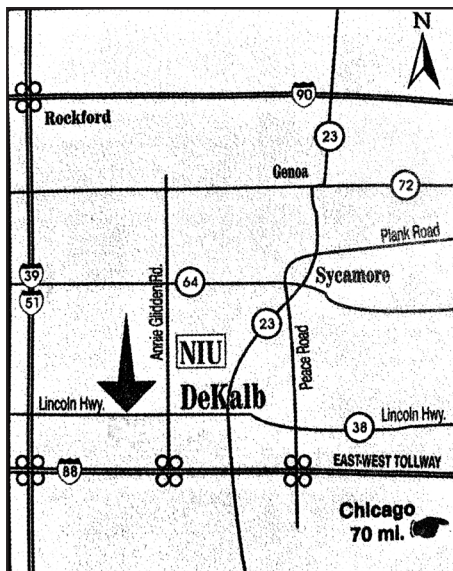

**FROM EAST OR WEST:** Take I-88 to Annie Glidden Road exit and follow directions above.

**FROM I-90:** Exit onto Route 47 South to Route 38 West approximately 20 miles to the Convocation Center entrance. See Map.

### ATTENTION OWNERS

**"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."**

**No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.**

## **GENERAL INFORMATION/RULES**

---

- Site will be available Friday, April 5, 2024. The Building will be open to Vendors and Exhibitors at 2:00PM or when BaRay is done with setup on the upper level (NO EXCEPTIONS). The Building will be locked at 10:00PM on Friday, April 5, and Saturday, April 6, 2024. The Building will reopen at 6:30AM each day. All dogs and equipment must be removed from the show site following Best in Show on Sunday, April 7, 2024.
- DOGS MAY BE LEFT IN THE BUILDING OVERNIGHT, BUT MUST BE CRATED. A local contact or cell phone number must be left with dogs crated overnight.
- BUILDING IS HANDICAPPED ACCESSIBLE TO MAIN FLOOR & GROOMING AREA.
- The management/Superintendent/Club or its members will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog on site or for possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of an accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care, custody and control of its owner, agent or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show grounds. Show Superintendent and the employees of the Club and/or the Superintendent, will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through loss, theft, injury and/ or death of dogs entered at these events, whether said loss, theft, injury and/or death is or are caused by the negligence or carelessness of the said Kennel Club, their members, directors, officers, agents, Superintendent or by negligence of any person or by any other cause.
- All grooming is indoors. Limited electric is available in several areas. Please share outlets.
- Grooming in designated areas only. Grooming areas will be monitored and supervised. The club reserves the right to restrict or consolidate grooming space.
- Crates and equipment must be stacked.
- No rugs or mats on the floor.
- Private exercise pens are NOT allowed in building. No ex-pens used as crates. This includes puppy/cocker/drop pens. Ample OUTSIDE exercise area is available and MUST be kept clean. Those individuals not picking up after their dogs will be subject to discipline.
- No saving of grooming or parking spaces. Tape, cords, rope and cones will be removed and become the property of the Kennel Club.
- In accordance with building regulations: NO materials may be taped, stapled, nailed, tacked etc. to the floors, walls, ceiling or posts.
- Limited crate space may be available on level of the main show rings. There is NO electric available on the show floor and NO dryers allowed.
- Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping their grooming area clean. Please bring a broom and keep the grooming area free of debris. Aisles must be kept clear.
- Exhibitors are reminded to honor "NO DOG" areas. Dogs are not allowed in the Convocation Center lobby, on the passenger elevator or on tiled floor areas. Dogs are allowed in the freight elevator.
- This is a handicapped accessible facility with elevator access. No dogs permitted on this elevator.
- FREIGHT ELEVATOR is available during hours posted by the University. Staircases are available all day.
- Unentered dogs are not allowed on the show grounds. Dogs in attendance solely for the health clinics should stay in the clinic area and leave the building following their scheduled appointment.
- All dogs must be on a leash except while in obedience competition or when on the table, crated, or in an exercise pen. Dogs left on the table or in an ex-pen MUST be properly supervised.
- No Flexi leads allowed in the building.
- No Double Handling.
- Please turn off cell phones and pagers in the ring area. No cell phones allowed in the rings.
- NO SMOKING at any time in the building.
- No strollers permitted.
- Children must be under the direct control and supervision of an adult guardian.
- Flyers, brochures or other advertising materials may not be placed or distributed without the permission of the show giving club. No solicitation.
- Permission to videotape must be requested of and granted by the Show Chairperson & Building Superintendent.
- Food Vendor on site. NO OUTSIDE FOOD WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING.
- ADMISSION FOR SPECTATORS IS FREE. The Kennel Club of Yorkville, Illinois hopes our exhibitors will join us in extending hospitality to our spectators and guests. In an effort to foster the sport of purebred dogs we encourage everyone to conduct themselves in a friendly and courteous manner.

## ***AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES (NOHS) – BOTH DAYS***

---

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Professional handlers,\* household members and current assistants to professional handlers\*\* may not exhibit. Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners competition.

*\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

*\*\*A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

**PEE WEE CLASS SPECIAL ATTRACTION - SUNDAY ONLY**

**JUDGE - LEE KOUSKI, # 100825**

This Special Attraction will be held at lunch time when a ring becomes available. An announcement will be made. The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5-9 years of age. Safety is a primary concern.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

Entries are taken in person. No Entry fee. Limit is 15 Teams. Entrants must be registered at the show to participate. Registration will be taken at the Club Table on Saturday and on Sunday morning until 10:00AM.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- All AKC fully recognized and Miscellaneous Class breeds are allowed to enter, including dogs with a PAL listing.
- FSS breeds not in the Miscellaneous Class and All-American dogs are allowed to enter.
- In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Please contact Event Operations at [eventplans@akc.org](mailto:eventplans@akc.org) to request the current version of the Pee Wee Release of Liability. Releases will also be available at the event.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

One combined class will be offered for breeds and varieties of dogs that are (4) four months & under (6) six months and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. there will be a selection of Best 4 & Under 6 Months puppy in each Breed/ Variety, each Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Breed/Variety winner will then compete in their respective group for First through Fourth Placements. All First Place Group Winners will be eligible to compete in Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Show.

A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.

Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Show Competition.

## ***JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION***

## **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS**

**The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.**

The American Kennel Club will collect: a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee where applicable for the first entry of a dog, plus a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 is required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 is required for each additional entry of the same dog.

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.**
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE.** BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- **REFUNDS** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent **AFTER THE SHOW.** An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Clubs is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- **FAX ENTRIES** – Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES** or **OVER PAYMENTS**. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show **NO REFUND** will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- **LOSS OR DAMAGE** – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- **PUBLICATION RIGHTS** – By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

# AKC Code of Sportsmanship

*PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.*

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.



## USE OF RAMPS - ALL BREEDS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged **on the ground or on a ramp** through all levels of competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, American Water Spaniels, Boykin Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Grand Basset Griffon Vendeen, Whippets, German Pinschers, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Australian Cattle Dogs, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs, and Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on a **ramp or table** through all levels of competition: Mudi, Puli.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on the **ground, ramp, or table** through all levels of competition: Miniature Bull Terriers.

The following breeds **must be judged on a ramp** through all levels of conformation competition: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirneco dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows and Keeshonden.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (02/2024)
