the closing of entries. There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.
- Exhibitors must declare their dog AKC National Owner-Handled Series eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show. Dogs declared eligible will be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the judge's book, steward's book, and the show catalog.
- *Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit.
- The Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

USE OF RAMPS – ALL BREEDS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, American Water Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Grand Basset Griffon Vendeen, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs, and Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Boykin Spaniels, Whippets, Miniature Bull Terriers.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp, or on a table: Mudi.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirneco dell'Etnas, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows and Keeshonden.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (01/2021)

AKC SANCTIONED 4-6 MONTHS PUPPY FRIDAY, APRIL 16, 2021

Entries will close Wednesday Noon, March 31 at Superintendent's office.

One combined class will be offered for breeds and varieties of dogs that are (4) four months & under (6) six months and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. There will be a selection of Best 4 & Under 6 Months puppy in each Breed/ Variety. Each Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Breed/Variety winner will then compete in their respective group for First through Fourth Placements. The Miscellaneous Class Competition will be judged same as above followed by a Miscellaneous 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Group Competition. The Foundation Stock Service Class Competition will be judged same as above, followed by a FSS 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Group Competition. All First Place Group Winners will be eligible to compete in Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Show.

An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed or Miscellaneous breed. FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for FSS entries.

A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.

Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Show Competition.

AKC SUGGESTED BEST PRACTICES FOR THE WELL-BEING OF DOG SPORT PARTICIPANTS

The AKC urges clubs to take appropriate precautions for the benefit of their participants. Events need to be held in a manner that emphasizes the safety of participants and event officials over efficiency. The following is a list of suggested best practices. Participants in an event are required to adhere to the safety guidelines a club publishes in their premium list and Judging Program for their event. Event Committees are empowered by the AKC to deal with misconduct occurring in connection with their events.

GENERAL PRACTICES

- Clubs, officials and participants are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is held.
- Practice social distancing consistent with guidelines in effect at the time of the event. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
- Wearing face coverings is required within any show limits.
- Wash hands as frequently as possible.
- Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact.
- Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
- Avoid common use pens/pencils – bring your own.
- Chairs will not be provided.
- Participants should bring their own lunch/drinks.
- Vendors should follow retail guidelines for the area.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at every entrance and at multiple locations within the site.
- Parking/unloading staff will wear face coverings and sanitize their hands following the assistance of each individual.

EVENT PRACTICES

- Stewards will be responsible for finding the dog in the catalog if the exhibitor does not know the armband number and for handing out armbands. Stewards should not hand their catalog to exhibitors for review. Stewards should sanitize their hands frequently and will wear a face mask.
- It is the exhibitor's responsibility to clean up after their dog.
- Prepare to be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, bring a generator for electricity, bring personal use face coverings.
- Know the armband numbers for your entries before going to the ring. Bring rubber bands or armband clips to secure armband.
- Do not congregate at the ring or ring gate.
- While showing your dog, maintain social distances with other exhibitors.
- Forced air dryers are prohibited in indoor grooming areas.
- Judges will wear masks if otherwise not required.
- All classes should be called in catalog order to provide order and efficiency.
- Judges will sanitize hands after examining each entry. Re-examining of dogs should be minimized.
- Equipment used to measure and/or weigh dogs must be sanitized before and after each use.
- The location of the rings, indoors or outdoors, will be determined on the day of the event. Refunds will not be granted based on the final location.
- Juniors that have turned 18 on or after the date of the show may compete until Oct 31.
- Participants are expected to follow state, local government, facility and event guidelines. Clubs should be prepared to enforce the guidelines that apply to their event. The conformation field reps will assist as always in an advisory capacity.

At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 is required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 is required for each additional entry of the same dog.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks.
