Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

VETERAN DOG VETERAN BITCH

A class for Dogs and a class for Bitches, 6 years of age and older. Dogs/bitches entered in Veterans must be intact. Winners, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible for Best of Breed competition.

SELECT DOG SELECT BITCH

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Select Dog and Select Bitch, where applicable, will be chosen immediately following Best of Breed competition.

BEST VETERAN COMPETITION – Best Veteran will be awarded from the First Place winners in the Veterans Classes immediately following each breed. If the Best of Breed is awarded to a dog/bitch coming from the Veterans Class, the Best Veteran win is automatic.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR COMPETITION – Best Bred by Exhibitor will be awarded from the First Place winners in the Regular Bred by Exhibitor Classes immediately following each breed. If the Best of Breed is awarded to a dog/bitch coming from the Bred by Exhibitor Class, the Best Bred by Exhibitor win is automatic.

BEST PUPPY COMPETITION – Best Puppy will be awarded from the First Place winners in the Regular Puppy Classes (6-9 mos. & 9-12 mos. ONLY) immediately following each breed. If the Best of Breed is awarded to a dog/bitch coming from one of the Puppy Classes for that breed, the Best Puppy win is automatic.

From I-5: Take Exit 33 (Central Point). Turn East on Biddle (E. Pine) St. to Peninger Rd. (just past the freeway). Turn Left on Peninger Rd. to the Jackson County Expo/Fairgrounds. (Pine street is on west side, Biddle is on the East side of the hwy.)

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors 2:00PM on Tuesday, November 2, 2021. **THIS IS A SHOW AND GO FORMAT SHOW, PLEASE LIMIT THE TIME YOUR CRATES ARE IN THE BUILDING TO 10 MINUTES BEFORE AND AFTER YOUR JUDGING TIME.**

Dogs and crates must be removed from the Show Site within one hour of show completion each day. **NO EX-PENS** inside the Event Center. RVs must be removed from the assigned parking area Sunday Evening, unless previously reserved with the Jackson County Expo Center. Exhibitors are responsible for cleanup after their dogs.

This is a self cleaning show, this means all buildings and all the outside areas. Non-cleanup will result in an Event Committee Hearing. This includes the Grooming Building. Obedience and rally rings will be indoors. Exact location will be determined after closing. If space permits, they will be in the Seven Feathers Arena, which is packed dirt. Otherwise, they will be moved to the Paghdam Building, which is mats over tile. There will be **NO** indoor crating areas, but parking areas adjacent to the building will be reserved for obedience/rally exhibitors. Friday classes will start at noon.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS: At our Expo Center Management's request, there are to be **NO** mats or shavings put on the grass.

Children are the responsibility of parents.

Dogs left in vehicles and in distress will be removed from the car by any possible means. Payment for removal and potential damage caused to vehicles when removing animals is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Leaving a dog in a vehicle while in distress will result in an Event Committee Hearing.

WAIVER OF RIGHTS: All persons attending these dog events hereby waive any claim for damages against the Richmond Dog Fanciers Club, Inc., & Southern Oregon Kennel Club or their members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 is required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 is required for each additional entry of the same dog.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Clubs is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. - Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
