NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS



The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

The American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event:

- First entry of a dog in Conformation or Obedience, a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee, plus a \$3.50 Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog.
- First entry and each additional entry of a dog in Agility or Rally, a \$3.50 Service Fee.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries
 cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms
 without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no
 responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent.
 RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the
 amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a
 money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may
 result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Clubs is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- · FAX ENTRIES Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly.
 There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made.
 To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our
 exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during
 this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending
 party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external
 parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any
 specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- PUBLICATION RIGHTS By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

Because winners of the Veteran classes will compete for Best of Breed, all entrants must meet all American Kennel Club requirements for non-regular classes involving single dog entries.

Dogs/Bitches entered in Veterans need not be intact. Spayed and Neutered animals are eligible. Winners of the above Non-Regular Classes, if otherwise undefeated, compete for Best of Breed; therefore, all entrants must meet American Kennel Club requirements for non-regular classes involving single dog entries.

Note: Trimmed Havanese are allowed to enter all Non-Regular Classes except the Veterans classes at all HCA Specialties

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (Involving Multiple Dog Entries) - HCA (NATIONAL) ONLY

As the judge's decision in the following classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, the entries of these classes will not be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes will not be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes. Dogs may be spayed/neutered in Stud, Brood, Brace classes.

STUD DOG: Class for Stud dogs and no less than two and no more than four of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Entry only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the Standard for its breed. Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes or Best of Breed Competition, plus Stud Dog class as an "Additional Class".

BROOD BITCH: Same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE: The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog, which is part of a Brace, is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1". "Brace No. 2", etc.

A Dark Green Qualifying Ribbon will be given to each dog attaining a Qualifying Score.

Transfers will be allowed at this trial per AKC Regulations.

SPECIAL RECOGNITION

AWARDS OF MERIT: The Clubs offer an Award of Merit to deserving dogs/bitches for recognition of their quality. It is entirely at the judge's discretion whether to give any or all of the available awards. Awards of Merit are selected from the Best of Breed Competition, and may be awarded to any dog or bitch other than Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Winners, Select Dog and Select Bitch. The Havanese Club of America at the national will offer up to five Awards of Merit. Cascade Havanese Club and Oregon Trail Havanese Club will each offer up to three Awards of Merit.

BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR, BEST PUPPY, BEST VETERAN: Eligibility for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor Best Puppy, or Best Veteran competitions is predicated upon entry into the following class(es) and all divisions of:

- Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Bred-By-Exhibitor class including the Bred-By-Exhibitor Puppy or Bred-By-Exhibitor Adult age divisions
- Best Puppy any class limited to dogs six months and older and under 12 months of age; Puppy, 6-9 Puppy, 9-12 Puppy, and Bred-By-Exhibitor Puppy
- Best Veteran any non-regular Veteran Class

For Best Bred-By-Exhibitor, the eligibility criteria involving the individual handling the dog applies only to the original class entered and all competition specific to the special attraction. There are no restrictions as to who may handle the dog in any subsequent classes for which it may become eligible.

NOTE: Best Veteran, Best Puppy or Best Bred-By-Exhibitor competition will be forgone if the Best of Breed is one of the above.

AKC SANCTIONED 4-6 MONTHS PUPPY

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event.

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries. Exhibition-only entrants will participate in the same BPUP classes as regular entries. Judges will evaluate exhibition-only entrants in the same manner as regular entrants but will not consider them for awards. All Exhibition BPUP entries will receive an armband/catalog number starting with a capital "E."
- To be competitive, dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.
