- **THE SHOWS WILL BE CLOSED TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.**
- Masks are required and masks must cover your mouth and nose at all times unless stated below. **If you do NOT follow this rule, you will be asked to leave and receive no refund.** Judges will have authority to ask exhibitors to leave if they feel rules are not being followed.
- Please keep aisles as clear as possible and no socializing at ring areas. No public chairs provided.
- Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact.
- Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
- Avoid common use pens/pencils – bring your own writing instruments.
- Exhibitors must provide their own means for cleaning up from their dogs in public Ex-Pens & the entire facility. There will be NO public scoops.
- Prepare to be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, bring personal use masks, shade for your dog/s. There will be hand sanitizing stations and we will have extra masks in case someone needs one.
- Do not crowd the Superintendent’s table. Wait 6’ behind the person in front of you.
- **IF YOU ARE EXHIBITING SYMPTONS OF COVID-19, RUNNING A FEVER, COUGHING, SNEEZING, HAVE LOSS OF SENSE OF SMELL OR TASTE, ACUTE RESPIRATORY ILLNESS CONSISTENT WITH COVID-19, PLEASE STAY HOME.**

**• NOTE •**

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination. Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used. Additional information regarding these regulations may be obtained from the Wisconsin State Veterinarian at 608-224-4888.

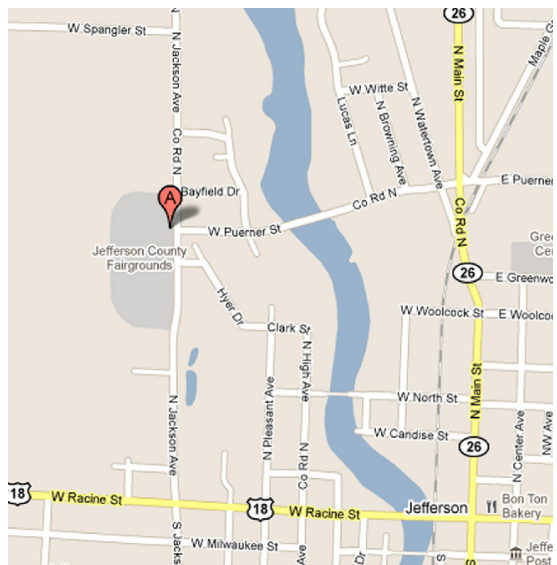
The New Highway 26 Bypass is open around Jefferson.

### BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

SELECT DOG • SELECT BITCH • AWARD OF MERIT • BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR • BEST VETERAN

**JUDGE'S AWARD OF MERIT (JAM):** At the Judge's discretion, Judge's Award of Merit will be given to those dogs which the judge determines to be meritorious. The judge will make the award at his/her discretion, to a maximum of 20% (round up) from the Best of Breed Competition. Excluded from JAM Awards are Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed. JAM winners will receive a Burgundy 3-streamer Rosette.

**BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR:** During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-By-Exhibitor from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class winners in each event. This will be done after the Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Bred-By-Exhibitor class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Bred-By-Exhibitor Class are eligible for the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

**BEST VETERAN:** During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran in Breed from the Non-Regular Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch Classes. This will be done after Best of Breed & Award of Merit judging unless the Best Veteran award is automatic. Example: A Veteran Class winner is awarded Best of Breed. Only dogs not defeated in regular Veteran classes are eligible to compete for Best Veteran.

**No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.**

### ATTENTION OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1. ## **FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION BOTH DAYS**

The Four-To-Six Month Beginner Puppy Competition shall be for Labrador Retrievers that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition. AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

- A Foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy Competition.
- Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination. If the judge finds it necessary to open the mouth they should disinfect their hands prior to examining other dogs.
- Male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused but the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of Merit points must be withheld.
- Dogs with breed standard disqualifications should not be excused but may not receive placements. However, dogs with age-related disqualifications such as color (as related to age), height, teeth etc. are permitted to receive awards in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy classes.
- Dogs must be excused for attacking a person or other dogs.
- No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.
- Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.
