DEAR EXHIBITORS...

The Lake Shore Kennel Club, Inc., Welcomes you to our All Breed Dog Shows, and Obedience & Rally Trials. It is a difficult time to put on an event so please be respectful of everyone, club members, volunteers and judges.

The following are changes and rules to our 2021 shows due to COVID-19.

The 4H Building (Bldg3) where Toy, Terrier and some Non-Sporting Breeds have previously been judged is unavailable. This building is being used to administer COVID-19 vaccinations on Saturday.

All rings will be in the Industrial Arts Building (large bldg with four wings) with the exception of Obedience & Rally. Obedience & Rally judging will be held in the Fine Arts Building where it has been in the past.

There will be limited number of reserved grooming spaces in the Industrial Arts Building.

See reserved grooming form on page 6.

Unreserved grooming will be available in the following areas:

Annex Building

Covered open sided cement floor pavilion north of the main entrance, electric available.

NO CHAIRS will be available and NO PERSONAL CHAIRS are allowed in any of the buildings or grooming areas.

NO FORCED AIR OR STAND DRYERS are allowed. Hand held dryers are allowed.

MASKS ARE MANDATORY in all buildings, tent and grooming areas.

Crates will only be allowed 15 minutes before your scheduled ring time and must be removed immediately following your judging.

Everyone on the Show grounds MUST follow the rules. Failure to do so may result in removal from the show grounds and/or bench committee hearing.

By entering our shows you are agreeing to the rules and guidelines put forth by the Lake Shore Kennel Club, Inc., AKC, CDC, the State of Indiana, Lake County Indiana and the City of Crown Point.

