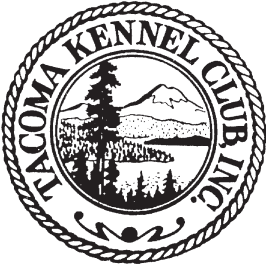

ALL ENTRANTS TO THE TACOMA DOME FOR ANY AND ALL OF THE TACOMA KENNEL CLUB, INC., AND ASSOCIATED EVENTS HELD FROM APRIL 24 & 25, 2021 (HEREINAFTER "THE EVENT") MUST COMPLETE AND SIGN THIS COVID-19 EVENT WAIVER ("WAIVER") BEFORE ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT IS PERMITTED. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.

THIS IS FOR EXHIBITORS, OWNERS, HANDLERS, BREEDERS, ASSISTANTS, FAMILY MEMBERS, JUDGES, FRIENDS, VOLUNTEERS, MINOR CHILDREN, COMMITTEE MEMBERS AND ANYONE ELSE WHO ENTERS THE TACOMA DOME DURING THE EVENT.

IF YOU ARE ON THE TACOMA DOME SITE THIS FORM MUST BE ON FILE.

My signature below confirms that I voluntarily attest, to the best of my knowledge, that at the time of signing this Waiver, I: (1) do not have COVID-19; and (2) have not been in contact with or exposed to any known carrier of COVID-19 within the past 14 days. I further attest that I am not currently displaying or feeling symptoms of COVID-19 (including, but not limited to, coughing, sneezing, elevated temperature, or any other symptom(s) that the United States Center for Disease Control has attributed to COVID-19).

**COVID-19 EVENT
WAIVER EXHIBIT "A"**

The following plan will be enforced throughout all time relevant to the Tacoma Kennel Club, Inc., all-breed dog shows and the associated events (collectively referred to as "The Event"). This plan is subject to change as necessary.

1. IF YOU ARE ILL, COUGHING, SNEEZING, RUNNING A TEMPERATURE OR FEEL UNWELL, please stay home because any Spectator, Exhibitor or Attendee with these conditions will not be admitted to The Event.
2. EXPOSURE TO COVID-19: If you have recently tested positive for COVID-19, or if you have recently been in the presence of a person who has either tested positive for COVID-19 or has the symptoms of COVID-19 (including, but not limited to, coughing, sneezing, or high temperature), please stay home because any such by Spectator, Exhibitor or Attendee will not be admitted to The Event. If proof of a positive COVID-19 test dated from The Event closing dates through April 25, 2021, is submitted, you will be eligible for a partial refund of entry fees.
3. WRISTBANDS AND ADMISSION INTO THE EVENT: The following procedures will be in place throughout The Event:
 - a. Wrist Bands or Stickers: All Spectators, Exhibitors, and Attendees will be given a wrist band or sticker to indicate The Clubs have a signed Waiver on file. If you lose your wrist band/sticker or it falls off, please go to the COVID-19 Monitor for another wrist band or sticker; it will be confirmed that a signed Waiver is on file before another wrist band or sticker will be issued. Please note you MUST have a wrist band or sticker to pick up any armbands; and
 - b. Failure to comply with these procedures will result in a bench hearing.
4. ATTENDANCE: All Exhibitors and Attendees must adhere to the Social Distancing Guidelines provided in Paragraph 5 below. This includes, but is not limited to, placing chairs six (6) feet apart or creating small "family units." Please understand that Exhibitors and Attendees may be asked to move, spread out, or wait outside the building, so that state, county, and/or local social distancing requirements may be maintained.
5. SOCIAL DISTANCING: All Exhibitors and Attendees must maintain social distancing of the recommended six (6) feet from others in attendance at The Event. Please be cognizant that other Exhibitors and Attendees may have medical issues or concerns of which you are unaware. Those in attendance at The Event will undoubtedly have different levels of concern and fear, and thus The Clubs are requiring that each individual in attendance at The Event to be respectful of others.
6. MASKS: PER AKC AND THE CLUBS, EVERYONE IN ATTENDANCE AT THIS EVENT WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR A MASK AT ALL TIMES THAT ADEQUATELY COVERS BOTH THE NOSE AND MOUTH. YOU ARE REQUIRED TO SUPPLY YOUR OWN MASK(S). THERE WILL NOT BE ANY EXCEPTIONS.
7. DESIGNATED COVID-19 MONITORS: The Clubs will have assigned throughout the duration of The Event "COVID-19 Monitors", including before and after The Event for set up and break down, who will be responsible for the following:
 - a. Ensuring that all Exhibitors and Attendees are in compliance with the mask-wearing requirement set forth in Paragraph 6 above;

