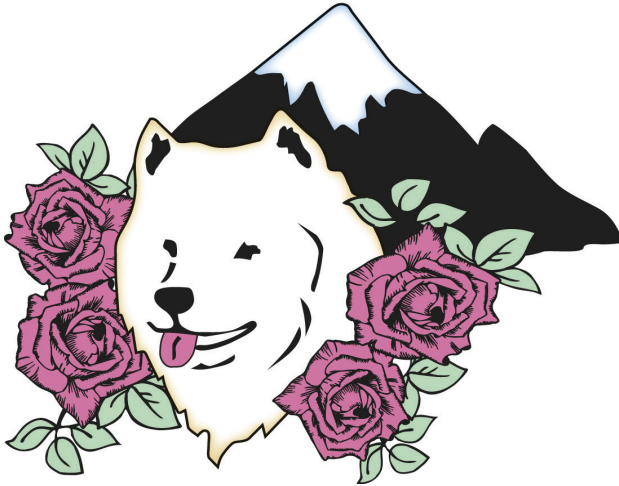

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List. The American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event: An AKC

Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions.)

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- PUBLICATION RIGHTS – By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

Neutered Dogs & Spayed Bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes at Specialty Shows.

WORKING DOGS WORKING BITCHES

Dogs and Bitches must be registered on a full registration with the AKC (limited registration, ILP and PAL and foreign registration cannot be accepted), must have a SCA working title (WS, WSX or WSXM), an AKC tracking title or an AKC performance event title that requires at least three (3) qualifying scores (included, but not limited to, obedience, rally, agility, herding, etc.). Any other AKC certifications, tests or titles based on pass/fail scores do not qualify (CGC, HIT, THD). A verification list of eligible dogs / bitches may be obtained from the SCA Working committee chairman. Champions of record that have working titles are also eligible.

Note: Per AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, effective June 28, 2023, neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veterans and all other single entry non-regular classes only at independent specialties which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed. Winners of the single dog entry non-regular classes, if not otherwise defeated, are eligible for Best of Breed

Winners of the above classes, if otherwise undefeated,

are eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Select Dog & Select Bitch, if applicable, will be chosen immediately following Best of Breed.

SPECIAL RECOGNITION - ALL EVENTS

AWARDS OF MERIT - Two (2) Awards of Merit (AOM) are offered in recognition of the quality dogs that are in serious contention for the top breed awards - made with no consideration as to sex. It is entirely the judge's decision whether to give two AOM, only one, or none. AOM exclude the winners of Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch, and Best of Winners that, by virtue of their placements have already been recognized.

BEST BRED-BY EXHIBITOR, BEST PUPPY, BEST VETERAN - Eligibility for Best Bred-by Exhibitor, Best Puppy, Best Veteran competitions is predicated upon entry into the following class(es) and all divisions of:

- Best Bred-By Exhibitor – the Bred-by-Exhibitor class including all divisions
- Best Puppy – any class limited to dogs six months and older and under 12 months of age; 6-9 Puppy and 9-12 Puppy
- Best Veteran – any non-regular Veteran Classes

For Best Bred-By Exhibitor, the eligibility criteria involving the individual handling the dog applies only to the original class entered and all competition specific to the special attraction. There are no restrictions as to who may handle the dog in any subsequent classes it may become eligible.

NOTE: Best Veteran, Best Puppy or Best Bred By Exhibitor competition will be forgone if the Best of Breed is one of the above.

All dogs entered in a Sweepstakes class must also be entered in a Regular Class or Best of Breed Competition at this Specialty, at the regular entry fee. Entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as the regular classes, indicating in the space for "Additional Classes" your entry in Sweepstakes.

DISTRIBUTION OF VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

Club shall retain 35% for expenses. After deductions, the balance of the monies received will be divided as follows:

Best in Sweepstakes.....25% Best of Opposite Sex.....20%

The remaining money will be divided evenly for First Prize in each class.

WORKING SWEEPSTAKES - SAT SHOW 1 & SUN SHOW 2

Working Sweepstakes Requirements & Classification: Working Sweepstakes is open to all Samoyeds that are actively pursuing a Working title recognized by the Samoyed Club of America or an AKC performance title. Winners of the Working Sweepstakes classes will compete for Best in Working Sweepstakes & Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Working Sweepstakes. Dogs shown in Working Sweepstakes may be altered. Dogs shown in Working Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. Indicate your Working Sweepstakes Class with the division in the space provided. The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches. Pretitled - (300 points earned in calendar year toward Samoyed Club of America WS title or one qualifying score in any AKC performance event)

Novice - (SCA WS title or any novice/initial AKC performance title; CA, CD, GN, HS, NA, NAI, NAP, NF, NFP, NJP, BN, OA, & RN)

Intermediate - (SCA WSX title or any intermediate AKC performance title; CAA, GO, HI, OA, OF, OJ, RE & XF)

Advanced - (SCA WSXM title or any advanced AKC performance title; AJX, AX, AXJ, AXP, CAX, CDX, HX, MJP, MX, MXF, MXJ, MXP, OGM, OM, PA, RA, UD, VC, XFP)

Documentation of qualifications for entry must accompany entries.

DISTRIBUTION OF SWEEPSTAKES & WORKING SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

Club shall retain 35% for expenses. The remaining 65% will be divided among the winners in each class as follows:

Best in Sweepstakes.....15% Best of Opposite Sex.....10%
