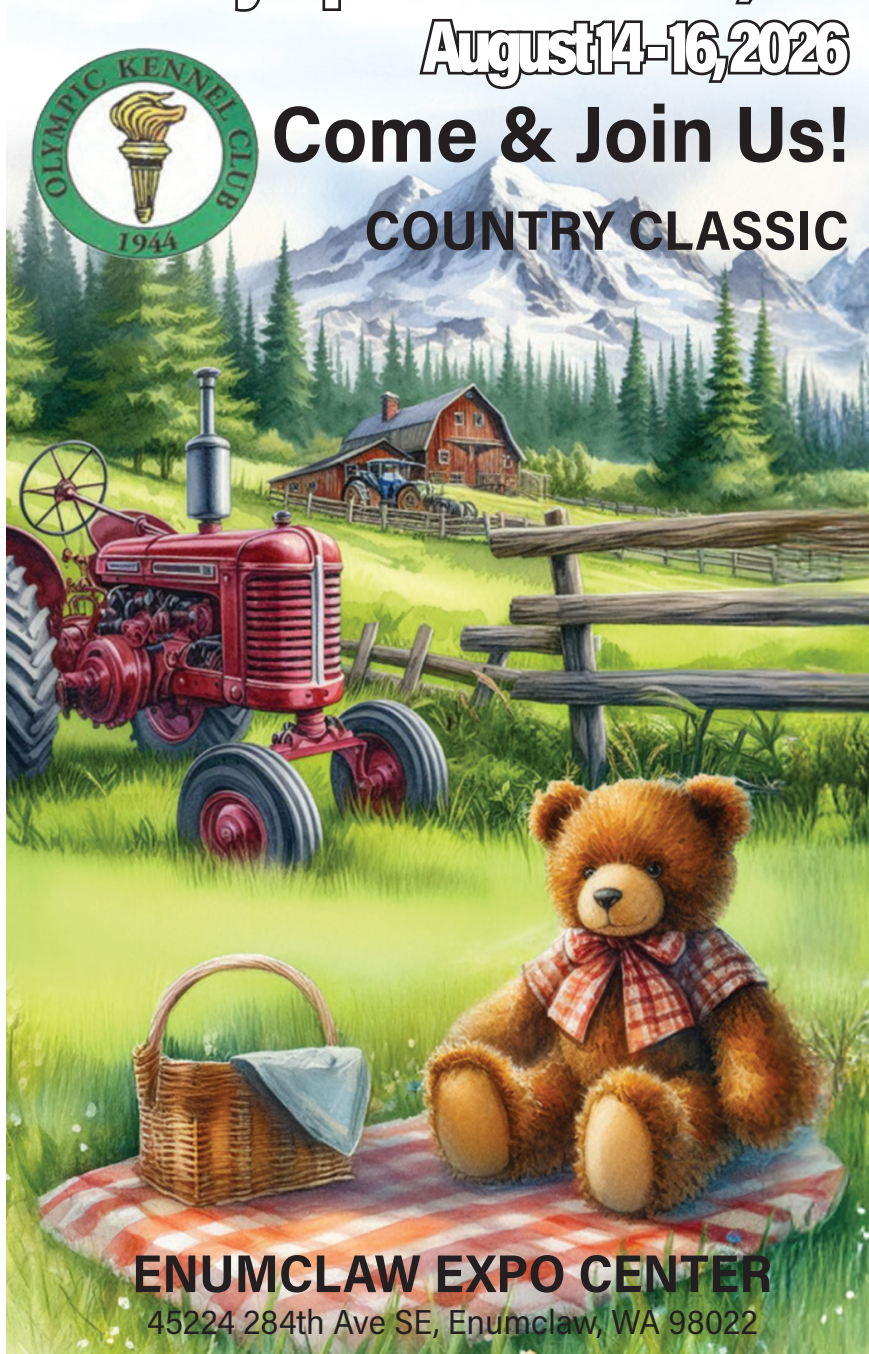

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List. The

American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event: An AKC Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions.)

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- PUBLICATION RIGHTS – By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors on Tuesday, 2:00PM to 10:00PM. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday.

