### HOLIDAY INN PET POLICY

---

*It's not secret that we love our human guests, but you may not know we have a big soft spot for our pet guests as well. We want your pets to feel as comfortable as possible, but have some guidelines we need them to follow in order for everyone to have a great stay. As always, Red Lion welcomes service animals.*

**NON-REFUNDABLE FEE** – The hotel will assess a non-refundable fee of \$15 per stay, plus applicable taxes, which will be charged to the guests account upon check-in. Fee will be waived for service animals.

#### RULES & CONDITIONS FOR ALL PETS

1. The Pet(s) must pose no threat to guests or hotel associates.
2. The Pet(s) must be on a leash at all times when in public areas, hallways or the outside grounds of the hotel.
3. Pets are not permitted in dining areas, swimming pool areas, meeting/banquet rooms, fitness and business centers.
4. The Pet(s) may not be left unattended in guestrooms, on property, or in vehicles in the parking lot, even if they are kenneled. Owner must be present while any member of the hotel staff is serving the guestroom (housekeeping, engineering, in-room dining, etc.) when a pet is in the room. Pets must be restrained or removed from guestroom while hotel staff is present working in the room. Hotel staff will not enter any room that has an unrestrained pet.
5. Daily housekeeping will be suspended if pets are discovered left unattended in a guestroom.
6. All pets must be registered at the front desk as they are allowed in designated rooms only. This is for servicing your room and for the safety of our team members.
7. Additional cleaning charges may apply and will be billed to your credit card if we find any of the following issues with your room:
  - An animal is found in an undesignated room
  - Soiled or torn carpet and/or bed linens
  - Scratches on furniture, walls or doors
  - Excessive pet odor
  - Animal hair on bed or furniture (we ask that you not allow your pets onto the beds or furniture)
8. Pets must be in good health and up to date on all relevant vaccinations (including rabies), house-trained, clean and free of any parasites such as ticks or fleas.
9. Any damage caused by pets must be reported to management immediately so proper action can be taken to avoid inconvenience to other guests. The owner is liable for any damage or injury caused by pets.
10. The owner of the pet(s) is liable for health, safety, and welfare of pets staying on property.
11. Noise/Disruptive complaints – Barking and noise that is disruptive to other guests in the hotel is not acceptable. Upon receipt of two (2) noise complaints, the guest may be asked to make alternative arrangements for their pet.
12. In accordance with local pet laws, please ensure that you pick up after your pet at all times. We can supply you with pet waste bags at the front desk if needed. All litter is to be disposed of properly by guests. Additionally, pets must be walked only in an area designated by the hotel (please ask a front desk agent for the best locations).
13. Please do not give your pet a bath in the bathtub. If your pet is dirty, please contact the front desk for local grooming services.

#### **BEST VETERAN DOG & BEST VETERAN BITCH** (*OFFERED AT NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY*)

**AWARD OF MERIT** – The judge may, at their discretion, choose up to five (5) entrants that show exceptional quality deserving of an Award of Merit, excluding Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Winners Dog and Winners Bitch based on the number of entries in the BOB Class as follows:

- Up to 1 AOM if 8 to 12 dogs shown • Up to 2 AOM if 13 to 17 dogs shown
- Up to 3 AOM if 18 to 22 dogs shown • Up to 4 AOM if 23 to 27 dogs shown
- Up to 5 AOM if 28 or more dogs shown

**BEST PUPPY** – Best Puppy will be selected from the Puppy Classes following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Puppy Class are eligible to compete.

**BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR** – Best Bred-by-Exhibitor will be selected from the Bred-by-Exhibitor Dog & Bitch Classes following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Bred-by-Exhibitor Class are eligible to compete.

**BEST VETERAN** – Best Veteran will be selected from the regular Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in Veteran Class are eligible to compete.

*At the National Specialty only, a Best Veteran Dog and Best Veteran Bitch will also be selected.*

### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES**

*Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.*

**Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class** (*offered at National Specialty only*): Each entry is shown with not less than two nor more than four of their get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

**Brace Class:** Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be

entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

**Team Class** (*offered at National Specialty only*): Four Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. Dogs competing in the team class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Team Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Team is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Team Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Team must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Team Class."

**POINTS FOR RESERVE WINNERS DOG & BITCH**

NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY: Scottish Deerhound Club of America as provided by the American Kennel Club will designate the Reserve Winners Dog and the Reserve Winners Bitch to be awarded a three (3) point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winners sex totals at least twice the number required for a five (5) point major, in the region in which this event is held. No Major for Reserve Winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners. In counting the number of dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge or from which all awards are withheld, shall not be included..

