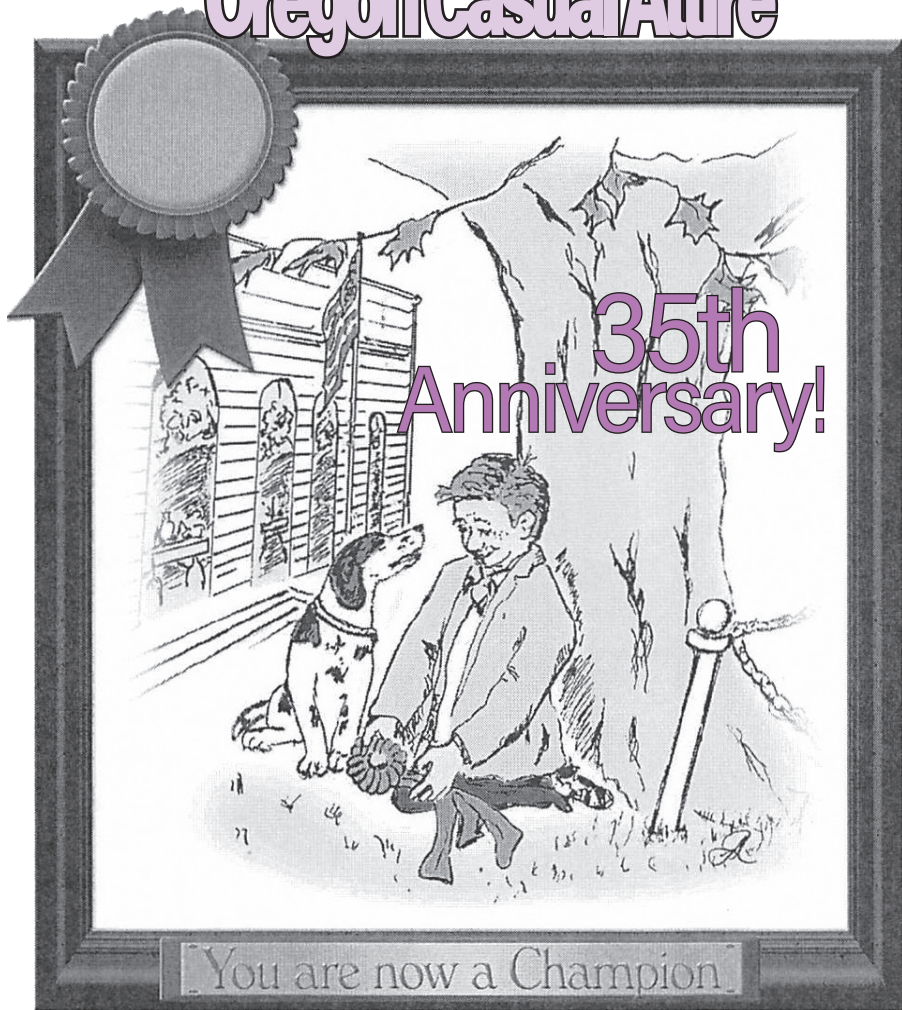

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

The American Kennel Club will collect: a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee where applicable for the first entry of a dog, plus a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 is required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 is required for each additional entry of the same dog.

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.**
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE.** BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- **REFUNDS** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent **AFTER THE SHOW.** An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- **FAX ENTRIES** – Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES** or **OVERPAYMENTS**. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show **NO REFUND** will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- **LOSS OR DAMAGE** – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- **PUBLICATION RIGHTS** – By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

Clackamas Kennel Club, Inc. was incorporated in 1974 and held its first AKC licensed all-breed show and obedience trial at the Clackamas County Fair & Event Center on September 12, 1988. That makes this our 35th Anniversary Year! For over 35 years, CKC has been proud to sponsor shows that are high quality, relaxed, and fun. We appreciate the many positive comments we have received from exhibitors, judges and the general public. We want to thank everyone for their continued support.

WHAT DOES CKC DO WITH YOUR MONEY? Over the years, when the club has made a modest profit on our shows, this money has been spent primarily on donations to National Animal Interest Alliance Trust (NAIA), AKC/CAR & AKC Reunite, K-9 4-H, Clackamas County Event Center Foundation Fund, and Oregon Dog Judges Education Fund.

HIGHLIGHTS FOR THIS YEAR!

OREGON CASUAL: We are an outdoor show and 80% of the time the weather is good. We want to encourage participants including Judges to dress in a manner that is comfortable and that makes sense in an outdoor setting. Really no need for ties, jackets or over the top attire. Come prepared to have some fun.

GROOMING: SEE PAGE 19. Again this year, the Fair and Event Center has decided NOT to put up the T-Structure that has been used in the past for covered grooming. Our club explored options and came up with three. 1) We will offer free grooming setup area in the Yellow Lot where pop-ups and generators will be allowed. 2) You can reserve a day grooming space (popups and generators allowed but no electricity) and these will be scattered around the show grounds at the Parking Supervisor's / discretion. 3) You can reserve an overnight parking space for your grooming set up.

