 Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events

AWARDS OF MERIT

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Variety Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If at the end of the 90 day period the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Variety competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC. This will be followed by Best Owner-Handled of Breed.

NOTE: Per AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, effective June 28, 2023, neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veterans and all other single entry non-regular classes only at independent specialties which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed.

OPEN CLASS DIVISIONS - BOTH SEXES

SPECIAL RECOGNITION

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR PUPPY - SATURDAY ONLY: The winners of the Bred By Exhibitor Puppy Dogs/Bitches will compete for Best Bred-by Exhibitor Puppy.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR ADULT - SUNDAY ONLY: Bred By Exhibitor Adult Dogs/Bitches classes compete for Best Bred-by Exhibitor Adult.

If the winner of any of the mentioned classes was awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed, then the award is automatic. **All varieties will be shown together.**

AWARDS OF MERIT: The judge may, at the conclusion of Best of Breed, at their own discretion, award 1 AOM for every 10 entries of Specials in the show. These are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed. Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety, Select Dog/Bitch, and Best of Winners are not eligible to receive an Award of Merit because it is assumed the judge finds them worthy of merit by the virtue of their win.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

AKC SANCTIONED 4-6 MONTHS PUPPY

Entries will close Wednesday Noon, November 12, 2025 at Superintendent's office.

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event.

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries. Exhibition-only entrants will participate in the same BPUP classes as regular entries. Judges will evaluate exhibition-only entrants in the same manner as regular entrants but will not consider them for awards. All Exhibition BPUP entries will receive an armband/catalog number starting with a capital "E."
- To be competitive, dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.


