# 4-6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs/bitches that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Entry and eligibility requirements include:

• AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol. 
   Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner

The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If at the end of the 90 day period the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

# Non-Regular Classes (involving multiple dog entries)

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class: Each entry is allowed two get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

**Brace Class:** Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

#### **SWEEPSTAKES**

**ELIGIBILITY**: Open to Boston Terrier Dogs and Bitches 6 months and under 18 months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class MUST also be entered in a regular class at this show. ENTRY FEE (as an additional entry) \$20.00. No Champion of Record is eligible to compete in Sweepstakes. A dog may be handled in the Sweepstakes by any person in good standing with the American Kennel Club. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to regular classes.

- GROUNDS AVAILABLE FOR SET-UP OF GROOMING EQUIPMENT FROM 11:00AM 9:30 PM Friday.
- CONTROL OF THE GROOMING AND CRATING AREAS WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE GROUNDS CHAIRMAN. No roping off or saving of grooming areas. Show Committee reserves the right to rearrange crates etc., in the non-reserved grooming area in order to make more room. Grooming equipment left in day grooming area after Best in Show will be confiscated.
- · Grooming and Crating area aisles must remain open at all times.
- Personal exercise pens, Cocker pens, Toy pens and/or canopies are not allowed inside or outside

  Parking available until 10:00AM on Tuesday (See RV Parking Signup).
- No parking on the Fairgrounds without a proper parking pass (no parking with Load/Unload tags.)
- Loss or Damage The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs
  and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or
  misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's
  child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor/Parent. It is distinctly understood that
  exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the shows OR THE
  EXHIBITOR/PARENT WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOW PREMISES.
- The only fresh water available on the grounds will be in the restrooms. (The only acceptable
  place for dumping water is down the drains in restrooms). Exhibitors are responsible for the water
  required for the safety and comfort of their dogs. No dogs will be allowed in buildings overnight.
- Exhibitors and Handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their grooming area, mobile grooming area and hotel room.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. X-pens will be provided outside.
   Exhibitors and handlers must pick up fecal matter deposited by their dogs on the grounds and risk a \$50.00 fine if caught not picking up after their dogs. The fairgrounds requested exhibitors keep dogs by buildings and keep them off the grass.
- Speed limit within the Fairgrounds is 5MPH. Anyone exceeding the speed limit will be subject to
  an event show hearing, and/or escorted off the grounds immediately. Parking in undesignated
  areas are subject to an event show hearing, \$50.00 fine and/or being escorted off the grounds.
- If it is necessary to rescue a dog from a parked vehicle on the show grounds or in the parking areas, the club will not be responsible or liable for any damage to the vehicle involved. Animals left in vehicles will be monitored by County Control Officers and Club Members. If animals are in distress due to heat or any other circumstances, the vehicle will be forcibly entered the animal recovered and the owner cited.
- ALL ELECTRICAL DEVICES WHICH CREATE MULTIPLE OUTLETS MUST BE UL APPROVED AND INCORPORATE A SEPARATE CIRCUIT BREAKER WITHIN THE DEVICE.
- No Smoking will be allowed or tolerated in any building on the Show Site. Offenders of the rule shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$50.00, and in the event of continued abuse, shall be asked to leave the show premises.
- TROPHIES Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging rings to the person exhibiting the
  dog, who will be considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for trophies and other
  prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed, and
  the Show Chairmen advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. No Award will be mailed. The
  Clubs reserve the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

THESE RULES WILL BE ENFORCED BY THE SHOW COMMITTEE. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN CHARGES BEING BROUGHT BEFORE THE SHOW COMMITTEE.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

- **NOVICE CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.
- OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.
- MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.
- **NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:** Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.



#### DIRECTIONS TO THE WASHINGTON STATE FAIR EVENTS CENTER



FROM OLYMPIA AND THE SOUTH: Take I-5 North to Hwy. 512, Exit 127. Follow Hwy. 512 east for 10 miles to the Meridian St., S. Exit. Turn left under the freeway. Fairgrounds are on the left.

FROM SEATTLE AND THE NORTH: Take I-5 South to the Puyallup Exit #142B in Federal Way. As exiting, stay in the left lane. Turn right at the traffic light at the end of the exit ramp, then turn left at the first traffic light onto Hwy. 161. Travel approximately eight miles into the Puyallup Valley (Hwy. 161 becomes Meridian St. in Puyallup). Continue south through town. The Fairgrounds will be on your right at 9th Ave. S.W.

FROM BELLEVUE AND THE EASTSIDE: Take I-90 to I-405 South. Take Exit 2 to Hwy. 167 toward Kent/ Auburn. Travel South on Hwy. 167 for approximately 20.2 miles to Hwy. 161 South/Hwy. 512 W. Travel 2.3 miles to the second exit, Meridian St. S. At the light at the end of the exit turn right. Fairgrounds are on the left.

## FROM SEATAC AIRPORT:

Option 1: Depart airport, taking exit to I-5 and I-405. Follow signs to I-405 Northbound toward Renton and Bellevue. Take Exit 2, Hwy. 167 South toward Kent/Auburn. Travel south on Hwy. 167 for 20.2 miles to 161 South/512 West. Follow Hwy. 512 West to Puyallup and Olympia, traveling 2.3 miles. Take the second exit, Meridian Street South. Turn right at the light at the end of the exit. The fairgrounds are on the left, on the corner of Ninth and Meridian (Cattin's Restaurant is on the corner). Option 2: Take I-5 south to the Puyallup Exit #142B in Federal Way. As exiting, stay in the left lane. Turn right at the traffic light at the end of the exit ramp, then turn left at the first traffic light onto Hwy 161. Travel approximately eight miles into Puyallup Valley. (Hwy. 161 becomes Meridian Street in Puyallup). Continue south through town. The Fairgrounds are on the corner of Meridian and 9th Ave. S.W. (Cattins Restaurant is on the corner).
