Winners of the Veterans classes need not be intact. Spayed and neutered animals may enter. Winners of these Non-Regular classes, if otherwise undefeated, will compete for Best of Breed.

### GUN DOG CLASS

This class is open only to those dogs/bitches that have received a title in AKC Hunt tests. Entries may be spayed or neutered. Winners (if undefeated) are eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

### BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Select Dog and Select Bitch, where applicable, will be chosen immediately following Best of Breed competition. To be followed by the Awards of Merit, Best Bred-by Exhibitor, Best Puppy, and Best Veteran.

**Three-Point Major Reserve (applies to National & Regional Specialties):** Dogs designated Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex total at least twice the number required for a five-point major in the region in which the event is held. Per Chapter 16, Section 1 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Option applies to events held on or after July 3, 2024.

**NOTE:** Per AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, effective June 28, 2023, neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veterans and all other single entry non-regular classes only at independent specialties which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed.

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries (National Specialty ONLY)

*Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.*

**Stud Dog:** For Stud Dog and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed/Variety Competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if Champion of Record, in Best of Breed Competition.

**Brood Bitch:** Same as above for Stud Dog except Substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**Brace:** A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers.) Both dogs must be entered in another class. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dog comprising each Brace must be so designated, "Brace # 1," "Brace # 2" etc.

## **SPECIAL RECOGNITION**

---

**Best Bred-by-Exhibitor:** During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-By-Exhibitor from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Bred-By-Exhibitor class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Bred-By-Exhibitor class are eligible for Best Bred-By-Exhibitor competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. The Dogs & Bitches in Bred-By-Exhibitor (Puppy) & Bred-By-Exhibitor (Adult) will compete for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor.

**Best Veteran Competition:** During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran from the Veteran Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Veteran award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Veteran class is awarded Best of Winner or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Veteran class are eligible for Best Veteran competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. Neutered and spayed dogs and bitches may compete.

**Best Puppy:** During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Puppy Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Puppy class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Puppy class are eligible for Best Puppy competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. Dogs & Bitches in the 6-9 Months, 9-12 Months and Puppy Bred-By-Exhibitor will compete for Best Puppy.

**Judge's Award of Merit:** The judge may select, at his discretion, up to 4 of the superior quality specimens from the intersex competition (up to two of each sex). These would not include those exhibits previously awarded Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog/ Bitch or Best of Winners.

## **OBEDIENCE & RALLY**

---

*Judge is limited to 8 hours of judging per day for Obedience and Rally combined. UDX, RAE & RACH Classes Offered. Jump heights where applicable will be in ascending order.*

The term "dog" refers to either dog or bitch in both Obedience and Rally. Qualifying scores are required for all trophies and rosettes in the regular classes. Non-Regular & Titling classes are not eligible for the Special Obedience Trial trophies, nor will qualifying scores be awarded AKC legs or points towards Obedience Trial Championships. OBEDIENCE & RALLY MOVE-UPS WILL BE ACCEPTED ACCORDING TO AKC REGULATIONS. No bitches in season may compete. Entry fees will be refunded for females in season. A processing fee may be retained by the club. (Obedience regulations Chapter 1, Section 14). A refund of all but \$3.00 for bitches in season upon presentation of a written statement from a veterinarian to the Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the beginning of regular class judging. A rosette will be given to each entry receiving a qualifying score in the Regular Classes. Qualifying score required for all prizes.

## **SWEEPSTAKES**

The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Clumber Spaniels six (6) months of age and under 24 months of age on the day of the show. ALL SWEEPSTAKES ENTRANTS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR BREED CLASS. Entries shall be made at the same time, and on the same entry form as for the Regular classes. The sweepstakes class should be entered in the Additional Class field with the age division noted on the same entry used to enter the dog or bitch in the regular class. The ten class winners shall compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

## **VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES**

The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Clumber Spaniels, seven (7) years of age and older on the date of the show. Entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes NEED NOT be entered in a Regular Breed Class. If this is the only class in which the dog is entered, indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" with the age division noted in the Dog Show Class field. If it is an additional class, indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" with the age division noted in the Additional Class field. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes.

