

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - ALL EVENTS



The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List. The American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event:

• First entry of a dog in Conformation or Obedience, a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee, plus a \$3.50 Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog. • First entry and each additional entry of a dog in Agility or Rally. \$3.50 Service Fee.

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned
 entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of
 Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events
 assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the
 owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee
 to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required
 to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same
 person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by
 the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all
 refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- · FAX ENTRIES Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the
 Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been
 entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil
 disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the
 Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation
 Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our
 exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property
 during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the
 offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must
 be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service
 for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a
 class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- · Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external
 parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any
 specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- PUBLICATION RIGHTS By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

Dogs/Bitches entered in Veterans need not be intact. Spayed and Neutered animals are eligible.

Winners of the above Non-Regular Classes, if otherwise undefeated, compete for Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship

Select immediately following Best of Breed: Select Dog/Bitch, Awards of Merit, Best Brindle, Best from the Regular Puppy Classes, Best from the Bred By Exhibitor Classes, Best Veteran. (See page 6).

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

Note - As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Get must be entered individually in one of the Regular Classes or Best of Breed. *

BROOD BITCH CLASS: Same as Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.*

*Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".

BRACE CLASS: For two dogs with at least one common owner and presented in the ring with no more than one handler. Both dogs must be entered in another class at this specialty show. The entry form for each dog entered as a part of a brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space for Additional Classes - "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc.

WE MUST KEEP FIRE LANES AS WELL AS OTHER AREAS CLEAR PLEASE PARK ONLY IN THE DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

- NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.
- OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.
- MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.
- **NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED**: Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

SPECIAL RECOGNITION

- BEST BRINDLE: After Best of Breed, Selects and Awards of Merit are chosen, the qualifying brindle dogs/bitches compete for Best Brindle. This is competition is open to any brindle competing in Regular Classes, not defeated by another brindle. Open to Highest Placing Brindle in each class. If no placing brindles in class, then all brindles in class are then eligible.
- BEST PUPPY FROM THE REGULAR CLASSES: After Best of Breed, Selects and Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of regular puppy classes (6-9, 9-12 & Bred-By Exhibitor Puppy) compete for Best Puppy from the Regular Classes. If Best of Winners is from the regular puppy classes, that entry is automatically Best Puppy from the Regular Classes.
- BEST VETERAN: After Best of Breed, Selects and Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of the veteran classes compete for Best Veteran. If Best of Breed is from a veteran's class, that entry is automatically Best Veteran.
- BEST FROM THE BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES: After Best of Breed, Selects and Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of Bred By Exhibitor Adult/Puppy Dog and Bred By Exhibitor Adult/Puppy Bitch compete for Best Bred by Exhibitor. If Best of Winners is from the Bred by Exhibitor class, that entry is automatically Best Bred by Exhibitor.
- NOTE: Best Veteran, Best Brindle or Best Puppy competition will be forgone if the Best of Breed is one or more of the above.
- AWARDS OF MERIT: The judge may, at his/her discretion, recall into the ring up to five (5) Bull-mastiffs (including Best of Breed & Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed) to receive a silver ornament with inlay of award. These ornate silver ornaments are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

AKC SANCTIONED 4-6 MONTHS PUPPY

Entries will close Wednesday Noon, November 12, 2025 at Superintendent's office.

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event.

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries. Exhibition-only entrants will participate in the same BPUP classes as regular entries. Judges will evaluate exhibition-only entrants in the same manner as regular entrants but will not consider them for awards. All Exhibition BPUP entries will receive an armband/catalog number starting with a capital "E."
- To be competitive, dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes and is open to all Bullmastiffs who on the day of the show, will be 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. Classes will be divided by age and sex. All entries in the sweepstakes MUST also be entered in a Regular Class or for Best of Breed at this show. Entries shall be made at the same time and on the same entry forms as for the Regular Classes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and the age division in the space provided for "Additional Classes." Each dog entered must be handled by the owner, by a member of the owner's immediate family, or by an amateur handler with exception that professional handlers may handle only dogs that they own/co-own or are the breeder/co-breeder of record and handle without recompense. All prize money is the property of the owner.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes and is open to all Bullmastiffs who on the day of the show, will be 6 years of age or older. Classes will be divided by age and sex. Champions of Record are eligible for the Veteran Sweepstakes. Each dog or bitch NEED NOT be entered in a Regular Class at the show. Entries shall be made on a regular entry form. Indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" and the age division in the space provided for "Additional Classes." Dogs and bitches which have been altered (castrated or spayed) may be entered. Entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes may be shown by anyone in good standing with the American Kennel Club.

PEE WEE CLASS SPECIAL ATTRACTION

NO ENTRY FEE • JUDGE: JOHN DEWING - BULLMASTIFFS ONLY-

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5–9 years of age. Children younger than five cannot participate in the Pee Wee Class Special Attraction. The safety of the children is a primary concern.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

At an All-Breed Event the judge must be an AKC approved All Breed Junior Showmanship Judge. A Group Club or Specialty Club may have a Limited Status Junior Showmanship Judge that meets the criteria.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
 - All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
 - At a Group or Specialty Club Show the dogs must be of the breed(s) eligible for the event.
 - At an All-Breed event, all AKC fully recognized and Miscellaneous Class breeds must be allowed to enter, including dogs with a PAL listing.
 - At an All-Breed event, it is up to the host club to decide if FSS breeds not in the Miscellaneous Class and All-American dogs are allowed to enter.
 - It is up to the host club to decide if a dog must be registered to participate.
- How entries will be accepted is up to the host club. In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Please contact Event Operations at

eventplans@akc.org to request the current version of the Pee Wee Release of Liability.

- The entry fee, if any, shall be specified.
- Clubs may specify a limit on the number of children allowed to enter the class.
- Clubs must submit a summary report to AKC including number of entries and feedback to the Sport Services Department.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

Although the word "judge" will be used, this is designed to be a learning and mentoring experience—no Junior will be "judged" but rather will be mentored with the age-appropriate amount of information to help prepare them for what they will be expected to know about AKC regular Junior Showmanship once they reach 9 years of age.

REGISTRATION WILL BE TAKEN AT THE CLUB TABLE IN THE MORNING STARTING AT 8:00AM. EACH ENTRANT WILL BE REQUIRED TO FILL OUT AN ENTRY FORM. IN ADDITION TO AN ENTRY, A RELEASE MUST BE SIGNED BY THE CHILD'S PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN. JUDGING WILL BE HELD DURING THE LUNCH BREAK. NO ENTRY FEE.