Three days of Obedience and Rally Trials will once again be held in the Ely Arena and CGC and AKC Trick Dog will be offered on Sunday.

MANY MAJORS are possible in so many breeds because of the large number of specialties and we appreciate all they do to contribute to the success of the weekend. The Thursday and Friday Specialties include: Brittany's, English Setters, German Shorthaired Pointers, Cocker Spaniels, Dachshunds, Bernese Mountain Dogs, Great Pyrenees, Newfoundlands, Samoyeds, Boston Terriers, Miniature Pinschers, French Bulldogs, Australian Cattle Dogs, Carin Terriers, Shetland Sheepdogs, Irish Setters, and the Terrier Association of Oregon group show. In addition, there will be Designated Specialties for Brittany's, Shetland Sheepdogs, and Airedale Terriers on Saturday and Shetland Sheepdogs and Brittany's on Sunday. And the Leonbergers are having a supported entry on Saturday.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES: CKC is offering two days of NOHS – Saturday and Sunday. We hope to see a large participation in this event. As in the past, our OH Group, RBIS and BIS rosettes are equivalent to the regular groups and we are again offering cash prizes for OH BIS and OH RBIS!

AGAIN THIS YEAR – BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION! The CKC is offering a Beginner Puppy competition on Saturday and Sunday for puppies between the ages of 4 and 6 months. We are really looking forward to having the puppies at our show!

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Select Dog and Select Bitch, where applicable, will be chosen immediately following Best of Breed competition.

USE OF RAMPS - ALL BREEDS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, American Water Spaniels, Boykin Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Grand Basset Griffon Vendéen, Whippets, German Pinschers, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs, and Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Miniature Bull Terriers.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp, or on a table: Mudi.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirneco dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows and Keeshonden.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (03/2023)

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second-place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Professional handlers,* household members and current assistants to professional handlers** may not exhibit. Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring. The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners competition.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

CKC GROOMING

Again this year the Clackamas County Fairgrounds and Events Center has elected to not set up the large Tent-Structure that we used for grooming the past several years.

The CKC Members have come up with three options for grooming and crating for our exhibitors:

1. Free Grooming Space: We will provide free grooming space in the yellow parking area. This area is grass, there is no cover and no power. If you require cover and power, you will need to bring a generator and a popup tent. There will be parking nearby, but you will have to move your equipment into the designated area. Poupers should be organized in rows with 15 foot aisles between rows. You may leave your equipment set up overnight at your own risk, but we suggest you lower your pop ups for extra protection and in case of wind/storms. Dogs may not be left overnight or unattended in this area. We expect you will keep your area clean. No reservations necessary – first come/first served.
2. Day Use RV Area Grooming Space: Option number two is renting a day use only RV spot. These spots are day use only - no overnight camping and no power. RV day use spots are available for \$35.00 per day. If you partner with another exhibitor, it will keep the cost affordable. No power use is included in these spots (using power in these spots will result in substantial up-charge (\$25/day). You may use a generator in these reserved RV spots keeping in mind the exhaust must be directed toward the roadway. If you wish to reserve a day use RV spot for grooming, please use the RV reservation form and check the box "Reserved Day Use Grooming Space" and we will permit 2 standard size vehicles in these spots.
3. Overnight RV Area Grooming Space: Option number three is to rent an overnight RV spot. Power is not guaranteed but available at some locations. The cost for an overnight RV spot is \$50/night and 2 standard vehicles will be permitted in these spots. If you wish to reserve a dayuse RV spot for grooming, please use the RV reservation form and check the box "Reserved Overnight Space for Grooming" and we will permit 2 standard size vehicles in these spots.

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

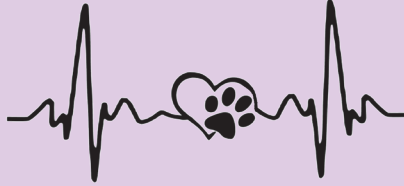

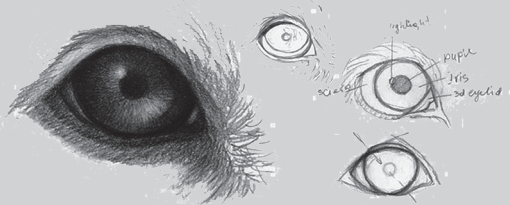

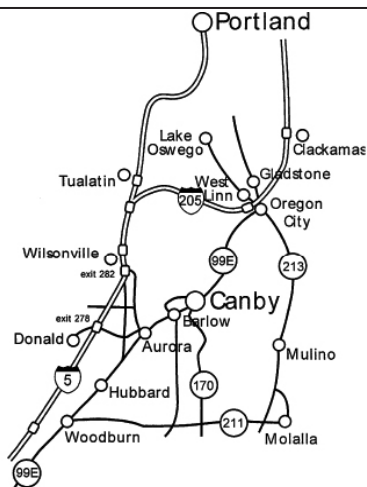

ROUTES TO THE SHOW
