NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

The American Kennel Club will collect: a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee where applicable for the first entry of a dog, plus a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 is required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 is required for each additional entry of the same dog.

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.**
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE.** BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- **REFUNDS** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent **AFTER THE SHOW.** An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Clubs is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- **FAX ENTRIES** - Fax entries are not accepted.
- Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify BaRay Events at 360-755-7086 or email dogshowsb@barayevents.com.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES** or **OVERPAYMENTS**. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show **NO REFUND** will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 11, Section 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- **LOSS OR DAMAGE** - The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- **PUBLICATION RIGHTS** - By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

ENTRIES TAKEN DAY OF EVENT - ENTRY FEE: \$30

There are 193 AKC recognized breeds. One of the things that makes a specific breed unique is not only the dog's physical appearance, but each breed also has its own distinctive temperament.

The AKC Temperament Test (ATT) was developed to bring focus & provide a meaningful evaluation to assess the temperament of our canine companions.

The ATT tests how a dog reacts to a variety of stimuli. Desirable traits are that the dog will be emotionally stable, inquisitive, cooperative, appropriately social for its breed, biddable & demonstrates the ability to recover from a startling situation in a reasonable amount of time.

Undesirable traits are fear, shyness, lack of cooperation & an inability to recover from unfamiliar or unexpected situations. Examples of undesirable behaviors include being afraid of friendly strangers or unfamiliar stimuli, obsessive barking, & aggression.

In the ATT, dogs are tested in 6 categories of stimuli that include:

1. Social
2. Auditory
3. Visual
4. Tactile
5. Proprioceptive (motion)
6. Unexpected stimulus

The Farm Dog Certified test provides for a series of twelve exercises that represent situations a farm dog would encounter in a typical farm environment. The basic test requirements are designed to emphasize a dog's ability of self-control, confidence & trust necessary to succeed in any canine/human partnership. These traits & foundational training are vital to a working farm dog.

Two judges will be testing each day. A passing score under two judges earns a Farm Dog Certification title.

The FDC program provides an opportunity for all dogs to apply their basic training in a novel environment, demonstrating their natural capability & trainability to work in partnership with their human companions. The Farm Dog Certified test is open to all dogs.

Each hour long session is limited to 5-6 teams**

The training clinic is open to all dogs and will be taught from the novice handler's perspective. A short briefing regarding the structure and rules of the sport is followed by intro to quarry, which has teams working with the instructor in a round robin format and introduces the dogs to live caged rats in a safe and controlled environment. Intro to tubes transitions the dogs from the sight & smell of the rat, to relying on their "inner ratter" to locate rats in protective tubes. Rat care and safety is paramount in the sport, nor rats are harmed during any barn hunt event. Practice runs on regulation courses are not part of this introductory session.

The indoor clinic area will be fenced, but may not be impassible to determined dogs, all dogs will be on leash during their session. Bitches in heat can participate in the Sunday clinic and will be segregated from the other dogs.

Clinic times will be assigned after the Judging Programs for the other activities are posted, those with pre-entries will get first dibs on times. Tentative clinic hours are Saturday & Sunday 9:00 am till 4:00 PM, . Day of show entries accepted as space allows.

You do not have to be registered with BHA LLC to participate.

The Event Center does not have a campground. We offer designated spots as a convenience to show participants and exhibitors. These spots may have limited electric, but there are no hook-ups.

Following are the guidelines for RV and tent camping on the grounds. Please ensure you are aware of all policies.

1. RVs must be pre-registered and paid prior to arrival. Parking hangtags issued by the Event Center with paid dates must be displayed at all times. The rental period begins on the arrival date and ends on the departure date. Permission must be granted by Management to extend the rental period and appropriate charges will apply.
2. RV/LQ parking and tent camping is only available to show participants and vendors and is not available to the general public. RV/LQ parking may not be available for all events. Designated RV/LQ spots may have electric, and a few spots at the Arena have access to water, but neither electric nor water is guaranteed.
3. In most instances, units will not have power at their designated parking space as multiple outlets are located at each power source. Please bring an extension cord (minimum 50') and a 110-volt adapter.
4. Please be mindful of your power consumption, as more than one unit is sharing a circuit breaker. The use of multiple appliances at one time may result in a loss of power for yourself and up to three other units.
5. RVs and motorhomes must have stabilizer pads at least 18" x 18" under each support point. Failure to use stabilizer pads will result in a \$150 fee.
6. Unless an event is ongoing, Event Center gates are locked at 5:00 pm each night. An emergency exit is available through the Loading Dock gate. This gate is automatic and is activated by driving your vehicle over the area directly

in front of the gate (outlined in yellow). Once you leave the property, re-entry may not be available until 8:00am the next morning. Please ensure you know how to exit the grounds in case of emergency.

7. Only registered RVs may park in designated spaces. Due to limited space, it may be necessary to park support vehicles away from RV spots or in exterior lots. Supply or livestock trailers must be disconnected from RVs and parked in the designated area(s).
8. The Event Manager has the authority to designate the location of each RV/Tent Camping spot, as well as have vehicles towed, and if necessary, request the removal of disruptive campers, or campers that are not following the guidelines set forth in this document.
9. No RVs or camping vehicles may be plugged into outlets inside buildings without prior FSMG approval.
10. Do not open gates, remove fencing or access any building other than those rented for the event you are participating in.
11. You must remain in the area rented by the Show Chair/Organizer and may not enter other areas.
12. Do not drive across or park in any grass areas without prior FSMG approval.
13. Absolutely no alcohol is permitted outside of RVs/Tents. Any alcohol consumption outside of RVs/Tents may lead to being trespassed from the Fairgrounds.
14. Cannabis is not permitted on the grounds at any time.
15. No open flame fires are permitted on the grounds. This includes portable propane fire pits. Propane grills are allowed.
16. Absolutely no dumping of gray water or sewage on the grounds.
17. Dogs are not allowed in the restrooms at any time.
18. Courteous respect for other campers is expected. Quiet time is from one hour after the event ends until one hour prior to the event start time the next day.
19. If security personnel are onsite, they are present to ensure public safety. As such, they have access to any and all areas of the event.
20. Pets may not be tied outside RVs/Tents unattended and must be leashed at all times. If pets disturb other campers, it may become necessary to remove the pet from the Fairgrounds. Owners are responsible for care and clean-up after pets. Fairgrounds Site Management Group and Clark County will not assume any responsibility for pets.
21. Fairgrounds Site Management Group and Clark County, its employees, directors, officers and volunteers are held harmless against any lost, stolen or damaged units or items.
22. Cancellation Policy: Cancellation requests that are received at least 48 hours prior to the event start date may be issued a full refund upon request. Cancellations received less than 48 hours before the event start date are not refundable.

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
