NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List. The

American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event: An AKC Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions.)

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.

Entrants in Non-Regular Single Classes need not be intact. Spayed or neutered animals are allowed. Winners of the above classes, if otherwise undefeated at this show, will compete for Best of Breed. NOTE: Dogs defeated in these classes may not compete for Best of Breed even if they were additionally entered in the Best of Breed class. (No championship points are awarded for these classes.)

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record; and Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. To be followed by Select Dog/Bitch, NOHS, Awards of Merit, and Best Bred-by-Exhibitor.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES) - OFFERED FRIDAY ONLY

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class. Dogs entered in multiple-entry classes need not be intact. Spayed and neutered animals are eligible.

Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class: Each entry is allowed a minimum of two, and no more than four of their get. . The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

Brace Class: Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class.. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

Veterans Exhibition-Friday: (13 years old & over) Dogs must be AKC registered. Class will follow Veteran's Classes, but dogs entered in this class are NOT eligible for BOB competition. Dog may be presented for examination at owner's discretion. Entries taken by BARAY EVENTS, but exhibitor should bring a 3x5-card description of the dog's lifetime achievements (to the event) to be read in ring by the steward.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION - BOTH DAYS

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the substitute dog is not entered in this specialty, the Junior Showmanship only fee applies.

SPECIAL RECOGNITION - BOTH EVENTS

Best Bred by Exhibitor - The winners of the Bred By Exhibitor Puppy Dogs/Bitches and Bred By Exhibitor Adult Dogs/Bitches classes (only) will compete for Best Bred-by Exhibitor.

Awards of Merit - At the conclusion of the regular Best of Breed judging, the judge may award a minimum of zero (0) up to a maximum of four (4) Awards of Merit (AOM), based on the scale below. The maximum number of AOM is calculated by adding the total number of the following who are present and competing in the Best of Breed: Dog and Bitch Specials, 1st place Junior and Senior Veteran Dog and Bitch, 1st place Field Champion Dog and Bitch, Winners Dog and Winners Bitch.

FUTURITY & MATURITY - FRIDAY

FUTURITY STAKE RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Futurity Stake is exclusively for the competition of Basenji puppies, six (6) months and under eighteen (18) months of age at the date of the Futurity. Only puppies from nominated bitches, and with enrollment kept up-to-date, are eligible for the futurity stake at the show. Division must be noted on entry blank as an additional class.

ALL PUPPIES ENTERED IN THE FUTURITY MUST BE ENTERED IN THE REGULAR CLASSES OR BEST OF BREED OF THE EVERGREEN BASENJI CLUB SPECIALTY SHOW AND ENTERED IN THE FUTURITY AS AN "ADDITIONAL CLASS":

FUTURITY CLASSIFICATION

Division 1: Puppy Dogs: 6 months and under 7.5 months • Puppy Bitches: 6 months and under 7.5 months (Puppies born Dec. 15, 2025 – Feb 1, 2026)

Division 2: Puppy Dogs: 7.5 months and under 9 months • Puppy Bitches: 7.5 months and under 9 months (Puppies born Nov 1, 2025 through Dec 15, 2025)

Division 3: Puppy Dogs: 9 months and under 18 months • Puppy Bitches: 9 months and under 18 months (Puppies born Feb 2, 2025 – Nov 1, 2025)

Division 4: Bred-by Exhibitor Dogs: 6 months and under 18 months • Bred-by Exhibitor Bitches: 6 months and under 18 months (Puppies born Feb 2 2025 – Feb 1, 2026)

The First Place winners will then compete for Best in Futurity. The Second Place winner to Best in Futurity will then return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best in Futurity

FUTURITY PRIZES - DISTRIBUTION OF PRIZE FUND

Futurity prize money will be calculated on the total of nomination fees received. Forty percent (40%) of the total prize money will be awarded to Best in Futurity and Reserve in Futurity on a two-thirds (2/3) to one third (1/3) ratio. The remaining sixty percent (60%) will be divided into a stake for each class based on the number of puppies actually entered in each class. A sum per dog shall be determined by dividing 60% of the total nomination fee received by the total number of entrants. Class stake shall be determined by multiplying the sum per dog by the number of dogs entered in the class. The stake for each class will then be divided as follows:

Four (4) or more entries:	1st – 40%	2nd – 30%	3rd – 20%	4th – 10%
Three (3) entries:	1st – 50%	2nd – 30%	3rd – 20%	
Two (2) entries:	1st – 60%	2nd – 40%		
One (1) entry:	1st – 100%			

NOTE: Any place money not awarded due to absence shall revert to Evergreen Basenji Club, Inc.

MATURITY RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Maturity as a part of The Evergreen Basenji Club Futurity is open to Basenjies that actually participated in the Evergreen Basenji Club Futurity the previous year. ALL BASENJIS ENTERED IN THE MATURITY MUST BE ENTERED IN THE REGULAR CLASSES OR BEST OF BREED OF THE EVERGREEN BASENJI CLUB SPECIALTY SHOW AND ENTERED IN THE MATURITY AS AN "ADDITIONAL CLASS":

The classes will be divided into one class for dogs, with four (4) placements; and one class for bitches, with four (4) placements. The First Place winners will then compete for Best in Maturity. The Second Place winner to Best in Maturity will then return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best in Maturity.

MATURITY PRIZES

Twenty percent (20%) of the total Maturity Class entry fees received will be retained by the club to defray expenses. The Balance will be awarded as follows: Sixty percent (60%) going to Best in Maturity and forty percent (40%) going to Reserve Best in Maturity.

The Melody Russell Award: given each year to the Best Bred By Exhibitor Basenji. It is our honor to celebrate Melody's contributions and lifetime dedication to the breed. A Silver-plated item.

All Trophies must be claimed the day of the Show. None will be mailed.

AKC® Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.
