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NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List. The American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event: An AKC

Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions.)

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or BaRay Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- PUBLICATION RIGHTS – By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

4-6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries. Exhibition-only entrants will participate in the same BPUP classes as regular entries. Judges will evaluate exhibition-only entrants in the same manner as regular entrants but will not consider them for awards. All Exhibition BPUP entries will receive an armband/catalog number starting with a capital "E."
- To be competitive, dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

IMPORTANT PARKING INFORMATION

VEHICLE ACCESS & PARKING INFORMATION

- Primary driving access to the event site at the SW Washington Fairgrounds is shown on the Routes to the Show exhibit.
- Site access and parking information is shown on the 2026 TVDFA Show Site Map, and is described below.
- Entering vehicles will access the SW Washington Fairgrounds (event site) on the south end from S. Gold St. No other vehicular access point will be used for this event. There will be two access gates in use:
 - **Blue Gate:** All regular vehicles will use the Blue Gate to enter the site via its access road off S. Gold St. just south of the Fairgrounds office. Look for "Blue Gate" and/or "Parking" signage on S. Gold St. This access road will be "one-way" only for inbound regular traffic during the event. Two lane queuing will be used to approach the Blue Gate Check In Station outside the Blue Gate. Parking staff will process vehicles & collect parking fees. They will direct vehicles to appropriate parking locations. No RV, Vendor and other large vehicles will be allowed to enter the site via the Blue Gate during the event.
 - **RV Gate:** All RV, Vendor, Handlers and other large vehicles (aka RV's) will use the RV Gate to enter the event site through a gate located on S. Gold St. across from NE Exhibitor Road and north of the Fairgrounds office. Look for "RV Gate" and/or "RV Parking" signage on S. Gold St. The entry road will be "one-way" only for inbound RV's during the event. If necessary, two lane queuing may be used to approach the RV parking check-in station. All RV's will be processed at the RV Parking Check In Station, then will be directed to assigned spaces. No regular vehicles will be allowed to enter the site via the RV Gate.
- **All Exiting vehicles**, both regular and RV's, will leave the event site through the Blue Gate and proceed southerly on one-way exit road around the Senior Center to exit to S. Gold St./N. National Ave. (one way street toward Chehalis).

• Access Hours:

Wednesday Sept. 9

- RV Gate: Open from 12pm (noon) to 10pm.
- Blue Gate: Open from 6am to 10pm. Since this day is a set-up day and has no show events, parking check-in station will not be in place at Blue Gate for regular vehicles. All regular vehicles shall use this gate.

Thursday/Friday/Saturday Sept 10-12

- RV Gate: Open from 6am to 10pm.
- Blue Gate: Open from 6am to 10pm.

Sunday Sept 13

RV Gate: Closed. No RVs allowed to enter site, all RVs must enter site prior to Sunday.

Blue Gate: Open from 6am to 10pm. At end of show, all vehicles associated with the event must vacate the site by 7PM, exiting exclusively through the Blue Gate. No overnight stays will be allowed.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Do not park in or drive through the Senior Center parking lot located immediately south of the Blue Gate access road.
- Do not remove or move barricades, signs, warning tape or other traffic control items.
- All vehicle parking on the event site, including reserved or unreserved spaces or near buildings or roadways, shall be as directed by Parking Staff, or other TVDFA representatives. No Exceptions. No parked vehicle shall block a roadway within the event site unless specific permission has been given by authorized staff. Many site roadways are "emergency access lanes" which are required to be unobstructed in the case of an emergency response need during this show event. In the case of a vehicle parked in an unapproved location, TVDFA or its representatives, may attempt to locate the vehicle owner to resolve the problem. However, TVDFA or its representatives, will have the right to have the vehicle towed, and removed from the event site at the owner's expense whether an attempt to locate the owner is taken or not. It is the responsibility of vehicle owners to follow Parking staff directions and park in approved locations. TVDFA and its representatives will bear no responsibility for towing or related costs.

IMPORTANT PARKING INFORMATION

- Use of the event site is a privilege allowed by the Fairgrounds via a contract with TVDFA. TVDFA reserves the right to withdraw this privilege from anyone who uses abusive language or aggressive behavior, argues with Parking Staff or other TVDFA representatives, causes damage, or otherwise conducts themselves in an inappropriate manner. Withdrawal of this privilege will require immediate removal from the site and/or other enforcement activity if warranted.
- All parking and use of the event site is at your own risk. TVDFA and its representatives assume no liability for damages or loss to any vehicle or its contents.
- All vehicles shall observe max. speed limit of 5 MPH and use of hazard blinker lights on the event site. Safety for pedestrians, dogs and vehicles is paramount.
- Per AKC rules, use of vehicles near active show event locations is strictly prohibited. Generally, this will mean a minimum of 50 foot separation to avoid any disruptions to the show events. TVDFA and its representatives shall determine actual vehicle use and separation requirements as necessary to implement this AKC rule.

