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NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List. The American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event: An AKC

Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions.)

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- PUBLICATION RIGHTS – By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

VETERAN DOG VETERAN BITCH

A class for Dogs and a class for Bitches, 7 years of age and older. Dogs/bitches entered in Veterans must be intact. Winners, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible for Best of Breed competition.

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Selects, if applicable, will be chosen following Best of Breed.

BEST PUPPY COMPETITION - SATURDAY ONLY

Best Puppy will be awarded from the First Place winners in the Regular Puppy Classes ONLY immediately following each breed. If the Best of Breed is awarded to a dog/bitch coming from one of the Puppy Classes for that breed, the Best Puppy win is automatic. The Best Puppy from each breed will then compete for First through Fourth place awards in the Puppy Working Group. The First Place puppy is also awarded the Best Puppy in Working Group. Judge for Best Puppy in Breed will be as published for the regular classes. Puppy Group judge will be the same as regular group judge.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR COMPETITION - SUNDAY ONLY

Best Bred by Exhibitor will be awarded from the First Place winners in the Regular Bred by Exhibitor Classes ONLY immediately following each breed. If the Best of Breed is awarded to a dog/bitch coming from one of the Bred by Exhibitor Classes for that breed, the Best Bred by Exhibitor win is automatic. The Best Bred by Exhibitor from each breed will then compete for First through Fourth place awards in the Working Group. The First Place winner is also awarded the Best Bred by Exhibitor in Working Group. Judge for Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed will be as published for the regular classes. Bred by Exhibitor Group judge will be the same as regular group judge.

USE OF RAMPS - WORKING BREEDS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breed may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition: German Pinschers, Standard Schnauzers.

This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (08/2022)

PEE WEE CLASS SPECIAL ATTRACTION - SUNDAY ONLY

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5–9 years of age. Children younger than five cannot participate in the Pee Wee Class Special Attraction. The safety of the children is a primary concern.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

Although the word "judge" will be used, this is designed to be a learning and mentoring experience—no Junior will be "judged" but rather will be mentored with the age-appropriate amount of information to help prepare them for what they will be expected to know about AKC regular Junior Showmanship once they reach 9 years of age.

JUDGE: Ms. Tanya Tresino (Sun)

This class will be run after the Working Best in Show and before the Toy group starts their classes.

Each Pee Wee will receive a Rainbow Flat Ribbon, a Bag of Grooming Supplies and a WGDCA Logo drool towel.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

FROM THE SOUTH (ANCHORAGE): Follow AK-1 N/Glenn Hwy to S. Birchwood Loop Rd. Take the exit toward S. Birchwood from AK-1 N/Glenn Hwy. Continue onto AK-1 N/Glenn Hwy. 15.6 mi. Take the exit toward S. Birchwood. Drive to Old Glenn Hwy. Turn right onto S. Birchwood Loop Rd. Turn left onto Old Glenn Hwy. Destination will be on the left.

FROM THE NORTH (WASILLA/PALMER): Follow AK-1 S/Glenn Hwy toward Anchorage. Use the right 2 lanes to take the exit toward N. Birchwood. Drive to Old Glenn Hwy. Turn left onto Birchwood Loop Rd. Turn right onto Old Glenn Hwy. Destination will be on the right.

- General Grooming set-up will be open starting approximately 6:00PM on Friday, September 4.
- All Generators will be allowed only at fence line setups or behind the fence in your setup. Electricity & shelters are not available at this show site so you will need to make your own arrangements for a generator & easy-up shelter.
- Due to SAFETY, there will be NO extension cords for generators run past those setups along the fence line.
- NO DOGS ALLOWED in children's playgrounds on CBA location. This risks the club's ability to continue holding their shows on this site and the Event Committee will hold hearing(s) if anyone has not complied that is entered. Signs will be posted for everyone's attention for all dogs entered.
- The welfare of an Exhibitor's children and dog(s) is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children and dog(s) OR THEY WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOW PREMISES. (This includes disturbances as well.)
- There shall be no breeding on or within the show precincts.
- ALL DOGS shall be kept on leash.
- No smoking allowed inside the fenced area. Smoking will be outside the fenced area.
- IF IT IS NECESSARY TO RESCUE A DOG from a parked car on the show grounds, the Club will not be responsible or liable for any damages to the car involved.
- No Alcoholic Beverage use allowed.
- WGDCA will exercise every precaution for the safety of the dogs exhibited and it is understood that neither the club nor the management nor the landlord will be responsible for the loss of, damage to or any damage caused by any dog from any cause.
- WGDCA may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show premises on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, & no one shall have any claim or recourse against WGDCA or any officials thereof for such action.
- Except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows, NO DOGS wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class. OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS in any forms, regardless of who may make such errors.
- The show giving Club, the Event Secretary, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION - OPEN TO ALL BREEDS

The AKC Board of Directors approved a pilot program to not require ownership for a dog to be entered in Conformation Junior Showmanship. This is in effect for these shows.

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.