SDCA STANDING RULE FOR SWEEPSTAKES & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES: The handler of an exhibit in the Scottish Deerhound Club of America Futurity or Sweepstakes at the National Specialty shall not be a professional handler or handler's assistant, household member or employee. A professional handler is any person who has been a member of a professional handlers association; listed as a professional handler by the American Kennel Club; has represented themselves as a professional handler; advertised as such, or received compensation for handling dogs at any specialty, group or all breed show within two years of the date of the specialty in which the exhibit is entered. Notwithstanding this prohibition, professional handlers may exhibit, at the national specialty, their own dog(s) of which they are an owner, co-owner, breeder or co-breeder.

**NOVICE CLASS:** This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**OPEN CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

**MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. ## **ALL AROUND HOUND CRITERIA** (OFFERED AT NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY)

The All Around Hound award was developed to recognize the Deerhound which excels in all three areas of competition at the national specialty: conformation, running events and training events. It takes a special dog and a dedicated owner to even compete for this award. Dogs and handlers that excel in all three areas deserve real recognition and we applaud all those competing.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Dogs must enter at least one event in each of the following categories:

- Conformation: regular classes, field trial classes, veteran classes
- Running Events: ASFA field trial, AKC field trial, LGRA meet
- Training Events: Obedience Trial, Rally Trial

### **RULES**

- Professional handlers may not be used unless they are a co-owner of the dog.
- One (1) point will be given for each event (not class) participated in; regardless of performance (qualifying score not needed).
- Qualifying scores are required in obedience, rally, the ASFA field trial and the AKC field trial in order to receive placement points.
- Only the highest scored class in each event will be used for ranking purposes.
- Additional points, as indicated under scoring, will be awarded for every qualifying score earned.
- A dog with a title or legs towards a rally or obedience title may not utilize a score from a lower class for the AAH competition (i.e. if a dog has a CD or legs towards a CD it may not utilize a score from Beginner Novice.) (Exception: when entering both Open/Utility or Advanced/Excellent the higher qualifying score will be utilized for ranking purposes.) (Exception: dogs competing in Veteran classes in all other categories can declare, prior to start of trial, Veteran Obedience as the counted class.)

### **SCORING**

#### **Running Events:**

ASFA Field Trial and AKC Field Trial:

- All dogs competing in the event (excluding Singles Stake) will be ranked by their total score from preliminary and final runs (run-offs not to count), regardless of stake. If a participating AAH dog ranks in the top 5 scores, points will be awarded as follows: highest score is 5 points then 4-3-2-1. BOB in each trial will receive an additional 10 points.
- If more than 5 dogs compete in the trial then placements in each class will receive 5-4-3-2-1 (if 6 competing in the class). Points for class placements will reduce accordingly for lower entries. No placement points awarded unless another hound ranks lower.
- Singles Stake points will be awarded as follows: first = 3pts, second = 2.5 points, third = 2 points, fourth = 1.5 points, NBQ/fifth = 1 point. When there are less than 5 dogs the points will be decreased accordingly (4 dogs is 2.5, 2, 1.5, 1; 3 dogs is 2, 1.5, 1 etc).
- Tied scores: points for tied places will be added together and then divided by amount of dogs tied and all involved will receive that final score.
- All dogs receiving a qualifying score will receive 1 additional point for qualifying.

LGRA: Points will be awarded as follows: first = 5 points, second = 4 points, third = 3 points, fourth = 2 points, fifth = 1 point.

**Training Events:** includes Obedience and Rally

- All dogs competing in the event will be ranked by their score. If a participating AAH dog ranks in the top 5 scores, points will be awarded as follows: highest score is 5 points then 4-3-2-1. Additional points for ranked dogs will be added for the competition level competed in as follows: Utility/Excellent 3 points, Open/Advanced 2 points, Novice/Veteran 1 point, Beginner Novice .5 point. No additional points for HIT.
- Additional qualifying points will be awarded for each qualifying score as follows: Utility 7 points, Open 5 points, Novice 3 points, Beginner Novice 1 point, Excellent 3 points, Advanced 2 points, Novice 1 point.

### **Conformation**

- Points from BOB cuts are cumulative but will only be awarded to dogs not receiving BOB/BOS/Select/AOM.
- There must be a minimum of 2 dogs in a class for any points to be awarded. The 1st place dog in that case will receive 1 point.

## AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

---

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Professional handlers,\* household members and current assistants to professional handlers\*\* may not exhibit. Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners competition.

*\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years*

*\*\*A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The American Kennel Club will collect: a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee where applicable for the first entry of a dog, plus a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 is required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 is required for each additional entry of the same dog.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Clubs is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. FAX NUMBER: 360-755-2248. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). - Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify BaRay Events at 360-755-7086 or email [dogshows@barayevents.com](mailto:dogshows@barayevents.com).
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. - Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 11, Section 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