LOADING & UNLOADING - Loading and Unloading is located behind reserved grooming at the Livestock Building and the Horse Barn. ALL VEHICLES MUST BE REMOVED OR WILL BE TOWED, NO EXCEPTIONS. THIS IS A FIRE LANE.

POWER OUTLETS - Use of ALL power outlets is at user's own risk.

No practicing allowed in rings at any time.

No dogs to be left overnight in Reserved or Non-Reserved grooming buildings.

Free day grooming is available on a first come, first served basis & is located in the farthest south row of the Horse Barn. There is no power in Free Grooming. All equipment must be removed at the end of each day.

Reserved grooming is available in the Livestock Building and the Horse Barn. Follow the link and instructions in the RESERVED GROOMING RESERVATIONS section on page 8.

Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning up after his own dog(s). Poop bags will be placed around the show grounds for your convenience. If your dog soils in the show ring, the ring steward will hold your dog while YOU do the clean up. Poop bags will be placed outside each ring. Responsible dog owners will clean up after their dog(s).

All dogs in stand-alone ex-pens MUST have someone in attendance with them at all times.

PARENTS SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES!

SKATEBOARDS, ROLLERBLADES, SCOOTERS OR BIKES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS, AND THIS INCLUDES THE SHOW RINGS. ONCE SHOW HOURS ARE OVER, THESE WHEELED DEVICES ARE LIMITED TO THE PAVED AREAS ONLY AND SUBJECT TO LOCAL COUNTY RULES.

NO UNAUTHORIZED USE OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES ON SHOW GROUNDS DURING SHOW HOURS.

NO PERSONAL GOLF CARTS ALLOWED INSIDE SHOW LIMITS.

DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS WILL BE PROVIDED FOR THESE CARTS OUTSIDE SHOW LIMITS, AND TRANSPORTATION TO A RING PROVIDED BY OKC HOSPITALITY IF NEEDED.

Grooming and exercise pens in DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. Crates may be brought to ringside during breed judging and must be removed immediately when judging for that breed is over.

NO GROOMING OR SMOKING UNDER SHADE TENTS IN AISLES. ALL CRATES MUST BE REMOVED FROM RINGSIDE AND FROM UNDER SHADE TENTS IMMEDIATELY AFTER SHOWING.

NO SMOKING WITHIN 25FT OF ENTRANCES.

PARKING INFORMATION

Non-Compliance may result in a Bench Hearing.

GENERAL INFORMATION

All parking is a privilege extended by Olympic Kennel Club and the Enumclaw Expo Center. Any arguing, abusive language or failure to follow the rules, regulations or instructions of the club or parking personnel will cause you to be escorted from the show site, forfeit all parking privileges without refund of fees and subject to possible discipline by the Event Committee.

All parking is at user's own risk. Olympic Kennel Club and Enumclaw Expo Center assume no responsibility or liability for damages or loss to any vehicle or its cargo.

Day Pay Parking is available at the North and South Lots

- Everyone using this facility is expected to keep and leave the area clean.
- Limited handicap parking (with a valid permit) is available in the general parking areas. These spaces will have easy access but may be some distance from the show rings.
- All vehicles must vacate the premises no later than one hour following Best In Show Sunday.
- No vending in parking areas without a permit.
- All parking fees must be paid in US funds.
- **FIRE LANES MUST BE KEPT CLEAR AT ALL TIMES.** Vehicles subject to towing at owner's expense with no prior notification.

LOADING & UNLOADING

- Reserved grooming is in the Livestock Building and Horse Barn, located at the northeast corner of the grounds. Free day grooming is in the furthest south row of the Horse Barn. Vehicle access to both buildings will be off 284th Avenue SE - follow signs.
- Unloading will begin at 2:00PM Tuesday. All loading and unloading will be supervised and a time limit per vehicle will be observed to give as many exhibitors as possible access to the grooming buildings. REMINDER - All vehicles must be removed after Load/Unload, this is a Fire lane and vehicles will be towed.
- **USE OF ALL POWER OUTLETS IS AT USER'S OWN RISK. ELECTRICITY IS LIMITED AND NOT GUARANTEED**
- **NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT OVERNIGHT IN THE GROOMING BUILDINGS.**

GENERAL PARKING

- General parking is available daily in North and South parking lots beginning at 6:00AM. The parking fee is \$7.00 per day. Pay at Gate.
- No exercise pens, set-ups or overnight parking in general parking areas.
- Vehicles illegally parked may be towed at owner's expense with no prior notification.