### **VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES - DIVIDED BY SEX**

## **GUN-DOG SWEEPSTAKES**

The Gun-Dog Sweepstakes is open to all Clumber Spaniels that have earned an AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter, or Master Hunter title or legs toward titles. The highest level leg or title that a dog has earned will determine the class in which it will be entered. Dogs shown in Gun Dog Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular breed classes. Indicate your Gun Dog Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided. Neutered dogs & spayed bitches may be entered in Gun Dog Sweepstakes. Winners of each class will compete for Best in Gun Dog Sweepstakes & Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Gun-Dog Sweepstakes.

### **GUN-DOG SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES - DIVIDED BY SEX**

*The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.*

**Junior Hunter** - For dogs that have earned legs toward or the AKC JH Title

# AKC SANCTIONED 4-6 MONTHS PUPPY

**Entries will close Wednesday Noon, April 8, 2026 at Superintendent's office.**

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event.

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries. Exhibition-only entrants will participate in the same BPUP classes as regular entries. Judges will evaluate exhibition-only entrants in the same manner as regular entrants but will not consider them for awards. All Exhibition BPUP entries will receive an armband/catalog number starting with a capital "E."
- To be competitive, dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

## ***JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION***

---

**NOVICE CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

**MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

**NOVICE AND OPEN Class divided:** Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

**RESERVE JUNIOR HANDLER:** After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

**NOTICE:** Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

**NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S):** There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

## ***PRACTICE RING:***

---

An obedience practice ring will be provided in the show building, once set-up has been completed the late afternoon/evening of Monday, April 27th, 2026. This ring will be vacated after all members desiring, have completed their scheduled practice time and/or no later than 7:00PM. A sign-up sheet and a steward will be present to manage usage. There will be NO practice ring available during the event dates on Tuesday, April 28th - Thursday, April 30th.

### **RULES:**

**Procedure:** Only one dog and handler team may be in the ring at a time. Bait: No food, treats, or toys are allowed in the ring. Run Through: No intensive or abusive training is permitted on the premises. Equipment: All dogs must be on a leash when entering and exiting the ring.

**Availability:** Times noted above for Monday, April 27 only. The practice ring will be monitored at all times by a person or persons designated by the club. Ring times will be monitored to ensure equitable use by all members desiring to use the practice ring.

**Fee:** Use of the practice ring is free for all entered exhibitors.

## **PEE WEE CLASS SPECIAL ATTRACTION - WEDNESDAY**

---

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5–9 years of age. Children younger than five cannot participate in the Pee Wee Class Special Attraction. The safety of the children is a primary concern.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

At an All-Breed Event the judge must be an AKC approved All Breed Junior Showmanship Judge. A Group Club or Specialty Club may have a Limited Status Junior Showmanship Judge that meets the criteria.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- At a Group or Specialty Club Show the dogs must be of the breed(s) eligible for the event.
- It is up to the host club to decide if a dog must be registered to participate.
- How entries will be accepted is up to the host club. In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Please contact Event Operations at [eventplans@akc.org](mailto:eventplans@akc.org) to request the current version of the Pee Wee Release of Liability.
- The entry fee, if any, shall be specified.
- Clubs may specify a limit on the number of children allowed to enter the class.
- Clubs must submit a summary report to AKC including number of entries and feedback to the Sport Services Department.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

Although the word "judge" will be used, this is designed to be a learning and mentoring experience—no Junior will be "judged" but rather will be mentored with the age-appropriate amount of information to help prepare them for what they will be expected to know about AKC regular Junior Showmanship once they reach 9 years of age.

**Breed Eligibility:** Clumber Spaniels only. Entries: Entry acceptance procedures, entry fee (if any), and entry limits are at the discretion of the host club. A Release of Liability signed by the child's parent or legal guardian is required in addition to the entry form. Safety: An additional lead will be available at the judge's table. At the judge's discretion, based on the size of the child and dog, the adult may be asked to attach a second lead so both walk the dog together. Although the term "judge" is used, this is a mentoring and learning experience; no child is judged.

**Day-of-Show Registration:** Registration will be taken at the Club Table starting at 8:00 AM on the day of the show. Judging time will be posted.

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned.