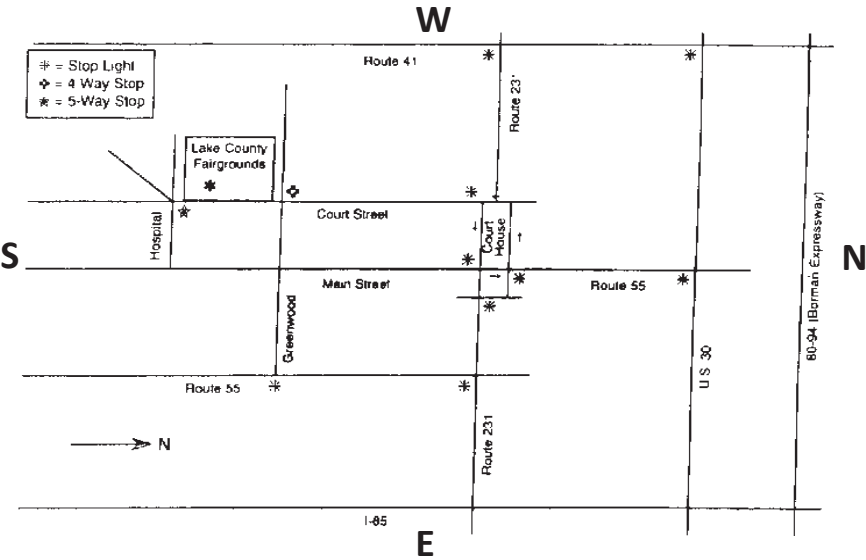

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Masks are required in all buildings at all times
- Show & go show only. Reserved Grooming only.
- CONFORMATION, OBEDIENCE, JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP & RALLY ENTRANTS: BUILDING WILL BE AVAILABLE FRIDAY AFTERNOON FROM 3:00PM UNTIL 9:00PM. The above provisions for leaving dogs in the Lake County Fairgrounds overnight is a provision of the Clubs for the convenience of the exhibitors. The Club, their members, directors, officers, agents, show superintendent, and the said employees of the said kennel club and/or its superintendents will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through the loss, theft, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event whether said loss, theft, injury and/or death is or are caused by the negligence or carelessness of the said Kennel Clubs, their members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents, and/or employees of the said Kennel Clubs and/or employees of their superintendents or by negligence of any person or any other cause.
- NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED IN THE RESTROOMS OR OTHER DESIGNATED AREAS.
- DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH or confined to their crates except when being judged or in the exercise pens provided.
- THE LAKE COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS will be available on Friday and Saturday nights for exhibitors who wish to leave their dogs in the building overnight. The building will be locked promptly at 9:00PM each night and will not reopen until 6:30AM the following morning.
- PARKING IS FREE.
- NO MESH CRATES ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING.
- BUILDING & RESTROOMS ARE HANDICAPPED ACCESSIBLE.
- HANDICAP PARKING – Limited handicap parking is available.
- NO PARKING OR BLOCKING OF ANY ENTRANCE OR EXIT OF ANY BUILDING EXCEPT FOR LOADING OR UNLOADING. AFTER UNLOADING, VEHICLES MUST BE MOVED AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE. Vehicles left in the unloading area more than 30 minutes with no activity will be ticketed or towed without further announcement. Note: Towing charges are approximately \$100.00. All parking is at the discretion of the Club. Overnight parking will be in designated spaces only. (See next page for reservation form). Failure to comply with these rules may result in an Event Committee hearing. The saving of space will be on a limited basis only and at the total discretion of the Club.
- RV PARKING Ample in Designated Areas – No RV parking on the south side of the main area or on the public streets outside of the Fairgrounds.
- MUST TURN OFF CELL PHONES and/or PAGERS BEFORE ENTERING RINGS.
- No puppies under 6 mos. of age will be allowed on the show grounds during show hours, except for entrants into the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy.
- UNENTERED DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.
- CLEAN UP NOTICE: Exhibitors/Handlers will be held responsible for keeping their grooming & crating areas clean. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action. All litter must be placed in containers that are provided on the grounds and in the buildings.
- EXHIBITORS MUST CLEAN UP AFTER THEIR OWN DOGS IN ALL GRASS AND PAVED AREAS OF THE FAIRGROUNDS. For the convenience of the exhibitors and their dogs, exercise pens will be available for the animal's toiletry needs. PLEASE EXERCISE DOGS BEFORE ENTERING THE SHOW RING.
- Electricity is provided on a limited basis AND IT IS EXPECTED THAT IT WILL BE SHARED.
- NO STROLLERS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE EXPOSITION BUILDINGS. The welfare of a child is assumed to be the responsibility of the adult bringing the child to the show. It is distinctly understood that adults will exercise control and restraint over their children at all times.
- NO SMOKING IN BUILDING AT ANY TIME.
- NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES. Lake County Fairgrounds prohibits any alcoholic beverages to be carried in.
- No cutting of rope or tape or removal of any barricade.
- No grooming or crates allowed at ringside. Show & Go crates will be allowed at ringside in designated areas during that breeds' judging at the discretion of the Show committee.
- NO CONES TO SAVE SPACES ALLOWED IN SOUTH LOT.

"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."

June 25, 2021 (Fri.) thru June 27, 2021 (Sun.)

- ALL RV and overnight parking is by reservation only and in designated areas. Space is limited. Spaces Assigned by Club.
- By local ordinance, the fairgrounds gates are closed at 9:00PM each evening and reopen at approx. 6:30AM. No RVs will be admitted on Friday or Saturday evening after the fairgrounds is closed. No exceptions are made under Fairgrounds rules. Emergency exit instructions will be provided to those in place by 9:00 pm each evening.
- Reservations are on a first come, first served basis within the grounds; no specific space is reserved for any party.
- Reservations must indicate and pay for electrical to have access to electrical hookups! **If you pay for a space without electrical, you will not be permitted to plug into the Fairground electrical hookups.** Electrical hookups are only permitted in designated spaces. **Limit two plug-ins per space** where electrical has been paid for. Very limited electrical hookup spaces available.
- **ONLY 15 Amp max service available.** Overtaxed service may blow fuses and fairground reset is not available overnight. **NO REFUNDS FOR BLOWN FUSES DUE TO OVERTAXING AMPERAGE.**
- The Lake County Fairgrounds is not a camping fairgrounds. No gray dump or water hookups available. No dumping on grounds of facility. Violators will be subject to disciplinary action.
- NO HANDICAPPED RV PARKING IS AVAILABLE as the parking lot is not set up for RV camping and RV parking for the show is an exception provided by the Fairgrounds.
- Please dispose of trash in overnight area properly. Coals may not be left on ground.
- Reservations must be received on or before June 9, 2021

AKC SANCTIONED 4-6 MONTHS PUPPY
SATURDAY, JUNE 26, 2021 & SUNDAY, JUNE 27, 2021

Entries will close Wednesday Noon, June 9, 2021 at Superintendent's office.

One combined class will be offered for breeds and varieties of dogs that are (4) four months & under (6) six months and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. there will be a selection of Best 4 & Under 6 Months puppy in each Breed/ Variety, each Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Breed/Variety winner will then compete in their respective group for First through Fourth Placements. The Miscellaneous Class Competition will be judged same as above followed by a Miscellaneous 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Group Competition. The Foundation Stock Service Class Competition will be judged same as above, followed by a FSS 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Group Competition. All First Place Group Winners will be eligible to compete in Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Show.

An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed or Miscellaneous breed. FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for FSS entries.

A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.

Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Show Competition.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 is required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 is required for each additional entry of the same dog.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. USE OF RAMPS – ALL BREEDS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, American Water Spaniels, Boykin Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Grand Basset Griffon Vendeen, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs, and Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Whippets, Miniature Bull Terriers.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp, or on a table: Mudi.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirneco dell'Etnas, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows and Keeshonden.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (01/2021)

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
