NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event: An AKC Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions.)

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- PUBLICATION RIGHTS – By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

To be followed by Select Dog/Bitch & Best Bred By Exhibitor (see below)

The above classification is provided for all Terrier breeds (and varieties). Additional divisions, i.e. (age, color, or weight) are in the breed list and must be indicated on the entry form.

OPEN CLASS DIVISIONS

Manchester Terriers (standard) Over 12 lbs. & not exceeding 16 lbs.; over 16 lbs. & not exceeding 22 lbs.

Miniature Schnauzers: Black; Black & Silver; Salt & Pepper.

Skye Terriers: Drop ears; Prick ears.

SPECIAL RECOGNITION

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: The Group IV Terrier Club of Salt Lake, Inc. will hold a Bred by Exhibitor competition for Bred by Exhibitor in each breed in the Terrier Group & Best Bred by Exhibitor in Group (placements 1-4)

Rules: The same rules apply to eligibility to compete in the regular Bred by Exhibitor classes as apply to eligibility to compete in the Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed and Group. During the course of the regular breed judging the assigned judge will select a Best Bred by Exhibitor from the class winners of the Bred by Exhibitor Adult and Puppy classes. This will be done after Best of Breed judging unless the Best Bred by Exhibitor award is automatic. **Example:** An entry from the Bred by Exhibitor classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Bred by Exhibitor class are eligible for Best Bred by Exhibitor Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

AKC SANCTIONED 4-6 MONTHS PUPPY

Entries will close Wednesday Noon, August 24, 2026 at Superintendent's office.

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries. Exhibition-only entrants will participate in the same BPUP classes as regular entries. Judges will evaluate exhibition-only entrants in the same manner as regular entrants but will not consider them for awards. All Exhibition BPUP entries will receive an armband/catalog number starting with a capital "E."
- To be competitive, dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

USE OF RAMPS – TERRIER BREEDS

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Kerry Blue Terriers. Breeds designated as ramp optional may, at the discretion of the judge, be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition. The full policy and list of Table and Ramp eligible/ required breeds is available on the AKC website at: https://images.akc.org/pdf/judges/table_breeds.pdf

Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (06/2023)

- NO VEHICLES ARE ALLOWED ON THE GRASS!! Failure to comply will lead to action by the Show Committee. Damages caused by vehicles will be the responsibility of those person bringing vehicles onto the show site grass areas!
- Please be sure that all dogs have current DHL, RABIES, and PARVO vaccinations!
- EXHIBITORS AND AGENTS will be held responsible for damages and for keeping the premises clean around their crates and set ups.
- EXHIBITORS & AGENTS MUST KEEP DOGS UNDER CONTROL AND RESTRAINED AT ALL TIMES.
- EXHIBITORS & AGENTS are advised to bring adequate shade for the comfort of their dogs and themselves.
- **Crates must be removed immediately following that breed. This will be strictly enforced by the Show Committee. The grounds may be sprinkled each afternoon to help combat dust in the arena. No effort will be made to keep equipment left near the rings dry.**
- No Crates within 25 feet of the show rings. Crates may be placed against walls during specific breed judging and MUST be removed immediately following that breed. No ex-pens on the grass. Ex-pens for overnight and box van parking must be in exhibitors parking space only. NO GROOMING IN THE EXHIBIT ARENA.
- Restrooms will be available for the convenience of exhibitors/spectators. NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED IN THE RESTROOMS AT ANY TIME. Any exhibitor found bathing or grooming a dog in the public restrooms WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE AND WILL BE SUBJECT TO ACTION BY THE SHOW COMMITTEE.
- NO OVERNIGHT PARKING allowed except in reserved parking area.
- The Bonneville Basin Kennel Association & the USU Bastain Agricultural Center assumes NO LIABILITY for loss or damage to equipment, property and/or exhibitors and agents.
- No Baby Strollers will be allowed on the Arena Floor. This is for the safety of all. Wagons and trollies must be kept at least 10 feet away from rings
- No loose materials such as SAWDUST, CHIPS, shredded paper, etc. will be allowed. Bring mats or other appropriate ground cover.
- **No dogs will be allowed to be left in the Buildings unsupervised at any time.**
