NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List. The

American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event: An AKC Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions.)

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES - Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE - The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- PUBLICATION RIGHTS - By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

Dogs/Bitches entered in Veterans Class need not be intact. Spayed and Neutered animals are eligible.

Winners of the above non-regular classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible for Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record; and Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If at the end of the 90 day period the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

Non-Regular Classes (involving multiple dog entries)

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class: Each entry is allowed a minimum of two get (maximum of four). The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

Brace Class: Two dogs of the same Breed with one or more common owner(s) and both dogs must be entered in another class, or if a Champion of Record, in the Best of Breed competition and presented by a maximum of two handlers. - The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.

Sweepstakes is open to all Canaan Dogs at least 6 months of age but under 24 months of age, which may or may not be Champions of Record. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee.

Neutered dogs & spayed bitches are eligible to compete. Winners will not be allowed to go on to any placement in the rest of the show as a result of participating in the Veteran Sweepstakes Classes. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes or at the regular entry fee.

From Charlotte, Kings Mountain & Gastonia (via I-85): Take I-85 North to Exit 48 (I-485). Turn right on I-485 Inner Loop, travel to NC 49 (Harrisburg). Turn left on 49 North, through Harrisburg - cross under US 601(Bridge) and follow NC 49 3.2 miles. Arena will be on the left.

-Or: Take I-485 Inner Loop to Exit 33 (Hwy. 49N - Harrisburg). Stay on Hwy. 49 North for approximately 13.5 miles. Arena will be on the left.

From Albemarle: Take NC 73 West through Mt. Pleasant. Turn right on NC 49 South and travel 2.9 miles. Arena will be on the right.

From Asheboro: Travel NC 49 South, pass under NC 73 (bridge) and travel 2.9 miles. Arena will be on the right.

From Davidson, Cornelius, Huntersville: Take NC 73 East to US 29/Hwy. 601. Turn right, travel 2.2 miles, stay left and follow US 601 to NC 49 North. At traffic light, turn left onto NC 49 North. Travel 3.2 miles. Arena will be on the left.

From Monroe: Take US 601 North to NC 49 North. Travel 3.2 miles and Arena will be on the left. From Salisbury: Travel I-85 South & take Exit 60. Turn left on Dale Earnhardt/Copperfield Blvd. Follow to NC 3 (approx. 1.5 miles). Turn left at the traffic light and follow NC 3 to US 601 (approximately passing 6 traffic lights). Turn left at traffic light onto NC 49 North and follow NC 49 3.2 miles. Arena will be on the left. From Columbia, South Carolina: Take I-77 North to I-485 Inner Loop to Exit 33 (Hwy. 49 North - Harrisburg). Stay on Hwy. 49 North for approximately 13.5 miles. Arena will be on the left.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

RESERVE JUNIOR HANDLER: After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

- **Best Puppy** – any class limited to dogs six months and older and under 12 months of age; Puppy, 6-9 Puppy, 9-12 Puppy, and Bred-by-Exhibitor Puppy
- **Best Veteran** – any non-regular Veteran Class

Best Bred by Exhibitor in Show, The CDCA will offer this special competition. To qualify Exhibitors must declare their dog meets the requirement of the Bred By Exhibitor class (Chapter 3, Section 8 of Rules Applying to Dog Shows). Dogs must be breeder-owner handled. Eligible dogs will be identified by an indicator in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition by an eligible breeder owner. Best of Breed Bred By Exhibitor will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes that have indicated eligibility on the entry form by checking the BOB BBE box. All dogs in competition for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor, except International entries, must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club. No handler change will be permitted for the purpose of becoming eligible for the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor competition. NOTE: If the Winners Dog and/or Winners Bitch are not BBX Eligible, then the BBX Class Winner of that sex will compete.

NOTE: Best Veteran, Best Puppy or Best Bred By Exhibitor competition will be forgone if the Best of Breed is one of the above.

AWARDS OF MERIT: The CDCA will offer Awards of Merit in recognition of the quality of dogs/ bitches in the Best of Breed Competition. It is solely the Judge's decision whether or not to give all available Awards of Merit, only some, or none at all. Award of Merit recipients are selected from dogs and bitches in the Best of Breed Competition, other than the winner of Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Best of Winners winner, Select Dog winner, Select Bitch winner. The number of Awards of Merit that may be given is determined by the number of dogs eligible for Best of Breed (entries in Best of Breed plus any Non-Regular Class Winners eligible for Best of Breed - i.e. Veterans etc.)

4-9 Eligible - 1 Award of Merit, 10-14 Eligible - 2 Awards of Merit, 15-19 Eligible – 3 Awards of Merit, 20-24 Eligible - 4 Awards of Merit, 25 or more Eligible - 5 Awards of Merit.

- All participants must sign the farm waiver before the test starts; this includes spectators as well as exhibitors.
- Bring water and shade for yourself and your dog(s); all dogs must always be crated or on leash while on the property (exception: test pen).
- There will be a handler's briefing prior to the first run; please be sure to arrive with plenty of time to set up your area, potty your dog(s), and be at the briefing (it will not be repeated for latecomers).
- Bring a chair to watch the action but please be seated far enough away from the test pen to not disturb/distract the dog in the pen. Keep dogs on leash away from the outside pen fence (same reason).
- There will be breakfast items (pastries, coffee, tea) and lunch will be served after the test; bottled water will be available all day.
- Please clean up after your dogs, we don't want to be regarded as an irresponsible club or you as an irresponsible owner.
- There will be a Run Order whiteboard with the names of the dogs listed; it is subject to change so check it often!