OVERNIGHT RESERVED PARKING

ALL ARRIVALS AND STAGING WILL BE AT NORTH LOT. FOLLOW THE SIGNS.

DO NOT ENTER AT OTHER ENTRANCES UNTIL DIRECTED UPON YOUR ARRIVAL AT THE

NORTH LOT! RV parking will begin at 2:00 PM on Tuesday, unless prior authorization by

RV Chair has been given. Gates will be closed at 10:00 PM.

- Mailed Reservations must be received on or before July 29, 2026.
- There will be an additional \$10.00 charge at the gate for those without a reservation - CASH ONLY.
- **NO LATE ARRIVALS WILL BE PARKED AFTER 9:00PM WITHOUT PRE-APPROVAL BY THE RV PARKING CHAIR. ALL OTHER GATES WILL CLOSE AT 8:00PM.**
- Inaccurate vehicle size may result in reassignment of space.
- All vehicles must park as directed by the parking personnel.
- If you wish to park near someone, reservations must be mailed in the same envelope, or reserved and paid at the same time online.
- All overnight parking units must be self-contained. No dumping of gray water or sewage.
- All overnight parking units must have a working fire extinguisher and generator exhaust piping.
- Only ONE vehicle PER space unless extra parking is purchased.
- A maximum of 2 extra vehicles are allowed per space and vehicles MUST fit within assigned reserved space. A vehicle towed behind your RV is considered an extra vehicle and subject to a separate \$30 fee. Any extra vehicle parked in an assigned space is required to also pay an additional \$30.)
- **USE OF POWER OUTLETS IS AT USER'S OWN RISK - ALL AIR CONDITIONING UNITS MUST BE RAN OFF A GENERATOR. POWER IS NOT GUARANTEED AT ANY SITE. Do Not Attempt to Run AC units on the 15AMP service.**
- Generators are allowed between the hours of 6:00AM and 10:00PM ONLY with an exhaust venting system.

The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Selects, if applicable, will be chosen following Best of Breed.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

FOR ALL BREEDS - BRACE CLASS: Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

BEST OF THE BEST JUNIOR HANDLER

The Olympic Kennel Club 2026 presents the prestigious "Best of the Best Junior Handler" award, offering a unique opportunity for all junior handlers who have been recognized as "Best Junior" in individual group shows, specialty shows, and each of the OKC "All Breed" shows held in August. The purpose of this award is to showcase and honor the top junior handlers in competition in connection with the August OKC Show.

The Judging for this event is scheduled for noon on the final day of the OKC show. A special certificate presentation will award the "Best of the Best Junior" with \$1,000 and the "Reserve Best of the Best Junior" with \$500, to be used towards travel expenses for prestigious events such as Westminster, AKC National, and Crufts, or other related dog show activities. This presentation will take place in the Group Ring immediately preceding the commencement of the seven groups.

One to two judges will be selected to judge this event. These judge(s) will evaluate each junior's performance based on the following criteria:

- appropriate skills when handling and presenting their dog for that particular breed;
- ability to follow instructions;
- attentiveness to their dog when working; and
- good sportsmanship.

In the event of a conflict of interest between a junior handler and a judge, the junior handler should still participate to be acknowledged for their win. During their turn for examination, the judge and junior handler should shake hands, after which the junior handler will be excused due to the conflict of interest. All best junior handlers from each category are eligible for this award.

Ramps can be used to judge any breed in an emergency situation where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list; an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. 4-6 BEGINNER PUPPY

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries. Exhibition-only entrants will participate in the same BPUP classes as regular entries. Judges will evaluate exhibition-only entrants in the same manner as regular entrants but will not consider them for awards. All Exhibition BPUP entries will receive an armband/catalog number starting with a capital "E"
- To be competitive, dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.