- b. Ensuring that all Exhibitors and Attendees are wearing a wrist band or sticker as provided to them to indicate that The Clubs have a signed Waiver on file for that individual; and
- c. Providing the COVID-19 Event Waiver to those who need to execute it prior to entry into The Event facilities.
8. **SANITIZING STATIONS:** Sanitizing stations will be placed throughout The Event facilities which will include disinfecting wipes and/or hand sanitizer.
9. **CRATING:** Dogs may only be crated ringside 15 minutes prior to, and during judging, and dogs shall not be permitted to be crated anywhere else on The Event or facility premises, with the exception of automobiles or under personal canopies set-up six (6) feet apart or in small “family units” outside in Parking Lots A & C. Ringside crates must have the recommended spacing of six (6) feet between them. No blow dryers will be permitted ringside or anywhere else inside a building throughout The Event facilities.
10. **ARM BANDS:** You must know your arm band number and have a wrist band or sticker before picking up your arm band. A table will be provided, and the arm bands laid out in advance of each class. Remember to maintain social distancing guidelines while you are obtaining your arm bands.
11. **ENTRANCE AND EXIT FROM THE EVENT FACILITIES:**
- a. On the first day of the Exhibitor’s and Attendee’s attendance at The Event, it must be confirmed that all Exhibitors and Attendees to The Event have signed the “COVID-19 Event Waiver.” Entry will be denied to anyone refusing to sign the Waiver.
- b. Once it has been confirmed that The Clubs have a signed waiver for the Exhibitor and/or Attendee, the Exhibitor and/or Attendee will be issued a wristband/sticker to wear for the duration of the event. If that wristband/sticker is lost or if it comes off, please return to the COVID-19 monitor to obtain another wristband.
12. **HAND WASHING:** As always, washing your hands frequently and thoroughly and not touching your face decrease the spread of germs. Continual hand washing throughout the day by Exhibitors and/or Attendees is encouraged. The restroom area will provide a wash station, hand sanitizer and paper towels for drying your hands. The Clubs also suggest that Exhibitors and/or Attendees keep a supply of sanitizing wipes and an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with them and use those items as necessary.
13. **RING ENTRY/EXIT:** The ring will have a separate entrance and exit, clearly marked. Markings will be placed to assist exhibitors with proper distancing while in the ring.

Professional handlers or agents are only permitted to exhibit in FSS Open Shows if they are listed as an owner of record of the dog being exhibited. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.*

Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Tacoma Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. The Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against either organization or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on event grounds. No retractable leads or prong collars.

The Club reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value if necessary.

The Best in Show winners from all four events will be invited to compete for “Best of the Best.” Judging will take place on Sunday before the start of the regular groups in the group ring.

This will be judged by a panel of 3 judges that have not judged the Open Show entries at these shows.

a Grooming Tote, stuffed with doggy items, and a Rosette.

SHOW INFORMATION

- Doors will open at 6:30AM Saturday and Sunday. Entrance available on the South Side on East “D” Street (Main Entrance).
- Each exhibitor will receive an acknowledgement of entry. See page 4.
- No exercise pens will be permitted.
- All dogs shall be kept on leash except when in the obedience or rally ring.
- There shall be no drilling nor intensive corrective training of dogs on the grounds or premises.
- STOOP TO SCOOP. The City of Tacoma has a “Poop Scoop” Law – \$500 FINE for anyone seen leaving their dog’s excrement on city property. Designated exercise areas will be clearly marked.
- No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these shows.

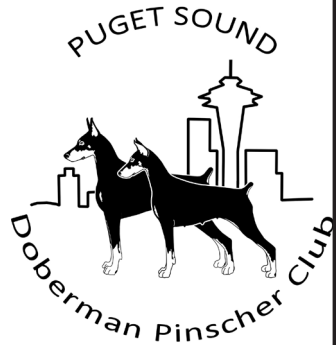

FAX ENTRIES: Fax number: 360-755-2248. \$4.00 per dog per show added for FAX-Credit Card entries. Both sides of entry form must be transmitted. Entries must be accompanied by a cover sheet stating the number of pages, what shows and how many dogs per show. Visa, MasterCard, and American Express are accepted for Fax entries. Credit card information (Credit Card number, expiration date, and cardholder name) must be on cover sheet. Note: Visa and MasterCard users – You must include the 3-digit security code that appears above your signature on the back of the card. Proof of fax transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I **(WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

Kennel Club®**

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The American Kennel Club will collect: a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee where applicable for the first entry of a dog, plus a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 is required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 is required for each additional entry of the same dog.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. Baray Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Club may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Club may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. FAX NUMBER: 360-755-2248. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). - Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify Baray Events at 360-755-7086 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 11, Section 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
