**CRUFTS QUALIFYING:** Winners of Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Winners, Select Dog and Bitch, the Awards of Merit, and Best Bred by Exhibitor are qualified to enter the 2022 and 2023 Crufts Dog Show. (National only)

**AWARD OF MERIT (AOM):** Award of Merit rosettes may be awarded to ten percent of the Best of Breed entry including the winners of the non-regular classes who are eligible for best of breed at each national specialty. The rosettes will not be numbered. The following are not eligible for an Award of Merit: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Winners Dog and Winners Bitch. This explanation must be included in the show catalog under Awards of Merit, with lines to record the results. (NWBCPS-AOM Up to 5; BCCA-ten percent of the Best of Breed entry including the winners of the non-regular classes.)

**BEST FROM THE REGULAR PUPPY CLASSES:** Best Puppy From The Regular Puppy Classes First place winners in Puppy Classes, 6 mos. and under 9 mos. and 9 mos. and under 12 mos., both sexes will compete together and will be judged after Best of Breed.

**BEST FROM THE BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES (Independent Specialty Only):** After Best of Breed, Selects and Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of Bred By Exhibitor Dog and Bred By Exhibitor Bitch compete for Best Bred by Exhibitor. If Best of Winners is from the Bred by Exhibitor class, that entry is automatically Best Bred by Exhibitor.

**BEST OF BREED BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR COMPETITION (National Only):** To qualify Exhibitors must declare their dog meets the requirement of the Bred-By Exhibitor class (Chapter 3, Section 8 of Rules Applying to Dog Shows) Dogs must be breeder owner handled. Eligible dogs will be identified by an indicator in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition by an eligible breeder owner.

Best of Breed Bred By Exhibitor will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes that have indicated eligibility on the entry form by checking the BOB BBE BOX.

### BEST VETERAN DOG & BEST VETERAN BITCH

First place winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes will compete for Best Veteran Dog and Best Veteran Bitch after Best of Breed.

### Points available for Reserve

The BCCA will award a 3pt major to the reserve winners dog and bitch if the class dog and bitch entry is twice that required for a five pt major in the division where the specialty is held. (National only)

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Undefeated dogs ONLY are eligible to compete for Best of Breed. All Best of Breed Dogs will be judged to their entirety. Bitches do not need to come into the ring to be checked at this point. The Best of Breed Bitch judging will follow to their entirety. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

Grand Champion Competition – The following categories of dogs are entered in this competition:

- Dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed or Best of Variety class.
- Dogs transferred to Best of Breed/Variety which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed.
- Champions that win Non-Regular Classes and become eligible for Best of Breed competition. (Altered or spayed CH veteran class winners at independent specialties are eligible.)
- Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition.

At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to • Best of Breed or Variety • Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed or Variety • Select Dog • Select Bitch Grand Championship competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed competition.

This will be followed by Awards of Merit, NOHS Best of Breed.

### Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Dogs, 7 yrs. & under 10 yrs.	Veteran Bitches, 7 yrs. & under 10 yrs.

Veteran Classes – For dogs and bitches seven years of age and older. In accordance with Chapter 11, Section 8, veteran dogs and bitches may be spayed or neutered at specialty shows. All winners of Veteran Classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete for Best of Breed. First place winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes will compete for Best Veteran Dog and Best Veteran Bitch after Best of Breed.

Performance Dogs      Performance Bitches (National only)

Performance Classes: For dogs and bitches, 6 months of age and over, that have earned at least one title in any AKC Companion or Performance Event (Agility, Herding, Obedience, Rally or Tracking). Dogs entered in these classes must not have been neutered or spayed. By virtue of winning these classes, the dog and bitch are eligible to compete for Best of Breed provided they have not been defeated in any other class. Performance Dog and Performance Bitch.

Sexually Altered Dog      Sexually Altered Bitches (National only)

Sexually Altered Class: For dogs and bitches, six months of age or over that have been neutered or spayed. The dog and bitch winning these classes are not eligible to compete for Best of Breed. Sexually altered Dog and Sexually Altered Bitch.

### **Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries (National only)**

**NOTE:** As the judges' decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace Class is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that a "castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

**Stud Dog Class** – For Stud Dogs and two (2) of their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered individually in one of the Regular Classes, Performance Classes or Best of Breed Competition Brood Bitch Class – Same as Stud Dog, except substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "Produce" for "get".

**Brace Class** – Two dogs of the same breed/variety, regardless of sex, and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog that is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only." In making entries for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated. "Brace No 1" "Brace No. 2" etc. If entered online an email MUST be sent to dogshows@barayevents.com identifying the Brace or Braces.

### **THE AKC NATIONAL OWNER HANDLED SERIES**

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Professional handlers,\* household members and current assistants to professional handlers\*\* may not exhibit. Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. ## **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP** (National only)

**NOVICE CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

**MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

**NOTICE:** Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

**NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S):** There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.

AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Competition.