DAY PARKING

1. Day parking will be available for the event Thursday to Sunday. All day parking is unreserved, first come, first served. One vehicle per space per day.
2. Cost: \$10/day or \$30/4 days.
3. Payment: Cash (USD) only will be accepted; no credit cards, checks or e-pay.
4. Day parking is only available at the Blue Gate. Spaces will be near the Blue Gate inside the fence at the designated paved, striped parking area, with overflow parking outside the fence at its designated gravel area. Additional day parking area(s) may be provided at the discretion of TVDFA.
5. Vehicles in the paved day parking area must be able to occupy a standard parking space, to not impede traffic or use multiple spaces. In the case of an oversized vehicle, parking staff may require its use of the overflow parking area.
6. Temporary vehicle parking is allowed. No overnight parking, grooming, chairs, pens, cooking, electrical/water hookups, generators or pop-ups allowed in day parking areas. If desired, must use RV Parking to obtain appropriate space for those activities.
7. Enforcement of day parking requirements will occur. If unauthorized use of day parking occurs, day parking privileges may be revoked, and the vehicle will need to leave the site. Vehicles may be towed without notice at owner's expense.

HANDICAP PARKING

1. Handicap parking for regular, day parking vehicles is only available at the Blue Gate. Vehicles transporting a disabled individual shall display valid handicap parking placard and/or license plate or tab at Blue Gate Check In Station to be processed. Handicap parking will be provided on the event site in designated area with approximately 17 spaces with aisles available on first come, first served basis. Parking staff will direct applicable vehicles to this area.
2. Display of valid handicap parking placard and/or license plate or tab required at all times when using the handicap parking space. Vehicles without proper placard/license/tab display will be illegally parked and will be subject to removal/towing or other actions.
3. Cost: \$10/day or \$30/4 days
4. Payment: Cash (USD) only will be accepted; no credit cards, checks or e-pay.
5. Applicable restrictions noted for Day Parking apply to handicap parking also.

RESERVED PARKING

1. Reserved parking is only available at the Blue Gate. Vehicles must have prepaid advanced reservation for reserved parking and will notify parking staff to be confirmed and processed at Blue Gate Check In Station. Refer to Reserved Parking Form.
2. A designated paved Reserved Parking area with approximately 28 marked parking spaces will be located inside the Blue Gate. These will be first come, first served each day. Parking staff will direct vehicles to this area.
3. Vehicles in the paved reserved parking area must be able to occupy a standard parking space, to not impede traffic or use multiple spaces.
4. Vehicles only allowed to park during the day, no overnight parking.
5. Cost: Pre-paid advanced reservation required.
6. Payment: No fee will be collected on site.
7. Applicable restrictions noted for Day Parking apply to reserved parking also.

IMPORTANT PARKING INFORMATION

RV PARKING FOR VENDOR, HANDLER, EXHIBITOR & OTHER LARGE VEHICLE (RV's)

1. TVDFA has arranged for NW Dog Show Parking (RV Parking staff) to manage all RV parking for this event.
2. Overnight RV parking access is only available via the RV Gate and its entry road. All overnight vehicles within the event site must use the RV Gate and be checked in prior to parking. This will typically include exhibitors, handlers, vendors and any other large oversize vehicles.
3. Overnight RV parking for the event, including Thursday specialty events, will be provided from Wednesday through Saturday. No RV parking access will be allowed on Sunday.
4. RV parking for the event generally will be reserved and pre-paid in advance. RV Parking staff will use reservations to assign spaces, process check in, collect fees due, & guide RVs to their assigned site. Refer to the RV Parking Reservation Form.
5. For RV's arriving without an advance reservation, RV Parking staff will process and collect "no-reservation" fees, assign an appropriate space and guide RVs to their site. All no-reservation RV parking is subject to availability of appropriate sites and is not guaranteed to be available.
6. Cost:
 - a. Overnight Reserved RV Parking: \$70/night, pre-paid.
 - b. Overnight No-Reservation Parking: \$80/night will be paid at RV check in station.
 - c. Car in Tow/Extra Vehicles: \$35/each paid at RV check in station (or prepaid).
7. Payment:
 - a. Overnight Reserved RV Parking: Pre-paid reservation, no fee collected on site.
 - b. Overnight No-Reservation Parking: Cash (USD) only; no credit cards, checks or e-pay.
 - c. Car in Tow/Extra Vehicles: Cash (USD) only; no credit cards, checks or e-pay (or prepaid).

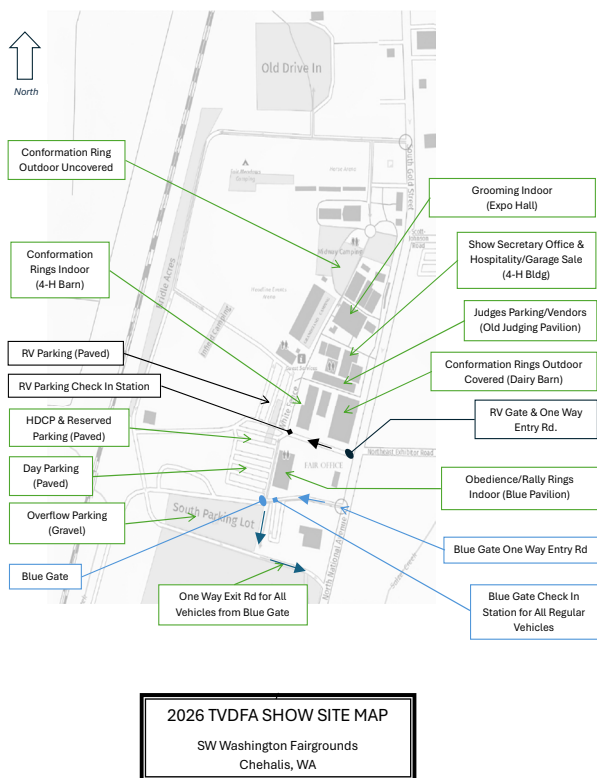
