Selects, if applicable, will be chosen following Best of Breed.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

Remember, all complaints regarding conduct prejudicial to the sport will be dealt with in accordance with AKC rules, by the Show Committee. This includes dogs relieving themselves on the shrubbery outside the show buildings.

SMOKING will not be permitted inside show buildings - state law, or around show rings. This will be enforced.

The Show Site & RV parking will be available to exhibitors after 2:00PM Tuesday. On Wednesday, parking will be available after 10:00AM. Dogs must be removed from the show site 1 1/2 hours after BIS on Sunday.

1. Damages caused by vehicles will be the responsibility of those persons bringing vehicles on to the show site.
2. Please be sure that all dogs have current DHL, RABIES & PARVO VACCINATIONS!
3. EXHIBITORS & AGENTS must be governed by any rules & regulations of the Cache County Fairgrounds and/or local restrictions.
4. EXHIBITORS & AGENTS will be held responsible for damages and for keeping the premises clean around their crates and set-ups & grooming spaces.
5. EXHIBITORS & AGENTS must keep dogs under control and restrained at all times.
6. EXHIBITORS & AGENTS are advised to bring adequate shade for the comfort of their dogs and themselves.
7. NO CRATES within 25 feet of the show rings (outdoors) except during breed judging & must be removed immediately following that breed. No set-ups between RV/Parking & rings & concessions & rings. Day parking exhibitors' ex-pens will be allowed in designated area only. Ex-pens for overnight parking will be in parking only. NO GROOMING ALLOWED IN BUILDING OR SHOWER FACILITY.
8. RESTROOMS will be available for the convenience of exhibitors/spectators. Any exhibitor found bathing or grooming a dog in the public restrooms WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO EXHIBIT AND WILL BE SUBJECT TO ACTION BY THE EVENT COMMITTEE.
9. Shower facilities available for paid reserved overnight parking exhibitors only. NO DOGS ALLOWED IN SHOWER BUILDING.
10. NO OVERNIGHT PARKING allowed except in reserved parking areas (see Parking information on page 14).
11. Mount Ogden Kennel Club, Inc. and Cache County Fairgrounds assume NO LIABILITY for loss or damage to equipment, property and/or exhibitors and agents.
12. No roller blades or skateboards allowed on show grounds.
13. Bring mats or other appropriate ground cover for grooming building.
14. Utah State Law prohibits smoking in public areas. **"NO SMOKING"**
15. Speed limit of 5mph for the safety of exhibitors and public.

PEE WEE CLASS SPECIAL ATTRACTION

SATURDAY AT NOON - AGES 5-9 - ENTRY FEE: \$5.00

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class that is geared toward children 5-9 years of age. Safety is a primary concern.

JUDGE: GAYLE M DENMAN

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

REGISTRATION WILL BE TAKEN AT THE CLUB TABLE ENTRIES WILL BE TAKEN UP UNTIL AN HOUR BEFORE THE EVENT. EACH ENTRANT WILL BE REQUIRED TO FILL OUT AN ENTRY FORM. IN ADDITION TO AN ENTRY, A RELEASE MUST BE SIGNED BY THE CHILD'S PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN. SEE JUDGING SCHEDULE FOR TIME.

PeeWee Entries are open to All Breeds, including Miscellaneous and FSS Breeds, and All-American Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

RESERVE JUNIOR HANDLER: After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

JUNIOR "BEST OF THE BEST"

Junior Handling competition "The Best of the Best"

restricted to the winners of all specialties and MOKC Junior Handling competition from May 15, 2024 thru May 19, 2024. This competition will be held on Sunday at lunchtime. The winner will be awarded a \$500 scholarship offered by Mount Ogden Kennel Club, to be used at the school of their choice when they enter either a college, trade school, or specialty school. Each will be given a ticket to verify their entrance into the competition. If the junior does not use this scholarship within 5 years of graduation from high school or equivalent education, then the money reverts back to the account of mount Ogden Kennel Club

MOUNT OGDEN KENNEL CLUB, INC.

AKC SANCTIONED 4-6 MONTHS PUPPY

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

The Club may limit the Beginner Puppy judge to 20. If this occurs, an additional judge will be named on the Judging Program.

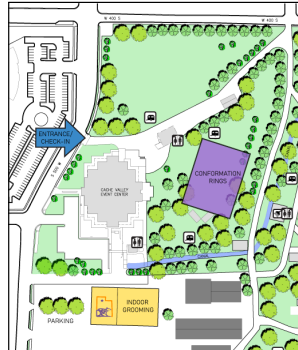

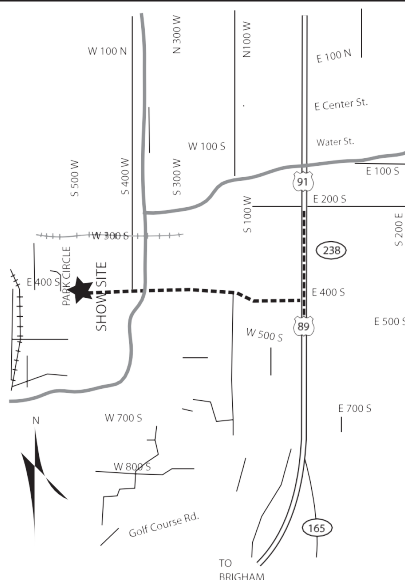

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION - NON-SPORTING BREEDS ONLY

NOVICE CLASS: This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION - The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Selects, if applicable, will be chosen following Best of Breed.

Non-Regular Class Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Brace Class: Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Both dogs do not need to be entered in any other class, however, one of the dogs must be entered in a regular class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION - SHOW 2

NOVICE CLASS: This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.
